AND AWAY WE GO... "SKIPPY" KICKS OFF CAMPAIGN IN DONN

It was his third straight Grade I win, but the first as he starts down the campaign trail toward a possible third divisional Eclipse Award. **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), with his name still in the hat for the 1997 "Horse of the Year" crown, made his first appearance since a powerful performance in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic yesterday at Gulfstream Park and picked up right about where he left off, cruising to a 2 3/4-length triumph in the GI Donn H. Now five, Skip Away could do no better than second as the 3-5 favorite in this race last year, but toting highweight of 126 pounds in the mile-and-an-eighth test this season he prodded 68-1 **Kiridashi** (Bold Ruckus) through a half in :46 3/5, moved to the lead after three-quarters in 1:10 4/5 and carried jockey Jerry Bailey clear in the stretch for the victory. "I think that this might be a little different animal this year," said Bailey. "He's come back real strong." The 1996 champion three-year-old after beating the great Cigar in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, Skip Away had to prove himself once again after a slow start in 1997, but he got it together in time to take a second straight Gold Cup and justified a \$480,000 fee to supplement to the Breeders' Cup with a record-setting 6 1/2-length Classic score that earned him the Eclipse as '97 champion older male. Trainer Sonny Hine thinks he could have another Eclipse in him. "He's a great horse," said Hine. "He's going to show it over and over again this year." The grey will be back in the spotlight for the GI Gulfstream Park H. February 28.

"SILVER" STREAKS TO VICTORY IN

STRUB The ultra-consistent **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), who took two-thirds of last year's Triple Crown, missed most of the second half of the 1997 season, but has come back to add two-thirds of the Strub series to his resume. Never worse than second in a dozen starts, the silver bullet fired his first shot of the new year with a win in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. January 17 and survived a stewards' inquiry yesterday to take the series finale, the GII Strub S., by a widening four lengths. "He's just getting better and better," said trainer Bob Baffert. "That was his best race ever. He graduated today, he showed we're not going to have to be afraid to go up against those older horses." The four-year-old will face yesterday's GII San Antonio winner **Gentlemen** (Arg) in the GI Santa Anita H. March 7. (Weekend Results, p2)

Skip Away put himself in position to vie for 1997 "Horse of the Year" honors with runaway wins in the Oct. 18 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and the Nov. 8 GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Returning to the races for the first time since his easy score at Hollywood Park three months ago, the public choice was always close to the early pace, eased to the outside down the backstretch, grabbed the lead with three furlongs to go and spurred clear in the drive. "The thing I wanted to do was give him a clear trip," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey, back aboard the grey after missing the Classic ride to honor a commitment to trainer Jim Bond and BEHRENS (Pleasant Colony). "He probably was getting a little tired. He worked through the stretch. It was his first race back and I got into him a little bit." Added trainer Sonny Hine, "I wasn't as confident as I was at the Breeders' Cup. Not because of the horse, but because of the track and because he was giving away a lot of weight. I was very pleased. He beat some nice horses today." Disappointing as the 7-2 second choice, GII Buick Pegasus H. winner Behrens was making his first start since a seventh-place finish in the Classic. The four-year-old was bumped going into the far turn and failed to mount a serious rally, settling for seventh once again.

Fresh from his victory in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S., GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness winner Silver Charm was sent off the prohibitive favorite to go two-for-two on the year. The colt angled to the rail soon after the start and stalked the pace from the inside down the backside, then switched to the outside to make his bid three-wide on the far turn, taking the lead at the head of the lane and drawing off in a stakes-record effort. TRU STORY (Capote), 10-1, was checked hard off the leaders' heels while tiring as the field approached the quarter-pole; jockey Corey Nakatani blamed the winner for the interference, but the stewards took a look at the tape and allowed the order of finish to stand. "I don't even know what happened," said winning jockey Gary Stevens of the inquiry. "(Tru Story) was dropping out of there pretty quickly. (Mud Route) may have been fading out a bit. Mine might have been coming in a bit. On to the race itself, to me, this was by far the most impressive race that Silver Charm has run. He drew off and really won with authority. He was like a cat going around the turn, just waiting to pounce." Asked to compare his rides on Silver Charm and on Gentlemen (Arg) in the San Antonio earlier on the card, Stevens said, "It was just two outstanding performances by both of them. The right word is devastating." Added trainer Bob Baffert, "He gave me goose bumps for the first time today. He's just a great horse." Gary Stevens will have a choice to make. Both Gentlemen and Silver Charm will run next in the GI Santa Anita H. March 7.

Forced to skip the Breeders' Cup after coming down with a virus, Gentlemen (Arg) had not been seen since running fifth in the GIC Woodbine Mile on the turf last September 20, but had reeled off three consecutive Grade I wins on the dirt prior to that effort. The Argentine champ had been working well for his return and came back running, bidding his time in fourth for six furlongs before powering to the lead at the top of the stretch and striding away to an impressive victory, his second straight in this event. "It's a great relief," said trainer Richard Mandella. "Whenever they're off a long time, you never know if they're going to come back the same. He was really full of himself today, really fresh. He just proved how great a horse he is today. I guess Sonny's horse (Skip Away) ran the same way today and he has the same feeling, so maybe someday we'll find out. I wish him the best." Jockey Gary Stevens said after the race, "Wow! You ride good horses every day, and it's real easy to forget how much talent these kind of horses have when you haven't ridden them for six or seven months. It's just incredible the acceleration that he has. I could tell right away that he was back." Gentlemen will make his next appearance in the GI Santa Anita H. March 7.

OVERHEARD: "When I turned around to gallop out in the post parade, he tried to buck me off. If you were a betting person, you could have put every penny you had on him. Sea Of Secrets broke his maiden in his debut at Santa Anita last October and followed with a five-length allowance victory at Hollywood November 20. Making his stakes debut off a 2 1/2-month layoff, the bay shadowed pacesetter Late Edition through a half in :44 1/5, put a head in front as they streaked through three-quarters in 1:08 3/5 and drove to the wire to take a narrow victory. "He's still a little green, but he relaxes well," said trainer Neil Drysdale. "This race set up well for him." Added jockey Kent Desormeaux, "This is a multi-talented little horse, but he does have one little setback. He has a little trouble getting air. Neil has done a wonderful job with him mentally to help him breathe. There's not much else we can do without surgery." The colt could come back in the GII San Rafael S. March 1. The 2-5 favorite ORVILLE N WILBUR'S (Out of Place) pressed the leaders early, moved to the outside for the stretch run, but weakened to finish fourth. "He's just green, that's all," said trainer Wally Dollase. "As soon as Corey (Nakatani) had to take hold of him and he had dirt in his face, he just kind of said, 'what is this?' I've got to work on that. This is a very, very good horse, though. We'll go in the San Rafael."

APPEALING SKIER RETIRED Five-year-old **Appealing Skier** (Baldski), second in an allowance race at Gulfstream Park January 23, has been retired "due to injury," according to trainer Ben Perkins. "He will retire to a farm in Ocala, but we don't know which one yet." A winner of eight of his 26 career starts, the Florida-bred captured six stakes, including the GII Hutcheson, GII Withers, GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint H. and GIII Laurel Futurity. He set a track record in the Kentucky Cup Sprint, going six furlongs in 1:08 1/5 at Turfway Park in 1996. His career earnings stand at \$579,610.

TURFWAY CANCELS SUNDAY Still cleaning up after a storm which dumped more than 18 inches of snow in the area, officials at Turfway Park have called off today's card at the track due to unsafe track conditions. Fluctuating temperatures have caused the snow in the track to melt during the day and freeze again at night, creating an unsafe surface. Turfway has now lost five consecutive programs to last week's blizzard. The \$60,000 Dust Commander S., which had been carded as Saturday's feature race, has been rescheduled for Saturday, February 21. Racing is scheduled to resume Wednesday evening, with first post at 5:30 p.m.
