GENTLEMEN BLED IN BIG 'CAP Gentlemen (Arg) (Robin des Bois), fourth and last as the 1-20 favorite in Saturday's GI Santa Anita H., bled during the race, assistant trainer Gary Mandella reported Sunday morning. "We scoped him when he got back to the test barn, and the bleeding was significant," he said. "Obviously, it's something we're going to have to deal with in the future. My dad (trainer Richard Mandella) and (veterinarian) Rick Arthur are going to have to come up with a plan on how to stop it. The good news is physically he looked very sound, and we're happy with that." The six-year-old was scheduled to undergo lung X-rays and a blood test Sunday. As for the future, the assistant said, "Until we find out more, everything is on hold."

SILVER CHARM POSSIBLE FOR OAKLAWN Trainer Bob Baffert said yesterday that he will nominate **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) to the GI Oaklawn H. April 4 after being forced to skip the GI Santa Anita H. with the colt due to a bruised foot. "We're going to look at the Oaklawn H., but we have to see how the horse is doing," he said. "We've got to get that foot healed up." Baffert emphasized that his Eclipse champ is not seriously injured. "He's got a bruised heel, that's it," he said. "It's not that bad, it didn't need X-rays, a scan or anything. But I couldn't take any chances (running him in the Big 'Cap)."

GRAND SLAM TO GOTHAM? MGISW Grand Slam (Gone West), out of action since suffering severe lacerations to his left hind leg in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, could make his three-year-old bow in the GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct March 21. "It looks like the Gotham--I don't know what else to do," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He'll work three-quarters (this week). If he's tight enough, we'll look at the race, but it's not the perfect situation. It's the middle of March and he's just getting ready to go to the races. The conditioning factor is a concern, but he's a seasoned professional with two Grade I wins under his belt." Grand Slam captured both the GI Futurity and GI Champagne S. at two.

 South American Toda Una Dama (Arg) was coming off a second-place finish to Exotic Wood in the GI Santa Maria H. at 1 1/16 miles Feb. 14. Sent off at 3-1 in that race and beaten eight lengths, the dark bay was given little chance of turning the tables this time, but stunned the crowd and the favorite, closing with a rush at the top of the stretch to get to the lead in the final strides. The mare gave trainer Ron McAnally his sixth Santa Margarita victory in the last 10 runnings. "I thought we had a little chance, but I didn't know if we could beat (Exotic Wood), she's a super filly," said McAnally. "This filly has never had any physical problems, but she has had some mental problems. In the paddock today, we had to change her girth because it was too small. By the time they brought me another one, she started to shake and get nervous. She's very kind, though, never mean." Jockey Goncalino Almeida, aboard the winner for the first time, added, "I just followed McCarron (on Exotic Wood) the whole way, and she just outgamed the other horse in the stretch. It's hard to believe she paid so much." The payoff of \$66.60 was the highest since this race became an invitational in 1968. The runner-up, coming off back-to-back Grade I wins, stalked the pace, assumed the lead as they straightened into the stretch, but couldn't hold on. "She didn't have any excuse," said her jockey, Chris McCarron. "She relaxed very well and had plenty in reserve when the real running started at the quarter pole, but she couldn't sustain that run inside the sixteenth pole. She felt fine, but she was a little tired." The top two are expected to meet again in the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn April 10.

Colonial Play, a three-length winner of a Feb. 1 Gulfstream turf allowance race, finished sixth last time out in the Feb. 15 Gill Suwannee River H. after steady around the far turn. Ignored at the windows despite that troubled trip, the upset winner raced in the middle of the pack at the outset, rallied on the outside around the far turn, gained command in the stretch and inched away late. "It really set up well for us," winning jockey Robbie Davis said. "I was worried about not having a lot of pace in the race. But, sure enough, the turf has firmed up a bit and the pace has been real strong. I got a real horrible trip with her last time out. I was working my way to the outside and every time I got there, somebody shut the door on us. I couldn't really let her run until the last 70-80 yards. Today, we gave her free sailing and she finished up strong." Trainer Scotty Schulhofer indicated the winner would ship to Kentucky for her next start. Heading the 6-5 favored entry in her American debut, French Group 1 winner QUEEN MAUD (IRE) (Akarad {Fr}), 15th in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in her most recent start last October, pressed the early pace and tired to finish seventh. "She was just rank," said her jockey, Jerry Bailey. "When she was fighting that filly (pacesetter SHEMOZZLE {IRE} {Shirley Heights (GB)}), I knew she wouldn't have anything to finish with."

Phantom On Tour, winner of last year's Gill Rebel S. at Oaklawn, saw his sophomore campaign end with a sixth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby, the only time he has ever finished worse than second. He came back to run second by a nose in a Jan. 2 allowance race at the Fair Grounds, won the Feb. 1 Crabapple S. at Oaklawn and was beaten a neck last time out in Feb. 21 Gill Essex H. at Oaklawn. The consistent colt, third choice here, stalked the early leaders three-wide down the backside, ranged up to challenge turning for home, took over in mid-stretch and held off Precocity in the final stages. "He's the kind of horse that always breaks well and stays up there close to the leaders," said winning jockey Larry Melancon. "When I asked him, he really kicked it in." Added trainer Lynn Whiting, "He has shown a fondness for this racetrack. He handles the track here very well, and he never throws in a bad race." The 4-5 favorite DEPUTY COMMANDER (Deputy Minister) seemed to have no excuses. The four-year-old was reserved in the early stages and failed to respond in the drive to finish a dull seventh, 11 lengths behind the winner.

MALEK INVITED TO DUBAI Malek (Chi) (Mocito Guapo {Arg}), upset winner of Saturday's G1 Santa Anita H. over stablemate Gentlemen (Arg), has been officially invited to the \$4 million Dubai World Cup March 28. "We got a fax last night and...I think my father's intention is to run," said Gary Mandella, assistant to his father, trainer Richard Mandella. The five-year-old, a champion in Chile at two, has been first or second in 13 of his 15 career starts. In his two U.S. appearances prior to the Big 'Cap, the bay captured a Hollywood allowance race which was taken off the turf and finished second in the GII San Pasqual H.

MOUAWAD SOLD Last season's champion three-year-old colt **Mouawad (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}), who failed as a stallion at Glenlogan Park in Queensland after getting only one of his 33 mares in foal, was sold for \$382,950 at public auction at Saturday's Doomben race meeting in Queensland. The full-brother to the former Horse Of The Year Octagonal (NZ) was purchased for \$266,400 as a yearling. He went on to win seven of his eight lifetime starts, including three at the Group 1 level, and earned \$516,454 before being retired with a serious tendon injury. He was syndicated for stud duties at a value of \$2,664,003. Now four, the colt was bought by Magic Millions Sales Director Don Hancock, who was acting for an unidentified Hong Kong-based bidder rumored to be W. P. Cheung's Domeland Pty Ltd., which has a major investment in Australian racing and has horses with Mouawad's former trainer, Clarrie Connors.
