DEBARTOLO RACING CHALLENGE RETURNS

DeBartolo Racing announced it will offer a total of \$2.4 million in purses and bonuses for the DeBartolo Racing Challenge, a three-event series consisting of the major Derbies from each of the organization's three Thoroughbred tracks, Thistledown, Remington Park and Louisiana Downs. In its second year, the challenge offers a \$1 million "Sweeps Bonus" and a \$300,000 "Participation Bonus" for horses that compete in all three events: Thistledown's \$300,000 GII Ohio Derby, the \$300,000 Remington Park Derby and the \$500,000 GI Super Derby. The participation bonus will be awarded on a point system, with the winner of a single race earning 10 points, second--six points, third--four points and unplaced entrants earning one point. Horses that run in all three events and earn 22 or more points will share \$200,000 and horses earning 12 or more, but less than 22 points, will share \$100,000. "We feel we have put together an outstanding package that allows horsemen to compete in three premier racing events while offering attractive purse and bonus moneys," said John York, senior vice president of DeBartolo Racing. "We were extremely pleased last year...and we look for the DeBartolo Racing Challenge to become a prominent fixture in Thoroughbred racing." The Ohio Derby will be run July 19, Remington Derby August 30 and the Super Derby Sept. 27. With a nomination fee of \$300 before April 19, a horse can be automatically nominated to all three DeBartolo Racing Challenge events.

FAVORITE TRICK WORKS TOWARDS SWALE

Horse of the Year **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick) worked five furlongs in 1:03 2/5 at Payson Park for trainer Bill Mott yesterday. "He came home in :25," said Mott. "He's doing fine for the Swale." After asking who Favorite Trick would face in the March 14 GIII Swale S., Mott was told Francis C. McDonnell's **Southern Bostonion** (Silver Ghost), who was ridden to victory in the February 21 Great Navigator S. by Pat Day, was scheduled to go. Mott quipped, "I hope Pat doesn't make the wrong choice in which mount to take."

LORD AT WAR RECOVERING Wimborne Farm stallion **Lord at War (Arg)** (General {Fr}) sustained a deep to his hind leg Wednesday and is presently recuperating at Hagyard-Davidson-McGee equine hospital. No decision has been made on when the 18-year-old stallion will resume stud duties. A multiple graded-stakes winner in North America and champion miler in Argentina, Lord at War is the sire of Grade I stakes winners **La Gueriere** and graded stakes winner **War Thief, Added Asset, Lord Joe, Road of War, Patton** and **Cuando Puede**.

RAW GOLD RETIRED Multiple graded stakes-winner **Raw Gold** (Rahy), who has been winless in three starts in 1998, has been retired and will be bred to **Alphabet Soup** (Cozzene) this spring, according to her trainer, **David Hofmans**. Owned by **Ridder Thoroughbreds**, the five-year-old mare won nine of 29 starts on the racetrack, including the 1995 GII Landaluce S. at Hollywood and the 1996 GIII Santa Ynez at Santa Anita. She retires with earnings of \$509,005. "She has done everything she needs to do," said trainer **David Hofmans**, who also trained **Alphabet Soup**. "She's retiring sound."

◆ FOREIGN ◆

Local News, France:

According to published reports, courts in both France and Kentucky have declared that the now defunct insurance company **Equitania**, which holds a \$1.16 million accidental infertility policy on the 16-year-old stallion **Le Glorieux (GB)** (Cure the Blues), will have to pay off. **Le Glorieux**, a champion in Germany and winner of the 1987 GI Washington D.C. International, suffered a head injury in 1994 which has affected his balance, making it difficult for him to cover his mares and severely limiting his capacity to breed. **Equitania** argued that the stallion was not actually infertile and will appeal the decision, which was reached in France and upheld by a Fayette Circuit Court judge in Kentucky.

Local News, Australia:

New Zealand-trained three-year-old filly **Champagne (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}), winner of the first leg of the Australian Fillies Triple Crown, the **Angus Armanasco S.**, goes for the second leg, the \$333,000 A. V. Kewney S. over a mile and an eighth at **Flemington** in Melbourne this Saturday. Trained by **Laurie Laxon**, **Champagne** will again face the Lee Freedman-trained 1997 Victoria Oaks winner **Kensington Palace (Aus)** (Kingston Rule), whom she beat at **Caulfield**. If **Laxon's** filly should win Saturday, she will go on to the third leg of the series, and a chance to win a \$166,500 bonus, in the \$666,001 **Moonee Valley Oaks** at **Moonee Valley** in Melbourne on March 21.

Australia's two-day **Inglis Premier Yearling Sale**, starts next Thursday, March 12 at **Oaklands** in Victoria and will offer the progeny of several American-based shuttle stallions--**Brocco**, **Dehere**, **Honor Grades**, **Jade Hunter**, **Personal Hope**, **Quest For Fame (GB)** and **Regal Classic**. Best represented in terms of numbers are the former Canadian champion juvenile **Regal Classic** and GI Santa Anita Derby winner **Personal Hope**. The latter has six yearlings in the sale--four colts and two fillies--while the former has 12 representatives--six colts and six fillies. The sale also features three colts by deceased multiple champion sire **Sir Tristram (Ire)** and a colt and three fillies by his son **Zabeel (NZ)**, sire of 1997 Melbourne Cup winner **Might And Power (NZ)**.

Asked when Formal Gold would be back to the races Perry said, "I don't want to put a specific day or race on him. But, I'd like to have him racing in June."

Patrick Byrne said Frank Stronach's GSW **Black Cash** (Deposit Ticket) has taken well to his new surrounding at Hialeah. "He's really come around since I brought him over here," said Byrne. "He worked :48.4 the other day (Tuesday) for a half mile. I think we'll look for an allowance race at Keeneland and see how he does there. Byrne said he would leave a string of horses at Hialeah to race while he took a group back to Kentucky to be divided, for a time, between Keeneland and Churchill Downs.

D. G. Van Clief, Jr., interim chief executive officer of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, announced yesterday that, based on signed membership agreements with 41 racetracks, the NTRA has received the support of 80 percent of the tracks in North America. The level of support already exceeds most projections and the group is in negotiations with the majority of remaining tracks. Van Clief also reports significant progress on membership agreements with horsemen's associations, tote companies, sales companies, stallion farms, equine veterinarians and other associate members. "This is a clear demonstration of the broad-based support the NTRA has generated and is a further sign of the continued momentum of the NTRA as we move to the April 1 public launch."
