**ALYDAR GROOM IN COURT** According to published reports, Alton Stone, the groom who was filling in as night watchman when leading race horse and sire **Alydar** (Raise a Native) was fatally injured, appeared in a Houston federal court Friday. Stone is facing charges he lied to a grand jury last August regarding the Alydar case. Arrested last week in Kentucky, he admitted to the two counts of lying, but did not go into details. Alydar fractured his right hind leg November 13, 1990 and was subsequently put down. His owner, Calumet Farm, was heavily in debt at the time; \$20.5 million of the \$36.5 million insurance settlement on the top stallion's life was paid to one of Calumet's biggest creditors, the now-bankrupt First City Bancorp of Texas. The Houston grand jury, which is investigating possible fraudulent activities by First City Bancorp, is looking into allegations that Alydar was intentionally injured so Calumet could collect on the insurance policy.

**ELMHURST PREPS FOR PALOS VERDES** GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hero **Elmhurst** (Wild Again), getting ready for his first start of the new year, worked five furlongs in 1:00 at Santa Anita Friday with jockey Corey Nakatani aboard. The eight-year-old will be back in action in the GIII Palos Verdes H. January 31. "He finished really well," said trainer Jenine Sahadi of the breeze. "He worked perfectly. He's sharp. I just hope there's a lot of speed in the race. They're going to have to go a nice clip for him to get up and win." Elmhurst closed from 14<sup>th</sup> off a half in :43.89 to get up for a half-length victory in the Sprint.

**NEW MEXICO TRAINER SUSPENDED IN "SPONGING" CASE** Trainer Joe Meyers, accused of "sponging" a horse at The Downs at Santa Fe in New Mexico last August, has been handed the stiffest possible penalty by the New Mexico Racing Commission, a five-year suspension. The suspension was the longest the Commission could impose, but it was also recommended that Meyers be denied a trainer's license in the state should he apply again at any time after his suspension has been served. The sponges were found in the nostrils of the then three-year-old gelding Absolutely Nothing, trained by Nicole Rawlings, just before he was scheduled to run at The Downs last August 22. A security guard had seen Meyers inside the horse's stall before the race; the sponges were discovered after Rawlings asked a veterinarian to examine her horse.
