SAINT BALLADO COLT TOPS FASIG-TIPTON CALDER OPENER A colt by Saint Ballado--Hokum (Acaroid) topped yesterday's first session of the Fasig-Tipton Calder Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale in Miami, Florida. Selling as hip number 42, the dark bay two-year-old was consigned by Jerry Bailey Sales Agency, agent for Bailey-Ellenberg Select, and brought a final bid of \$400,000 from John Kimmel on behalf of George R. Melillo. "He fits many of our parameters," Kimmel said of the session topper. "We liked him physically, first of all, and we've been very impressed with how Saint Ballado has come up with horses that have classic aptitude. He scored out very well in his breeze and had a great cardiovascular assessment. We thought he would be one of those horses that would be around next spring." The colt will have three weeks of down time before joining Kimmel's stable at Belmont Park in April. The two-year-old is the second horse owned by Melillo, president and chief executive officer of the Pennsylvania-based pharmaceutical company Pharmflex. "My wife Sandra and I just got into the business and we plan to be players for a while," Melillo explained. "We are partners in life and in everything," he added. The couple's first horse, **Glitman** (Glitterman) was second in last year's GII Jim Dandy and GII Dwyer S. During last night's session, 55 horses sold for a total of \$6,441,000. That is down 11 percent from last year's figure of \$7,238,000 grossed from the sale of 64 two-year-olds. The average price of \$117,109 was up 3.6 percent from last year's average of \$113,094. The sale's final session begins today at noon.

Skip Away (Skip Trial) breezed five furlongs in :59 over a fast surface at Gulfstream Park yesterday under jockey Jerry Bailey in preparation for this Saturday's GI Gulfstream Park H. Skip Away made it on to the track before heavy rains and strong winds, which started after training began, forced the cancellation of training at 7:45 a.m. "We got him out there right before the rain," said trainer Sonny Hine. "Jerry said he wasn't blowing or anything. He said when the headwinds hit him turning for home, he had to lean down on him. He was amazed he went in :59 with all that wind." Hine's charge was assigned highweight of 127 pounds for the Gulfstream Park H. Said Hine, "I was looking at the history of the race. The last horse to carry 127 was Forego in 1974. The next highest weight (121) was Skip Trial, his daddy, in 1986. That should tell you something."

Glitter Woman (Glitterman), second in the Gill Shirley Jones H. in her second start this year, may make her next start in Sunday's Gill Rampart H., depending upon how she works this week, according to trainer Shug McGaughey. "I'm going to work her Wednesday or Thursday and if she does well, she'll go," said McGaughey. "If she just goes okay, probably not."
