TIME LIMIT SPOILS "CORONADO'S"

QUEST IN HUTCHESON Helped perhaps when 4-5 **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner) threw a tantrum in the paddock and post parade, second choice **Time Limit** (Gilded Time) outfinished the favorite to win Saturday's GII Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream Park by a neck. "He's a very, very good sprinter," said winning rider Jerry Bailey. "The question is whether he can go long or not." Time Limit, winner of the six-furlong GIII Spectacular Bid S. over this track last time out, settled in third as **Zippy Zeal** (Unreal Zeal) cut out fractions of :22.33 and :44.90. With the crowd's choice boxed in along the rail, the gelding made his move from the outside at the top of the stretch, opened up his advantage at the eighth pole and just held on over the fast-closing **Coronado's Quest**. The runner-up, five-for-six at two, showed temperament as well as talent during his juvenile campaign but had settled down and was all gentleman before his five-length victory GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct in his 1997 finale. But making his three-year-old debut, the cantankerous colt was fractious in the paddock, refused to be mounted by jockey Mike Smith, and broke away from his lead pony when Smith finally got a leg up once on the track. Smith got him under control and back to his pony, and after the race blamed his ride more than the bad behavior on the chestnut's narrow loss. "I'll take the credit," he said. "I got him beat. I think so--I know so. If I would have let him (go up with the leaders), I'd have been fine. But I didn't want three of us going head-to-head and setting it up for Time Limit...so I decided to ease back. When that happened, they backed up in my face." Once in the clear, **Coronado's Quest** came running and just missed. "I'm disappointed in two things," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "He didn't win, and especially the way he acted. We had schooled him and he acted perfect. I don't know why this happened today." The colt will have the chance to redeem himself in the GII Fountain of Youth S. February 21, but Time Limit may skip the race as stablemate Cape Town takes up the Triple Crown chase.

Time Limit, runner-up in the Nov. 29 GIII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at 1 1/16 miles in his final 1997 start, successfully turned back to a sprint with a 5 1/4-length tally in the Jan. 4 GIII Spectacular Bid S. at Gulfstream in his previous trip to the post. The winner was never far from the lead while racing on the outside down the backside, went after pacesetter Zippy Zeal approaching the stretch, ducked in slightly after getting to the front near the final furlong and dug in late to hold off favored **Coronado's Quest** at the wire. Said winning jockey Jerry Bailey, "(Coronado's Quest) didn't have a very good post (#3). He got stuck down in there. I had the dream post (#6). I had the time to get a free run and Mike (Smith) had to shuffle back. It probably didn't help him." Added trainer D. Wayne Lukas of the winner, "He's a very relaxed, laid-back horse. This was a nice progression. He's had two good races where he has relaxed. I think he'll stretch out better now." As for the future, Lukas said, "I've got Cape Town pointed to the Fountain of Youth (February 21). I don't know where we'll take (Time Limit)." The odds-on choice in his three-year-old bow, **Coronado's Quest**, who acted up in the post parade, raced just off the pace while caught behind horses down the backstretch, was eased back around the far turn to move to the outside and finished well but could not get by Time Limit in the drive. Runaway winner of the mile-and-an-eighth GII Remsen in his lone two-turn try, he will stretch out for his next start in the mile-and-a-sixteenth GII Fountain of Youth.

LIL'S LAD ROMPS AGAIN Opting to stretch out to two turns rather than take on Grade II company in the seven-furlong Hutcheson S., three-year-old sensation **Lil's Lad** (Pine Bluff) overwhelmed a field of allowance foes with a 6 1/4-length victory in yesterday's ninth race at Gulfstream Park. Sent off the 1-5 favorite in the mile-and-a-sixteenth test, the colt dragged jockey Jerry Bailey to the lead right out of the gate and had seven lengths on the field after a half despite fanning wide around the first turn. With the result never in doubt, Bailey barely moved his hands as the pair coasted to an easy decision. "Kristi (Chapman, aboard Kin of Fire, who finished fourth after pressing the pace) was chirping to her horse to get him going. My horse heard it and took off on his own. He went very fast early," said Bailey. "I would have liked to go a little slower, but considering what happened...I kind of expected it. He galloped out real good. I think I had something left with him." Trainer Neil Howard said his colt, who has won his last two by a combined 22 3/4 lengths, would go next in the GII Fountain of Youth S. February 21.

After a promising start to his career which saw him run third behind Silver Charm and Free House in last year's GIII San Vicente S. and win the GII San Rafael, Funontherun had no fun at all in his next two starts. Eased behind a spill in the GII Jim Beam S. in March, he came back as the favorite in the GIII California Derby and was eased again after pressing the pace in what was his turf debut. On the sidelines since that April 19 outing, the grey had worked sharply for his return and was fit despite the layoff, setting all the pace and outfinishing Red in the drive to the wire for the victory. "I tried him in (the California Derby) and he just didn't run at all," said trainer Mel Stute. "He made the vet's list that day. I said to (owner Herb Alpert) that we really can't find anything wrong with him. He's always been a very bad going horse. I sent him out to the farm, and flew in a vet who ended up operating on him. He found chips, so we took the chips out of both knees. He still travels the same way...that's just the kind of horse he is. He'll probably make the vet's list again today. But he is a runner." GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Elmhurst, last through a half in :44 3/5, came flying at the finish but ran out of real estate. "That wasn't a disgrace at all," said jockey Corey Nakatani. "He made his big run. We had a little traffic problem, but nothing out of the ordinary." The dam of Funontherun, Alden's Juana (John Alden), in foal to Runaway Groom, will sell at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale in Lexington next Sunday, February 8.

Wagon Limit (Conquistador Cielo), third behind Skip Away when the two met in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup last October, could face that rival again in the GI Donn H. February 7. The four-year-old, away since running 10th in the GI Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct November 29, breezed seven furlongs in 1:27 1/5 yesterday. "He felt dynamite," said jockey Robbie Davis, who was aboard for the work and will be back in the saddle for the Donn. "He jumped in the bridle right away and was strong all the way around there."

Also getting ready for the Donn, **Kiridashi** (Bold Ruckus) worked five-eighths in 1:00. The Barbara Minshall trainee was third in the GIII Broward H. in his latest January 10.
