### FLAT FLEET FEET RETIRED Flat Fleet Feet

(Afleet) has been retired from racing and is heading to Kentucky to be bred. "She pulled a ligament in her leg in a work two days ago," explained the mare's trainer John Kimmel. "It didn't hurt her, but we made the decision to go on and retire her." Flat Fleet Feet captured the 1996 GI Delta Airlines Top Flight H., the 1995 GII Adirondack S. and the 1997 GIII Bed o' Roses Breeders' Cup H. The five-year-old finished second in the '97 GI Go for Wand S., '96 GI Test S. and '95 GI Spinaway. On the board in 19 of 23 starts, Flat Fleet Feet made seven trips to the winner's circle and earned \$727,041. In what would be her final start, the chestnut mare ran fourth in the GI Ballerina S. last August at Saratoga.

**BIG 'CAP DEVELOPMENTS** Multiple Grade I stakes winner **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois) prepared for his showdown with champion **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) in next Saturday's GI Santa Anita H. with a bullet six-furlong work in 1:10 3/5 at Hollywood Park yesterday. "He couldn't have looked better," trainer Richard Mandella said after the move. "He worked with a stablemate, stalked him and blew by him in the stretch. I am very happy with the workout." Mandella added this was Gentlemen's last work before the Big 'Cap and the six-year-old will now gallop up to the race. Mandella also reported **Refinado Tom (Arg)** (Shy Tom) is 50-50 to run in the Santa Anita H. after a bullet seven-furlong work in 1:24 3/5 Friday. William Lamaster has paid the initial \$2,500 first-stage supplementary fee for his **Da Bull** (Country Pine) to run in the Big 'Cap. The six-year-old is also entered in the March 7 GII Arcadia H. over the Santa Anita turf.

Skip Away confirmed his superstar status with eye-catching victories in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and GI Breeders' Cup Classic to close out his championship season and returned with an effortless win in the Feb. 7 GI Donn H. at Gulfstream. The prohibitive favorite sat just off the flank of front-running second-choice Behrens, swept by that rival around the far turn, and cruised home to pick up his fourth consecutive Grade I stakes triumph. "He really wanted to run today," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "I had to work to take him back off of Behrens. Skippy kinda wanted to run down the backside. I was content to let him 'cause I didn't really know how big of a turn Behrens would make. He (Skip Away) kind of loafs a little bit. Combining with a little bit of laziness and maybe that's what happened down the stretch. The package was kind of getting to him. It was a lot to carry, and he worked hard to get there." Trainer Sonny Hine had high praise for his charge. "I know that he's the best horse I've ever seen," Hine said. "My hope is that by the end of the year, everyone thinks that." Regrading the end of the race, Hine said, "He looked tired to me. I think the heat got to him. I was a little worried the last part of the race. He looked like he was really laboring. He struggled home (running a final quarter-mile in :28)." Hine indicated that Skip Away would bypass the April 4 GI Oaklawn H. and go next in the May 9 GI Pimlico Special.

Dance Parade, a graded stakes winner in England, was making her American debut and her first start since finishing 12<sup>th</sup> in the May '97 Newmarket 1000 Guineas. A winner of four-of-six in Europe, the chestnut filly took the lead at midstretch and gamely held off the late challenges of Shake the Yoke (GB) and favored Donna Viola (GB). "She's been touting me in her morning workouts that she is a real exceptional horse," said winning jockey Kent Desormeaux. Trainer Neil Drysdale, represented by his sixth winner from his last eight starters at Santa Anita, said, "I think she is good at a distance of one mile. If she relaxes more, she may be able to go further." Riding Shake the Yoke, who recovered from an awkward start to garner the runner-up spot, Eddie Delahoussaye said, "I got her back and got her to relax a little bit. She just got a little tired the last couple of jumps. She ran super race and hopefully, she'll continue to improve."

**Glitter Woman** (Glitterman), one of the top three-year-old fillies last year before her campaign was cut short by injury, easily captured her first four career starts over the Gulfstream main track before being upset last time out in the Feb. 8 Gill Shirley Jones H. as the 2-5 favorite. **Escena** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) ended 1997 with a third-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Distaff and just missed by a head in the Feb. 1 Gill Sabin H. to kick off her 1998 season. **Radiant Megan** (Commadore C.) has won two straight in South Florida, including the Sabin H. in her previous trip to the post.

**Souvenir Copy** (Mr. Prospector), winner of last year's GII Del Mar Futurity and GII Norfolk S., was a contender for an Eclipse Award prior to a fourth-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, and the well-bred colt kicked off his road to the Kentucky Derby with a runner-up performance in the Feb. 1 Gill Santa Catalina S. at Santa Anita. **Orville N Wilbur's** (Out of Place) was highly touted after capturing a pair of races at Hollywood by a combined 8 1/2 lengths, but weakened to finish fourth in the Feb. 7 GII San Vicente S. last time out in his stakes debut. "He's never been behind horses in his life," trainer Wally Dollase said after the San Vicente. "He's just green, that's all. He didn't like having dirt in his face." **Mr. Fortune** (Crafty Prospector), two-for-two lifetime, steps up in class here and may prove to be a late-comer to the Triple Crown scene if he can run well in this spot.

### Local News, Australia:

The 1997 Foster's Melbourne Cup winner **Might And Power (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) was sent off the 8-13 favorite in Saturday's nine furlong G2 St. George S. at Caulfield in Melbourne, but had to settle for second behind the Bart Cummings-trained four-year-old filly **Dane Ripper (Aus)** (Danehill). Might and Power was beaten 3/4 lengths, with 25-1 outsider **Rustic Dream (Aus)** (Rustic Amber {Ire}) 2 1/2 lengths back in third. Dane Ripper, a 33-1 upset winner in last October's G1 Cox Plate, is now the 9-4 second favorite for the G1 Australian Cup over a mile and a quarter at Flemington in Melbourne on March 9, a race for which Might And Power is still favored at 6-4.

Victory in Saturday's six-furlong G1 Blue Diamond S. for juveniles at Caulfield went to the Lee Freedman-trained 12-1 shot **Danelagh (Aus)** (Danehill), who beat the John Meagher-trained **Danari (Aus)** (Danehill) by a 1 1/4 lengths, with Freedman's colt **Piccadilly Circus (Aus)** (Royal Academy) 3/4 lengths back in third. Danari's rider Brett Prebble lodged a protest against Danelagh and the head-on film showed that the winner did veer in sharply and bump Danari, but the stewards ruled that the interference did not cost Danari victory. Race favorite **Shovhog (Aus)** (Danehill) finished fourth, while Freedman's filly **Compulsion (Aus)** (Danehill) was a late scratch with a high temperature.

Last season's champion juvenile **Encounter (Aus)** (Tierce {Aus}) won his fifth Group 1 race in the Futurity S. over seven furlongs at Caulfield Saturday. Trained by Clarrie Connors and ridden by Shane Dye, Encounter, will now aim for the G1 Chipping Norton S. over one mile at Warwick Farm March 7, the G1 George Ryder S. March 28 and the G1 Doncaster H. April 11.

The four-year-old mare **Fayreform (NZ)** (Tights) completed a hat-trick of Group 1 wins when she captured the G1 New Zealand S. over a mile and a quarter at Ellerslie in Auckland Saturday. Trained by Stephen Autridge, Fayreform, who had previous wins in the G1 Telegraph H. January 24 and the G1 International S. February 7, will stay in New Zealand and aim for a fourth straight G1 victory in the one-mile Easter H. at Ellerslie April 11.
