DERBY A 'LONGSHOT' FOR CORONADO'S

QUEST Coronado's Quest (Forty Niner), fifth in Saturday's GI Florida Derby as the 2-1 second choice, returned from the race in good shape but will most likely no longer be pointed toward the May 2 GI Kentucky Derby, according to trainer Shug McGaughey. The three-year-old colt, who has made bad behavior a habit, froze, reared and wheeled leaving the Gulfstream tunnel en route to the track for Saturday's race. "I said earlier that if he won the Florida Derby and the Blue Grass S. but I still wasn't happy with his behavior, we wouldn't go to the (Kentucky) Derby," said McGaughey. "I'm worried about the paddock area there. I think with his pedigree, his antics are just something we're going to have to live with. I think if I schooled him in the paddock 1,000 times in a row, it wouldn't help. He's by Forty Niner--it's just something we'll have to live with." Coronado's Quest will now be pointed to the April 11 Gil Wood Memorial at Aqueduct, but a victory there still might not prompt McGaughey to send the colt to Churchill Downs. Connections of the top three Florida Derby finishers--**Cape Town** (Seeking the Gold), **Lil's Lad** (Pine Bluff) and **Halory Hunter** (Jade Hunter)--all confirmed that the April 11 Gil Toyota Blue Grass at Keeneland would be next for their charges. The 1997 Horse of the Year **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick), the winner of Saturday's GIII Swale S. in his '98 debut, came out of the race in good shape and is also expected to head to the Blue Grass. "He came back great and cooled out well," said Ralph Nicks, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "He was back on the van to Payson (Park) even before the Florida Derby."

FASIG-TIPTON TEXAS OPENS TODAY The Fasig-Tipton Texas Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale returns to Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie today. In March 1997, Lone Star Park hosted the inaugural Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale before the track's first season of racing. "Last year was a great start," commented Tim Boyce, Texas sale director for Fasig-Tipton Company. "But this year, we are looking at a sale that should offer twice as many horses and better quality." Stallions represented by the 543 catalogued two-year-olds include Black Tie Affair (Ire), Clever Trick, Colonial Affair, Cure the Blues, Marquetry, Meadowlake, Smile, Spend a Buck, Runaway Groom, Strike the Gold and Technology. Both the Monday and Tuesday sessions of the sale begin at 10 a.m.

Hedonist, the least experienced runner in the field, followed her Jan. 17 winning debut with a five-length score in a Feb. 7 off-the-turf allowance last time out. Making her stakes debut, the filly sprinted out to grab the early lead, began to inch clear in the stretch and gamely held off the late rush of Keeper Hill and Nijinsky's Passion. "We've liked her all along," winning trainer Randy Bradshaw said of his lightly raced filly. "She got sick last spring and we just had to take a lot of time with her. We've had some problems off and on with her feet, but they're really good right now. Hopefully, that's all behind her." Bradshaw said Hedonist would run next in the April 4 GI Ashland S. at Keeneland followed by the May 1 GI Kentucky Oaks. The Santa Anita Oaks win capped a big week-end for Bradshaw. The conditioner sent out ARTAX (Marquetry) to win the GII San Felipe S. Saturday and took the Crystal Water H., the Oaks supporting feature, with SURACHAI (Slewpy). The 7-5 Oaks favorite STAR OF BROADWAY (Broad Brush) produced a mild rally before tiring to sixth. "It was pretty obvious it wasn't her day by the way she went to the gate," said Gary Stevens on the beaten favorite. "She just washed out and completely came unwound. She had like a mental breakdown."

After finishing second to eventual Florida Derby winner **Cape Town** (Seeking the Gold) in the Jan. 17 GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream, Comic Strip came back to win the Risen Star S. at this track February 22. Close to the pace that day, he came away from the break last here, and seemed content to let GII Hutcheson winner **TIME LIMIT** (Gilded Time) take the field into the first turn. Down the backstretch, **COWBOY DAN** (Walesa) dragged his rider past Time Limit, and those two raced in that order until Time Limit took the lead back heading into the far turn, while Comic Strip remained in ninth. At the eighth pole, Comic Strip started to pick up horses as Time Limit began to fade. By the sixteenth pole, he had Nite Dreamer left to collar, and just did get past that rival. **DIXIE DYNAMO** (Dixie Brass), midpack early, broke down on the far turn and was humanely destroyed. Winning jockey Shane Sellers, who was aboard Florida Derby winner Cape Town Saturday, said he didn't intend to let the field get so far ahead of him early. "I was concerned," said Sellers, "but they pretty much got away from me. They went a little quicker than I anticipated. I kind of went for broke and said hopefully I'll get 'em late. He made a powerful run through the stretch and showed them what he's all about. (Dixie Dynamo) broke down right in front of me and I had to snatch my horse up and just did get him going again." Comic Strip's win had to make trainer Neil Howard feel better after Lil's Lad's disqualification in Saturday's Florida Derby. Of Comic Strip, Howard said, "He has established himself as a one-run horse and that's what he needs."

FAIR GROUNDS BOOSTS PURSES, FIVE STAKES

Fair Grounds has announced it will raise purses for the fourth time at the current meeting, effective Thursday, March 19. All purses, excluding stakes races, will be raised by \$3,000, making the minimum claiming purse now worth \$13,000, with top allowances now at \$43,000. In addition, five of the season's remaining stakes purses have also been raised. The March 29 GIII Explosive Bid H. received the biggest increase, with its value climbing from \$200,000-added to \$300,000-added. Additional stakes increases include: the March 22 Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H. has been boosted from \$125,000-added to \$150,000-added. The March 21 Victoria Lass H. and the March 28 Gentilly H. have been increased from \$75,000-guaranteed to \$100,000-guaranteed, while the Red Camelia H., to be run closing day, March 30, went from \$60,000-guaranteed to \$75,000-guaranteed. "Off-track betting has been the key," said Director of Racing and Racing Secretary Mervin Muniz. "We continue to do well in all the markets."
