**LOVE LOCK TESTS POSITIVE** According to a *Daily Racing Form* report, three-year-old filly **Love Lock** (Silver Ghost) tested positive for the prohibited substance scopolamine after winning the GIII Santa Ysabel S. January 11. Scopolamine first drew attention when there was a rash of positives for the depressant in California in 1993. It was later determined that the horses who tested positive ingested the substance through hay and straw contaminated by jimsonweed. While the trainers in those cases were absolved of any wrongdoing, the horses were ultimately disqualified and forfeited any purse money won. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas was notified that both **Love Lock** and another of his horses, **Magic Cat** (Storm Cat), runner-up in a maiden race January 11, tested positive for scopolamine. Follow-up tests will be performed to confirm the original results before the CHRB takes any action.

**GOFFS IRELAND SALE CATALOGUES 400** Goffs Ireland will offer 400 lots during its two-day Mixed Sale February 9-10. The largest consignments in the catalogue are from His Highness the Aga Khan and Sheikh Mohammed. "There is a wide choice of horses on offer, ranging from weanlings of 1997, horses in and out of training through to fillies and broodmares," said Director Leo Powell. "The sale is ideally scheduled at the start of the breeding season and some six weeks before the start of the turf racing in Ireland and England." Last year's sale saw 230 lots sell for \$1,988,395; the average of \$8,646 was up 23 percent over 1996.

**DRAW AGAIN INJURED** Three-year-old **Draw Again** (Roman Diplomat), who picked up his fourth consecutive victory in the Super Bowl S. at Calder January 25, will be sidelined for at least three months after suffering a fractured left front cannon bone. The Fred Hooper homebred, who started his 1998 campaign with a victory in the GIII Tropical Park Derby at Calder January 2, will be forced to miss the Triple Crown, denying his 100-year-old owner the chance at his second Kentucky Derby. Hooper captured the 1945 Derby with Hoop Jr., the first horse he ever owned.

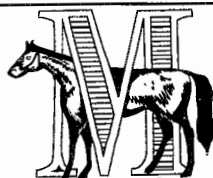
