**SECRETARIAT ANNIVERSARY PLANNED** The 25th anniversary of Secretariat's legendary run to the Triple Crown is being commemorated this spring in a celebration that will be launched at Churchill Downs, the site of his stirring victory in the 99th Kentucky Derby in 1973. Through support of Visa U.S.A., the sponsor of the \$5 million Visa Triple Crown Challenge, and Churchill Downs, Pimlico Race Course and Belmont Park, the Secretariat 25th Anniversary Celebration will include a traveling historic display and interactive kiosk that commemorates Secretariat's Triple Crown campaign and career. Contained in the kiosk will be trophies, racing silks and other memorabilia along with a video presentation on Secretariat's racing career. The celebration also will include "Fan Appreciation Days" at each of the Triple Crown tracks, the release of a commemorative poster and the sale of officially licensed merchandise bearing the official logo of the Secretariat 25th Anniversary Celebration. Profits from the sale of that merchandise will go to the Grayson Jockey Club Foundation and other industry-related charities. "Secretariat has an enormous number of loyal fans around the world and I'm thrilled to be a part of this celebration of the life of this special horse that means so much to so many people," said Mrs. Penny Chenery, who managed Secretariat's career as he ran in the blue-and-white blocked racing colors of her Meadow Stable. "It has been 25 years since his Triple Crown and nearly a decade since his death, but almost every day I receive new fan mail for him or someone mentions what an incredible and special horse he was."

### WINTER WEATHER THWARTS MIDWEST

**TRACKS** Turfway and Sportsman's Parks were both forced to cancel their live racing cards yesterday. It was the third straight day of cancellations for Sportsman's Park in Cicero, Illinois after a severe snowstorm moved through the area earlier in the week. In the wake of the storm, portions of the plant and stable area remain without power. Today is a scheduled dark day, but the track will remain open for full-card simulcasting. Live racing is scheduled to resume Friday. Turfway Park officials canceled the Kentucky track's Wednesday night card in expectation of record cold temperatures and high winds. It was the sixth missed day of the meet. Live racing is scheduled to resume at Turfway tonight, with a first post time of 7 p.m. Also cancelling racing yesterday due to the cold temperatures was Ohio's Beulah Park.

**(News cont.)****ATLANTIC CITY SEEKS ABBREVIATED '98**

**MEET** In what will probably be its last meet, Atlantic City Race Course has requested that its 1998 season be cut to five days, according to a report on *Thoroughbred Times On-Line*. "In all likelihood, this will be our last live racing, unless there is a legislative miracle," Atlantic City President James Murphy told the *Times*. "Without slot machines we cannot continue live racing." The five-day meet would run from May 26 through May 30. The New Jersey track would remain open through the year for simulcasting with proceeds going to support purses at Monmouth Park, the Meadowlands and Garden State Park. Murphy added that the track would not run its GI Caesars International H.

**Local News, Australia:**

Three of Coolmore Stud's new stallions for 1998, **Desert King (Ire)** (Danehill), **Entrepreneur (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Spinning World (Nureyev)**, will join the stud's shuttle team, led by **Woodman** (Mr. Prospector), to the Southern Hemisphere later this year. Desert King was the first horse in more than 20 years to achieve the Irish 2000 Guineas and Irish Derby double and was officially rated the second-best three-year-old in the Northern Hemisphere behind Peintre Celebre in 1997. Entrepreneur won the 1997 English 2000 Guineas at Newmarket and Spinning World captured the 1996 Irish 2000 Guineas.

**Local News, England:**

England's first two Classics of 1998, the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas over a mile at Newmarket Saturday, May 2 and the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas for fillies over the same distance and track Sunday, May 3, have attracted total entries of 77 and 69 respectively. Heading the 2000 Guineas entries are Prince Khaled Abdullah's ante-post favorite **Xaar (GB)** (Zafonic), last season's European champion juvenile trained in France by Andre Fabre, and Michael Tabor's **Second Empire (Ire)** (Fairy King), trained by Aidan O'Brien. The Maktoums' Godolphin team has 14 representatives on the list, while former champion trainer Henry Cecil has 10, including multiple-group winner **Daggers Drawn (Diesis {GB})**. Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's G1 Cheveley Park S. winner **Embassy (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), the ante-post favorite, heads the entries for the fillies Classic, along with the Luca Cumani-trained **Glorosia (Fr)** (Bering {GB}).
