FIRST FOAL FOR DERNIER EMPEREUR The first foal for two-time European champion **Dernier Empereur** (Tremolino) was born January 19 at Haras des Chartreux in Branville, France. The eight-year-old stallion was the highweighted three-year-old in France from 9½ to 11 furlongs and was similarly honored as an older horse in 1994. He won the 1994 G1 Dubai Champion S. in England, that year's G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte and the 1993 G2 Prix Guillaume D'Ornano. In a 12-race North American campaign, Dernier Empereur won the 1996 GII Del Mar Invitational and the GII Carleton F. Burke H. The chestnut's first foal, owned by Classic Breeding, is a bay colt out of **North Bend (GB)** (Shirley Heights {GB}).

Nijinsky's Passion made her debut in the claiming ranks, winning for a \$32,000 tag at Calder June 30, but scored at 30-1 in the Dec. 31 California Breeders' Champion S. last out. Lightly regarded in her first attempt in graded stakes company, the filly stalked the early leaders, rallied four wide turning for home to take over at midstretch and gamely turned back Well Chosen for a narrow win. Winning trainer Tim Pinfield said, "We thought after her last one against California-breds, we had to take a crack at this. As far as being good enough for open competition she showed it today. She ran super." Pinfield said the Feb. 15 GI Las Virgenes may be next for his filly. "Today, at the three-and-a-half (furlong mark), she had been losing a little position," jockey Corey Black said after the race. "(KENDRA FAYE {Capote}) had gone by, and I smooched and she actually got it in gear a little early, because she really cut. She was strong. It was a pleasant surprise." SUPERLATIVE (Olympio), the 4-5 favorite, faded to fourth after taking the lead momentarily at the head of the stretch. "I don't know why she ran so poorly," jockey Chris McCarron said of the beaten favorite. "The only thing I can put my finger on is this was the first time she was ever upset in the post parade. She's never done that before."

One of South Africa's premier sprint events, the G1 Cape Flying Championship over five furlongs at Kenilworth, was won Saturday by the 5-2 favorite **Cordocelli (SAf)** (Cordoba). The five-year-old held on to beat veteran gelding **Flobayou (SAf)** (Waterville Lake {Ire}) by a neck, with **Black Rod (SAf)** (National Assembly), a length and a quarter away in third. In last year's edition of the race, Flobayou beat Cordocelli as the pair finished second and third behind 20-1 outsider **Nobely Born (SAf)** (Complete Warrior). Cordocelli, trained by Chris Snaith, is now in line to take the champion sprinter award for this season.

Draw Again, who was one-for-five on dirt coming into this race, prevailed in the Jan. 2 Gill Tropical Park Derby over the Calder turf in his previous start. Looking for his fourth straight win, the colt, part of an entry that was sent off as the third choice, followed pace-setting United States in the early going and rolled by that rival in the drive to win going away. "There was a little question how he was going to handle the dirt since he is such an exceptional turf horse," winning jockey Joe Bravo said. "If he has to, he'll take the lead. If not, he'll lay back. My horse was in hand down the backside. I knew they were going to have to be running to get away from me. I had tons of horse. I just had to hit the trigger." Trainer Bill Cesare indicated that his charge may be heading for the Triple Crown trail. "I'll nominate him to the Fountain of Youth and the Florida Derby," Cesare said. "We'll just have to wait and see."

Dr. J. slam dunked a field of New York-bred maidens by nine lengths in his debut Dec. 18 at Aqueduct and won a Jan. 10 Aqueduct allowance contest for state-breds last time out. Making his stakes debut and trying open company for the first time, the bay colt stalked the pace, took over at the top of the lane, and pulled away in the final stages under a hand ride. "Everything went excellent for us today," winning jockey Herb McCauley said. "This is a small horse, but he's as tough and as big a fighter as I've ever seen. He just lays his ears back and gets competitive. He went about his business, and he's a very talented little individual. He stepped it up out there today." Trainer Joe Aquilino was concerned about his charge stepping up in class. "I thought this race would be a tough one for our horse because he's a New York-bred competing in open company, so he did surprise me," Aquilino said. "But he seems to run well when he gets a chance to get clear on the outside, and that's how he got his other two wins. He's a game and tough little guy." Aquilino plans on running the winner back in either the Feb. 14 Whirlaway S. or the Feb. 28 Best Turn S., both at Aqueduct.
