**BAFFERT: OAKLAWN FAR FROM CERTAIN** Bob Baffert, trainer of **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), said yesterday he didn't hold out much hope for his charge making the April 4 GI Oaklawn Park H., which will offer a \$1 million purse to the winner if **Gentleman (Arg)** (Robin des Bois), **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) and Silver Charm all compete. "I've trained Silver Charm hard for the Strub series," said Baffert. "I'll see how he comes out of the Big 'Cap (March 7) before I decide where to go next." Baffert also had an opinion on whether or not Skip Away would race at Oaklawn. "He'll go where it's soft, and so will I," he said. Baffert has scheduled a work for this morning for Silver Charm, while trainer Richard Mandella said he plans to work Gentlemen either Sunday or Monday.

**AAEP BACKS NTRA LAUNCH WITH \$100,000 GIFT** The American Association of Equine Practitioners has given \$100,000 to the National Thoroughbred Racing Association to support the NTRA's Spring '98 launch, it was announced yesterday by AAEP President Gary Norwood, D.V.M. Dr. Norwood said that in addition to the gift, \$25,000 of which was given by the AAEP as an organization and \$75,000 of which came directly from individual AAEP members, discussions were underway to establish an annual fee structure to provide ongoing support for the NTRA and its programs. The AAEP numbers more than 5,000 worldwide members.

**TRACK GAL RETIRED** **Track Gal** (Track Barron), who finished last in her most recent outing, the GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita Jan. 24, has been retired to Walmac International in Lexington, Kentucky and will be bred to Deputy Minister, according to Walmac's Kerry Cauthen. Cauthen said the seven-year-old mare, a multiple graded stakes winner of \$610,828 who won 13 of 25 starts including three consecutive runnings of the GIII Rancho Bernardo H. at Del Mar, is scheduled to be sold this fall in the Walmac consignment at the Keeneland November sale. Track Gal raced for a partnership of Robert Phipps and William Oldknow, who also bred the mare.

**Lil's Lad** (Pine Bluff), runner-up in last year's GI Champagne S., used his speed to dominate the opposition in Jan. 4 and Jan. 31 Gulfstream allowance races and could wire this field. "Lil's Lad is set," trainer Neil Howard said. "Knock on wood. Post positions don't mean a thing in a race like this. You have four horses and four world-class riders. It's going to be a rider's race." Trainer Shug McGaughey has been trying to teach **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner), who scored in last year's GII Remsen S., to relax after the colt's pre-race antics may have contributed to his second-place finish last time out in the Jan. 31 GII Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream in his three-year-old debut. "We're going with however the race shapes up," McGaughey said. "If Lil's Lad goes to the lead, we'll lay behind him. If not, we have enough natural speed of our own." Approval has been granted for the distribution of \$991,938 in 1997 supplemental awards to owners and breeders of New York-breds, the New York State Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund board announced Friday. Breeders will receive supplemental checks totalling \$232,869, while owners will be awarded \$759,069. In other action, the claiming level for owners' awards was lowered; owners will now receive awards when their New York-breds earn money in claiming races of \$30,000 or greater, down from \$35,000. The cap on owners awards for open company races was also raised from \$10,000 to \$20,000 per race.

**Local News, California:**

The California Horse Racing Board approved licenses Friday for two 1998 Thoroughbred meets in the state--the April 1-June 21 session conducted by the Pacific Racing Association at Golden Gate Fields and the April 24-July 20 meet at Hollywood Park. In other news, Commissioner Donald Valpredo, a member of the CHRB's Race Dates Committee, officially completed his second term as a commissioner Friday, ending his service on the Board.

**Local News, Hollywood Park:**

Hollywood Park Inc., which owns and operates Hollywood Park Race Track as well as Boomtown Inc., with casinos in Reno, Biloxi and New Orleans, has announced plans to merge with Casino Magic Corp. Under the terms of the signed merger agreement, Hollywood Park will acquire Casino Magic for a combination of cash and assumed debt with an aggregate value of approximately \$340 million. Casino Magic Corp. operates casinos, through subsidiaries, in Mississippi, Louisiana and Argentina. Hollywood Park will purchase in cash each share of Casino Magic common stock for \$2.27 per share. Casino Magic has approximately 35.7 million shares outstanding. Together, the combined companies will have six operating casinos in three states, two card club casinos in California and three racetracks. Completion of the merger is subject to various conditions, including Casino Magic shareholder approval and state licensing approvals.

**Local News, Santa Anita:**

Santa Anita Enterprises Inc., a subsidiary of The Santa Anita Companies, has filed plans with the city of Arcadia, California, for a 500,510-square-foot entertainment and commercial center and a 90,000-square-foot medical office building. The entertainment and commercial center, valued in excess of \$60 million, would include a 30-screen movie theater as well as retail stores and restaurants. If the Arcadia City Council votes to approve the plan, construction of the project could start as early as mid-1998.
