### STABLEMATE STUNS GENTLEMEN IN BIG 'CAP

Trainer Richard Mandella was in the winner's circle after yesterday's GI Santa Anita H., but he was standing beside the wrong horse. Bet down to 1-20 after the defection of Silver Charm, **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois) was expected to have an easy time of it in the Big 'Cap, but after shadowing stablemate **Malek (Chi)** (Mocito Guapo {Arg}) for a half and taking a short lead after six furlongs, the favorite faded badly to finish last. Malek, the second choice at 5-1 in the four-horse field, regained the lead and outfinished 13-1 **Bagshot** (Smokester) to win by a half-length. "I'm as stunned as anybody," said Mandella. "What's wrong with (Gentlemen), I don't know. It's very disappointing. Physically, as far as soundness, I'm sure he's all right. Obviously, past the first five furlongs, he wasn't himself." Jockey Pat Day, aboard Gentlemen for the first time, could offer no excuses. "He felt good," he said. "He warmed up great, went to the gate good. He was wanting to drift out just a touch around the first turn, but not uncontrollably, just kind of hanging on the left rein. I felt we were comfortably placed, but he never put his ears up and looked happy. When I called on him, he gave me a short burst and then went to floundering. Leaving the three-eighths pole, I felt I was in serious trouble. He was laboring. What can I say? I think when they get him back to the barn and check him over, there is going to be something. Just what, I don't know. But this was not the same Gentlemen that we saw run here in the San Antonio three weeks ago." Malek, a champion in Chile, was making his third start in the U.S. and his first since running second in the GII San Pasqual H. January 10. "He's a class horse, you can see it by looking at him," said Mandella. "His last race, he was a good second and came up with a blood blister in his frog. He had a right to improve a lot." The trainer will now leave Gentlemen at home, flying his latest South American star Malek to the United Arab Emirates for the Dubai World Cup March 28.

Coming off a six-length victory in the GII San Antonio H. February 7 and with a record of three wins in four starts at this distance, **GENTLEMEN (ARG)** (Robin des Bois) looked to have the Big 'Cap in his back pocket before the gates opened, but ran out of gas after a mile and finished last, eight lengths behind his barn mate, **Malek (Chi)**. The two raced as a team early, with Malek setting the pace through a half in :47 and Gentlemen putting a head in front after six furlongs in 1:11. But the crowd's choice was finished after a mile, dropped back in the drive and was edged for third at the wire by longshot **Don't Blame Rio**.

"There's no sense in trying to imagine what happened," said trainer Richard Mandella, who also saddled the winner. "The skin rash settled down nicely, and I can't imagine it would have affected him. He should have been two in front and really in hand, and he wasn't. We won't go to Dubai with him." The winner, however, will head to the Middle East after his upset victory. "He won today against his style," said Mandella of Malek. "He much prefers to run at something. In his races in Chile, he's always been off the pace." Added winning jockey Alex Solis, "I really thought around the turn that (Gentlemen) was going to kick in, but he never did. That's horse racing. It's kind of sad, I know, for a lot of people to see a horse like Gentlemen get beat. But this is my job. It's a bit like when I beat Cigar (with Dare And Go in the 1996 Pacific Classic). It's a great feeling, but a little bit strange, too."

Buck's Boy won the Oct. 11 GIII Hawthorne Gold Cup on dirt before returning to the grass to finish fourth in the Nov. 8 GI Breeders' Cup Turf. He started his '98 campaign on the grass as well, finishing second in the Feb. 14 GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. last time out. Making his second start off a three-month break, the third choice showed his usual early speed and had enough left in the tank to hold off a bid from African Dancer in the final stages. "He was going well within himself," winning jockey Earlie Fires said. "(The fractions) may have been fast, but it really wasn't that fast when you look at the final time of the race, I guess. He's a pretty little horse. Every time they eased up to me, he kinda picked it up on his own. That was what was good." Buck's Boy established a new course record of 2:23 2/5, eclipsing the old mark of 2:24 set by Fraise when winning the 1992 GI Breeders' Cup Turf. Favored FLAG DOWN (Deputy Minister) raced wide the entire way and was no factor in the stretch.

**GATE DANCER DEAD** Classic winner Gate Dancer (Sovereign Dancer), who captured the 1984 Preakness S. in stakes and track-record time and earned more than \$2.5 million, was humanely destroyed Friday morning at Silverleaf Farms in Summerfield, Florida after a battle with laminitis. The 17-year-old stallion, also winner of the GI Super Derby, was third in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic in 1984 and second in the event the following year. From eight crops to race, he has sired 21 stakes winners and the earners of more than \$12 million. He will be buried at Dean and Peggy Johnson's Johnson Hollow Farm in Oxford, Florida.

Looking for his third straight victory, Reality Road was coming off an impressive five-length score in the Gill Tanforan H. at Bay Meadows January 31. The dark bay sat just off the leaders through the opening fractions, swept to the lead on the final bend and easily held off the late charge of Gold Land under jockey Chris McCarron. "He ran his heart out," said trainer Craig Dollase. "I took the blinkers off him today and it really relaxed him. He's a push-button horse. There's a lot of options with a horse like this." The 6-5 favorite ANET (Clever Trick), fourth in the Reb's Policy H. following a five-month layoff last out, was caught in traffic at the top of the stretch, found a hole to squeeze through late in the lane and just missed getting third in a three-way photo. GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner ELMHURST (Wild Again) was last until the top of the stretch and made up some ground in the drive to finish sixth.

Brushing Up, winner of a Jan. 19 Aqueduct allowance event three starts ago, was a dull fifth in a Feb. 28 Aqueduct allowance in his prior start. Dismissed as the longest price on the board this time, the bay horse was rated along the inside, advanced up the rail around the second turn, moved clear in the stretch and just held on near the wire. "I just followed the other horses until they got tired," winning jockey Julio Pezua said. "I kept him a little closer today than before." Trainer Victor Simone praised his horse's durability. "He's a very consistent horse," Simone said. "He's run at 17 different tracks, and he's taken 15 different checks. What happened in the race is what I hoped would happen: that the horses up front would tire and we would be able to sit off the pace." Simone plans on keeping the winner in New York, but was unsure where he would run next.
