### FASIG-TIPTON KENTUCKY WINTER MIXED SALE RESCHEDULED

Record snowfall in Central Kentucky, which has made traveling dangerous and prevented horses from reaching the Lexington sales grounds, has caused Fasig-Tipton to move the date of the Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale and the Stallion Access Sale of Seasons and Shares from Sunday, February 8 to Wednesday, February 11. Due to the change in sales date, Fasig-Tipton will be offering telephone bidding arrangements for prospective buyers. For more information, contact the sales company at (606) 255-1555.

### RECORD FOAL NOMINATIONS FOR BREEDERS' CUP

A total of 12,743 foals, the highest number ever, were nominated to the Breeders' Cup program last year. The 1997 total tops the previous high of 12,183 nominated in 1987. Breeders' Cup Limited officials also announced that 1,202 stallions were nominated to the program for the 1998 breeding season, a 4.7 percent increase over last year. Foal nominations are up 6.4 percent over 1996 and 20.8 percent since 1995; 1997 marks the fifth consecutive year that the number of foals nominated has risen. Total revenue generated by the 1997 Breeders' Cup foal crop was \$6,371,500, while revenue from stallion nominations was \$6,595,859. "We are extremely pleased with our record-setting season and the sustained five-year growth in both foal and stallion nominations," said D.G. Van Clief, Jr., president of Breeders' Cup Ltd. "Nomination is essential to fund the purses for the Breeders' Cup Championship and the National Stakes Program, as well as the marketing and television initiatives which Breeders' Cup underwrites. We extend our thanks to breeders and owners around the world for their continued support." Nominators paid a one-time, \$500 per-foal fee to make their 1997 foals eligible to the Breeders' Cup program for their entire careers. Stallions are nominated on an annual basis at a fee equal to their advertised stud fee (\$1,000 minimum). Newly retired stallions can still be nominated for the 1998 breeding season.
