STEVENS STILL ON FENCE Jockey Gary Stevens had been expected to announce his decision regarding who he will ride in the \$1 million GI Santa Anita H. March 7 yesterday in the Santa Anita press box, but instead announced only that he has yet to make a decision. Stevens is the regular rider for both **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois) and **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck). "I've been afforded the luxury by both (trainers Richard Mandella and Bob Baffert) to have some more time and I'm going to take that time," said the rider. "I don't know when there will be a decision. I don't really want to say any more about it." Stevens' comments prompted speculation that Gentlemen may skip the Big 'Cap in favor of the \$4 million Dubai World Cup, set for March 28. "It's to my advantage if the two don't run in the Big 'Cap," he said, "but I'm a sportsman and I want to see racing flourish. I think if we can have these two horses and still possibly get Skip Away out here, it would be the greatest day of racing we've seen in a long time. I hope that does happen."

GRAND SLAM ON COMEBACK TRAIL Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said yesterday that MGISW **Grand Slam** (Gone West), injured in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, is five or six works away from a race. "We're in a tough position," admitted Lukas. "We don't have any conditions left, so I want to get him tight enough so we can run with stakes-type horses. Therefore, I don't have a time frame or a schedule for him. I might train him right up to the Santa Anita Derby (April 4)." The colt captured the GI Futurity and GI Champagne S. before tangling with another horse in the Juvenile and exiting the race with a severely lacerated left hind leg which required surgery to repair.

RADU COOL RETIRED GSW **Radu Cool** (Carnivalay), scratched from Saturday's GI Santa Maria H. when the track came up wet, has been retired and will ship to Kentucky Wednesday. The six-year-old will be bred to A.P. Indy. "It just didn't work out with the weather," said trainer John Shirreffs regarding Radu Cool's Santa Maria defection. "She's been doing very well, but has never trained well on an off track. She doesn't even like to gallop over it." The Kentucky-bred goes to the breeding shed with a record of nine wins, three seconds and a third in 20 career starts and a bankroll of \$572,218. Winner of last year's GI Chula Vista H., she was fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff in her final appearance.

Keeper Hill started her career in New York, finishing on the board in all three starts, then took a two-month break before resurfacing to break her maiden by a neck over the Santa Anita turf January 14. Climbing right into a Grade I stakes off the victory and returning to the main track, the bay was ignored at the windows but had everyone's attention as she closed from the back of the pack to put a head in front at the top of the stretch and left her rivals in the dust late for an easy victory. Trainer Bobby Frankel, who put blinkers on the filly for the first time here, said, "The last race she ran, (her jockey) had to ride her all the way, so I thought maybe she needed blinkers, that they would help her pick up the bridle. I think they helped. She was running on her own down the backside. I told (owners Mr. and Mrs. John Chandler)...I thought this filly would run good on the dirt. The thing I was worried about was that the distance would be too short for her. And I wanted to know if we had an Oaks filly." Looking every inch an Oaks filly, Keeper Hill could go next in the GI Santa Anita Oaks March 15. The 8-5 favorite, previously unbeaten Star Of Broadway set the pace, but couldn't hold on in her first try beyond six furlongs. "She had never been two turns, and I think it was one of those cases where she needed a race under her belt," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I think she'll benefit from it." CAREER COLLECTION (General Meeting), making her three-year-old bow after finishing second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and GI Hollywood Starlet to end her '97 campaign, stalked the pace, made a bid at the top of the stretch, but weakened late and finished fourth.

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH NOTES GSW Cape Town (Seeking the Gold), winner of the GIII Holy Bull S. January 17, had his final prep for Saturday's GII Fountain Of Youth S. yesterday, drilling five furlongs in a bullet :59 1/5 at Gulfstream. "He looked very good this morning," said Jerry Barton, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He worked really nice. I was really happy with him. I thought he looked as good if not better than he ever has. It's going to be a heck of a good race." Also breezing at Gulfstream yesterday, Rick Pitino's **Halory Hunter** (Jade Hunter) went five-eighths in :59 2/5. The colt was second to Fountain Of Youth hopeful **Lil's Lad** (Pine Bluff) in his three-year-old bow, a January 31 allowance race going a mile and a sixteenth. "He sure went good today," said trainer Nick Zito of his charge, who was third in last year's GI Champagne S. and second in the GII Remsen S. "He's got a good chance." Trainer Allen Jerkens' **Limit Out** (Northern Flagship), a possible for the Fountain Of Youth, went seven furlongs in 1:28 2/5 Sunday. The Kentucky-bred colt is three-for-three lifetime, with a win in a 6 1/2-furlong allowance at Gulfstream in his latest January 24, but would be trying two turns and stakes company for the first time Saturday.

CAREER OVER FOR LONDON NEWS? South Africa's dual Horse Of The Year **London News (SAf)** (Bush Telegraph {SAf}) will not be sent to Hong Kong in April to attempt a repeat win in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup and, after a disappointing South African season since his return from Europe last fall, looks set to be retired. His owners, Laurie and Jean Jaffee, are in negotiation to stand him at the stud owned by the Koster Brothers, who also bred the horse. London News' trainer Alec Laird said: "Last year he was on top of his game, he had three good wins and was well, but it would be an arduous thing for him to undertake the trip to Hong Kong again. He is not going to get better now than he was last year. He couldn't win in Hong Kong on his current form. Those races in Europe last summer broke his heart. He doesn't have the confidence of a winning athlete any more. Jean Jaffee doesn't want him to race any more. We should know about his stud career later this week." The five-year-old ran twice in Europe last year, finishing third in the G2 Prince Of Wales' S. and fifth in the G2 Budweiser American Bowl International. Returning to South Africa, he was unplaced in both the G1 Queen's Plate and the G1 J & B Met last month.

BRIDGMOHAN TAKES SIX AT BIG A Becoming the first apprentice since Steve Cauthen did it in 1977, jockey Sean Bridgmohan rode six winners on yesterday's card at Aqueduct. Bridgmohan, a native of Jamaica, West Indies, was the leading apprentice and third in the overall standings at the Tropical-at-Calder meet which ended January 2. He captured the first three races Sunday, then came back to win the sixth, eighth and ninth events. His longest shot was **Michelle's Tatala** (Cure the Blues), who paid \$10.20 in the first, while **Red Light Rambler** (Pappa Riccio) was the shortest price, paying \$3.90 in the second. "It's an honor," said the 18-year-old. "It really is just a great feeling. I know my dad is very happy watching the races down in Florida. He's my number one fan." Bridgmohan is now fourth in the Big A jockey standings with 25 wins.
