**FASIG-TIPTON CALDER OPENS TODAY** The juveniles entered in Fasig-Tipton's Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale took to the Calder track yesterday morning. Six two-year-olds shared the fastest one-furlong work. Hip number 3, a colt by Salt Lake--English Gal (London Bells) set a mark of :10.2 that was equalled by; hip number 9, a filly by Personal Hope--Falling Rain (Arctic Tern), hip number 201, a filly by Phone Trick--Sister Belle (Bravest Roman), hip number 249, a Belong to Me colt out of the Blade mare Twenty Six Girl, hip number 308, a filly by Meadowlake--Cassowary (Cormorant), and hip number 352, a filly by Pentelicus--Double Wiggle (Sir Wiggle). The fastest quarter-mile work was turned in by hip number 312. The colt, by Phone Trick--Caught a Pass (Pass Catcher), covered the distance in :21.3. Fasig-Tipton has catalogued 354 horses for the two-day sale. Sires who will be represented in the sales ring include, A.P. Indy, Deputy Minister, Forty Niner, Gilded Time, Holy Bull, Seeking the Gold, Storm Cat and Strike the Gold. The first session of the auction commences today at Calder Race Course at 7:30 p.m. The second session begins Tuesday at noon.

**FLORIDA DERBY REMATCH FOR FOUNTAIN RUNNERS** Each of the four runners who contested Saturday's GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Park will now be pointed towards the March 14 GI Florida Derby. Fountain of Youth victor **Lil's Lad** (Pine Bluff) came out of his first stakes win in good order, according to trainer Neil Howard. "He didn't seem too tired," Howard said. "We'll look towards the Florida Derby now." **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner), runner-up in the GII Hutcheson and again in the Fountain of Youth, should improve off Saturday's effort, according to trainer Shug McGaughey. "That horse (Lil's Lad) had a 1 1/16-mile race under him and we just had a seven-furlong race (the Hutcheson). I think we'll move forward now." Trainer Nick Zito was "impressed" with **Halory Hunter** (Jade Hunter)'s performance Saturday. "The way the track was playing--it wasn't conducive to closers," Zito explained. "I wouldn't have been surprised if he got beat by 30 lengths. It was amazing that he even got up there. He was only beat by about three lengths." **Cape Town** (Seeking the Gold) finished last in the four-horse Fountain of Youth field, but trainer D. Wayne Lukas was not discouraged. "As they say--it was a throw-out race for us," Lukas said. "He wasn't himself. He certainly wasn't the same horse he was winning the (GIII) Holy Bull S. We'll give him another chance in the Florida Derby."

Diamond On the Run, runner-up in last year's GI Mar-ton S. and GI Frizette S., encountered a rough trip when just missing by a head in the Jan. 28 GIII Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream in her seasonal debut. The favorite was reserved in the early going prior to moving up along the inside around the far turn and coming out at the top of the stretch to uncork a powerful rally which brought her to the front inside the furlong-pole. "I was in the middle of the pack," winning jockey Pat Day explained. "She broke well and was a little more enthusiastic today. Coming to the three-eighths pole, I had dead aim on them at the head of the stretch. When we went on by, she didn't go with authority. She had to work a little bit. That's just her." According to trainer Stanley Hough, the best from Diamond On the Run may be in the future. "She's just learning," He said. "She's a big, ranging filly. She'll go in the (GII) Bonnie Miss S. (March 16 at Gulfstream) next."

**MICHAEL ALAN MORPHY DEAD** Michael Alan Morphy, a pioneer in syndicating ownership of racehorses, died February 19 in Montecito, California, from a heart ailment. He was 65 years old. In the 1960s Morphy established Impossible Stables, Inc., which consisted of 30 shareholders. The owners never received a bill after their first investment because the horses, trained by Thomas A. Pratt, always paid their way. In later years, Morphy became an investor in Dogwood Stables and was a part-owner of 1990 Preakness S. winner Summer Squall. He was commissioner of equestrian sports for the Los Angeles Olympic Organizing Committee and served as president of the Oak Tree Foundation, which distributed funds generated from charity racing days conducted at Santa Anita by Oak Tree Racing Association. Funeral services will be held Monday, February 23 at All Saints Episcopal Church in Pasadena.

Hushion was pleased with his charge's effort. "This was a little surprising that she won so easily, but she did work freaky prior to this race," he said. "Her only two bad races, that I considered not up to her best, both came over off tracks."

Comic Strip won a Jan. 3 allowance event and ran second last time out in the Jan. 17 Gill Holy Bull S., both at Gulfstream. The second choice stalked front-running Time Limit, collared that rival at the furlong-marker, and fended off the late bid of Captain Maestri in the final strides. "Today, he broke so good and was a lot closer than usual," winning jockey Shane Sellers said. "It's not like him. I was surprised the way he came out of there. He started to relax better down the backside, and I just left him alone and let him run from there. When I called on him around the middle of the turn, he made a powerful run from there home." Trainer Neil Howard watched the simulcast of the race in the clubhouse at Gulfstream Park. Asked if he was worried about his colt being third at the quarter-pole, Howard said, "No. I'm glad Shane (Sellers) was aboard. He was concerned that he moved too early in his last race (the Holy Bull S.), and he wanted to wait to make his move to be sure he didn't hang this time. Shane was nervous from his flight. His plane got into New Orleans late because of the weather. He can relax now." Howard remarked that he is considering leaving Comic Strip at the Fair Grounds to contest the March 15 Gill Louisiana Derby. "It's nice," Howard said when asked about having two top Kentucky Derby prospects (he also trains Lil's Lad). "I want everything to go good. Yes, you have to be a little nervous." Favored Time Limit, who began his sophomore campaign in fine fashion with victories in the Jan. 4 Gill Spectacular Bid S. and the Jan. 31 Gill Hutcheson S., established the early pace of a half-mile in :47 but weakened in the stretch to finish third. "He tried to give his punch," jockey Jerry Bailey said, "but he couldn't get across the track as well as he did at the other track (Gulfstream). When he works twice as hard to get through the surface, he's going to get tired."

Funallover, running for a \$7,500 tag only six months ago, won three of four starts at Turf Paradise, then was sent to Santa Anita where she won the Survive S. over an off-track at odds of 34-1. She followed that with a third-place finish in the Feb. 8 Pro Or Con S. over another off-track in her last start. Funallover raced last for much of the race before charging to the front in deep stretch. "I think she really found herself the first time I ran her in Phoenix," said winning trainer Gene White. "I entered her for a \$7,500 claiming tag and just got beat and had a lot of trouble. She hasn't run a bad race since. I'll never run her for a tag again. I think that her improvement is just due to her maturing." Kent Desormeaux, riding second-place finisher Advancing Star, said, "She just had to settle for a head defeat by a horse that was just like a pig in mud." The 6-5 favorite MADAME PANDIT (Wild Again) never fired and finished sixth. "Everyone was thinking Advancing Star wouldn't like the track, but my mare didn't," explained jockey Eddie Delahoussaye on the beaten favorite.
