HOUSTON HEADS WEST Houston (Seattle Slew-Smart Angle {Quadrangle}), who had stood at Walmac International in Lexington, Kentucky since his retirement from racing in 1990, will join the stallion roster at Getaway Farms in Romoland, California for the 1998 breeding season. The 12-year-old stallion is scheduled to arrive in California March 4 and will stand for a 1998 stud fee of \$3,500 if booked by March 31 or \$4,000 if booked after that date. A winner of five of 11 starts for earnings of \$240,632, Houston won the Gll Bay Shore S., Glll Derby Trial and Glll King's Bishop. He is the sire of multiple stakes winners Viv, Beloved Trick, Ticket to Houston and Houston Fleet.

BRUCE GARLAND NAMED NJSEA SR. VP/ RACING Confirming earlier reports, Bruce Garland was named Senior Vice President/Racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority at the NJSEA's board meeting yesterday. The board also appointed Chris McErlean Vice President, Meadowlands Racetrack and Standardbred Operations; and Robert J. Kulina Vice President, Monmouth Park and Thoroughbred Operations. Garland replaces Hal Handel, who accepted a position at Philadelphia Park earlier this month. "The Sports Authority has been fortunate enough to attract and develop the finest racing staff in the country," said Robert E. Mulcahy, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Sports Authority. "This made it easy for us to promote from within with full confidence."

SANTA ANITA TO HOST INTERNATIONAL JOCKEY CHALLENGE A team of four United States jockeys will take on a quartet of European riders in the Santa Anita International Jockey Challenge at the Arcadia, California racetrack Sunday, March 22. The inaugural edition of a team competition similar to golf's Ryder Cup, the challenge will pit competitors against one another in a one-day, four-race test with jockeys vying for points in four races on the program--one sprint and one route each on the dirt and turf. The races will be regular betting events, both domestically and in Europe. Team USA will be made up of Jerry Bailey, Eddie Delahoussaye, Laffit Pincay Jr. and Gary Stevens; Team Europe consists of Lanfranco Dettori, Kieren Fallon, Michael Kinane and Olivier Peslier. Bill Shoemaker will serve as captain for the U.S. team, while Lester Piggott captains the Europeans. The Arcaro Cup, a perpetual trophy, will mark each year's winning team.

Two-time champion **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) demonstrated that he is still on top of his game with a 2 3/4-length victory in the Feb. 7 GI Donn H. at Gulfstream in his 1998 debut and looks to add to a three-race GI winning streak here after victories in the Jockey Club Gold Cup, Breeders' Cup Classic and Donn. The five-year-old grey/roan horse will also be out to avenge a second-place finish in this race last year. Said trainer Sonny Hine, "In (last year's) Gulfstream Park Handicap, our horse went absolutely nuts. He wouldn't let us saddle him and he took three hours to cool out. We don't know what happened to the horse. I'd like to say we've done something different this year, but I think the horse has always been a great horse. He's just a year older now and stronger." Skip Away hopes to beat up on many of his Donn victims again, including: **Unruled** (Notebook), second in the Donn; **Sir Bear** (Sir Leon), third; **Wagon Limit** (Conquistador Cielo), fourth; and **Behrens** (Pleasant Colony), seventh. The oddsmaker has given Behrens the best chance of knocking off Skip Away based on a form last year which saw him capture the Gll Buick Pegasus H. and Gll Jim Dandy S. while missing by a nose in the GI Travers S. at Saratoga. Trainer H. Allen Jerkens has been called 'The Giant Killer' for his ability to defeat some of racing's greats. **Banker's Gold** (Forty Niner), winner of last year's Gll Peter Pan S. and a Feb. 18 Gulfstream allowance contest in his last start, could add to Jerkens' legacy if he can pull off the upset of Skip Away in this spot.

Local News, Dubai:

In only his second race ride back since his self-imposed exile from the saddle at the beginning of last year, Irish-born jockey Walter Swinburn landed his first winner since capturing the 1996 Breeders Cup Turf on Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent). Swinburn partnered **Ragsak Jameel** (Northern Baby) to an eight-length victory at Nad Al Sheba in Dubai Thursday. On his first ride back last Sunday, Swinburn finished second aboard **Annus Mirabilis (Fr)** (Warning {GB}) and will ride again at Nad Al Sheba Sunday, including **Amyas (Ire)** (Waaajib {Ire}) in the Dubai City Of Gold S., the first race to be run on the new turf course.

Local News, Australia:

1997 Foster's Melbourne Cup winner **Might And Power (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) makes his second start back since that famous victory last November when he contests today's highly competitive \$83,250 G2 St. George S., a weight-for-age event run over a mile and an eighth at Caulfield in Melbourne. Might And Power made an impressive comeback when narrowly beaten in the \$133,200 G1 C. F. Orr S. over seven furlongs at Caulfield February 14. Among those facing the Jack Denham-trained four-year-old gelding in the St. George will be the 1997 G1 Cox Plate heroine **Dane Ripper (Aus)** (Danahill), the 1995 Melbourne Cup winner and 1997 runner-up **Doriemus (NZ)** (Norman Pentaquad) and the former English-trained veteran **Always Aloof** (Alleged), who won the G1 Underwood S. earlier this season.

Progeny of champion sire Danahill dominate the field for today's \$666,001 G1 Blue Diamond S. over six furlongs at Caulfield, the most important prep race for the \$1,332,001 G1 Golden Slipper S. at Rosehill in Sydney April 4. In addition to the present Golden Slipper favorite, **Shovhog (Aus)**, the Coolmore Stud stallion will also be represented by the Lee Freedman-trained pair **Compulsion (Aus)** and **Danelagh (Aus)**.
