### GENTLEMEN STARS ON HOLLYWOOD WORK

**TAB MGISW Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois), who will make his six-year-old debut in the GI San Antonio H. at Santa Anita February 7, worked a mile in 1:36 2/5 Saturday morning at Hollywood Park with jockey Gary Stevens in the irons. "He looks about as good as I've ever seen him," said trainer Richard Mandella. "This was the last of our big works for him. He'll have a shorter breeze before the race. The big stuff's done, and we couldn't be happier at this point." Winner of the GI Pimlico Special, GI Hollywood Gold Cup and GI Pacific Classic last season, the South American-bred has been out of action since running fifth in the Woodbine Mile last September. He came out of that race with an ulcerated palate, and missed the Breeders' Cup when he developed a fever two weeks before the event, but is now completely recovered. "I don't think he could be doing any better," said Mandella.

**SILVER MAIDEN SET FOR RETURN** Three-year-old **Silver Maiden** (Silver Buck), who ended her undefeated juvenile campaign with a seven-length score in the GI Frizette S. at Belmont Park October 19, will make her first start of 1998 in the one-mile \$75,000 Tiffany Lass S. February 1 at the Fair Grounds. "She's something special," said her trainer, Britt McGehee. "She'll run...in the Tiffany Lass, then she'll run in the Davona Dale (at the Fair Grounds February 21) and hopefully run in the Fair Grounds Oaks (GI, March 14)." Five-for-five as a two-year-old, Silver Maiden beat the boys in the Honest Pleasure S. at Arlington before taking the GI Arlington-Washington Lassie and the Frizette. She missed the Breeders' Cup due to a virus, but was co-runner-up behind unanimous choice Countess Diana in the Eclipse Award voting for champion two-year-old filly.

Exotic Wood has lost only once at Santa Anita, running second to the accomplished Serena's Song by a half-length in this event last year. Making her first start since a solid fourth-place finish against males in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, the dark bay mare ran her record at the track to five-for-six, stalking pacesetter Advancing Star through a half in :44 1/5 before putting a head in front at the top of the lane and driving clear. "She relaxed beautifully today," said her jockey, Chris McCarron. "She was very comfortable all the way down the backside and under no pressure at all. Consequently, she had a lot left at the finish. She pulled out all stops, a good effort on her part. This is as good an effort as I've ever seen out of her, as good a race as she's ever run." Exotic Wood's connections had considered retiring her after this race, but plans now call for the Kentucky-bred to continue her career on the racetrack. "I think there is no question she is back to where she left off a year and a half ago," said trainer Ron Ellis. "I think she looks better now than she ever has in her life. She's bigger and fuller now. We've been working on getting her to relax...the way she ran, this is the type of race she could stretch out off of." As for what's next, Ellis said, "The natural race to look at would be the Santa Maria (GI, 1 1/16 miles, February 14), it would just be a matter of if it would be a little too close to go ahead and stretch her out. But we want to pick out some major serious goals, not just run her in everything that comes up."

**"DREAM" CLAIM TO TANFORAN H.** Dreamer (Zilzal), claimed for \$125,000 at Santa Anita December 30, will make his debut under new management in the GIII Tanforan H. going a mile and an eighth on the grass at Bay Meadows January 31. The price paid for five-year-old gelding was the largest claim in Santa Anita history, but trainer Matt Chew, who dropped the slip for owners Nicholas L. and Nicholas J. Sibillo, said, "It was one of the easiest claims I've ever made. It's easier than claiming one for \$20,000. At least you know the horse is sound and you'll get to run him back. We had studied tapes and marked legs and there was no hesitation." Nicholas L. Sibillo, 82, owns and operates a creamery. This is his second racehorse; his first never broke her maiden. Dreamer, a winner in eight of his 27 starts, began his career in England, where he was stakes-placed, and also raced in Germany. He has earned \$300,185, but over \$200,000 of that was bankrolled last year. Third the day he was claimed, he has two stakes wins in four tries over Bay Meadows' Longden Turf Course and set the record for a mile and a sixteenth there last August, going the distance in 1:40.21. He was claimed from trainer Neil Drysdale and owner HRH Prince Fahd Salman.

Subordination won the Oct. 19 GII Jamaica H. at Belmont and the Nov. 30 GI Hollywood Derby, both on the turf, in his final two starts of 1997, and did not mind when this race was taken off the grass despite sporting an 0-for-3 record on the main track. Looking for his fourth straight victory, the favorite set the pace from the start and drew off handily in the stretch. "We didn't have a firm strategy," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said, "but the thing we did agree on was to let him run away from the gate and if somebody really wanted the lead, they were going to have to get it and pay a little bit of a price. I think he won the race in the middle of the race. He opened a couple of lengths on them, and he was comfortable doing it. He puts forth as much as he has to. And it was enough. Those types of races (coming off the turf)...the horse that goes to the front usually wins." Trainer Gary Sciacca had a decision to make after the race was taken off the turf. "We thought about scratching, but we knew we wanted to try him on the dirt sometime," Sciacca said. "It wouldn't be fair to say he can't run on the dirt because he hadn't run on it that much. He can run on hard turf, soft turf, dirt-it doesn't matter. He doesn't have to take his racetrack with him." Sciacca was unsure of where to run the winner next but indicated that he will space out the colt's races.

Sweetzie, who captured the Nov. 2 off-the-turf GII Long Island H. in the slop on the Big A main track three starts back, came on to finish fifth after a rough break last time out in the Dec. 20 GII Ladies H. going a mile and a quarter over the Aqueduct inner strip. Sent off as the longest price on the board, the winner broke slowly once again, steadied around the first turn, reached contention along the backside, stormed to the front around the far turn and drew away in the drive for a lengthy score. "I thought she would run a real good race, and I thought she had a real good chance of winning," jockey Julio Pezua said. "When I rode her last time, she stumbled coming out of the gate and she got cut off by a couple of horses; when I was able to get her to the outside she had a lot left. Because of that I knew she had a chance." Trainer Rita Nash credited the track condition with helping her charge's chances. "She seems to like this track and the wet surface really played to her favor," she said. "She likes an off track. I really thought she could win this race today, but not as easy as she did." ### Local News: California

The California Horse Racing Board has approved a plan to distribute more than \$350,000 by Hollywood Park Racing Charities to 76 beneficiaries. The largest grants will go to the Shoemaker Foundation (\$25,000) and the Don MacBeth Memorial Jockey Fund (\$15,000). Other racing-related beneficiaries include the Racetrack Chaplaincy of America (\$12,000), Winners Foundation (\$10,000) and United Pegasus Foundation (\$5,000); non-racing charities include International Life Services (\$15,000), Guide Dogs for the Blind (\$12,000), Santa Marta Hospital (\$10,000), Children's Bureau of Southern California (\$10,000) and the Salvation Army (\$10,000).

The CHRFB, however, did not approve the distribution of \$190,500 by the Bay Meadows Foundation because none of the 102 proposed beneficiaries were racing related, despite a new California law which requires that at least 20 percent of Charity Racing Day proceeds go to racing-related charities.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.
