**EVEN DOZEN LIKELY FOR DUBAI** It looks like a field of 12 will line up for the March 28 \$4 million Dubai World Cup at Nad Al Sheba, according to a report in today's *Sporting Life*. American runner **Behrens** (Pleasant Colony) is scheduled to join countrymates **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) and **Malek (Chi)** (Mocito Guapo {Arg}) in Dubai today. Also expected is **Kyoto City (Jpn)** (Soccer Boy {Jpn}) from Japan, due in Wednesday, and France's **Loup Sauvage** (Riverman), who will ship in Saturday. **Oxalagu (Ger)** (Lagunas {GB}) and **Borgia (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}), the German challengers; **Dance Design (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Oscar Schindler (Ire)** (Royal Academy), from Ireland; and British rep **Luso (GB)** (Salse) have already settled in at Nad Al Sheba. The United Arab Emirates will have two runners, both owned by the Godolphin Stable--**Swain (Ire)** (Nashwan) and **Predappio (GB)** (Polish Precedent).

**SUFFOLK JOCKS TAKE CARE OF THEIR OWN** Jockeys at Suffolk have started a voluntary contribution plan to aid fellow riders who become sick or injured. Each rider will contribute \$5 a week to the fund, augmenting a little-known but longstanding policy of donating their "mount money" whenever a rider needs assistance. The entire colony donated their March 15 "mount money," the \$35 a Suffolk Downs jockey earns for each ride, to Amy Dross, who suffered a back injury in a spill March 14. Dross is recovering from vertebrae damage at Massachusetts General Hospital. The donated money, in addition to any which comes in from insurance, the Jockeys' Guild or the Don MacBeth Fund, will be used to help defray medical expenses. "We take care of each other," said jockey Josiah Hampshire Jr. "We've taken up collections and done things like this for a long time. We just kept quiet about it, because publicity isn't the reason we do it. We're competitive, but we care about each other." Hampshire himself suffered a fractured ankle in a spill in September, and his fellow riders collected \$725 for him. "Thankfully, I didn't need it," he said. "But then Jose (Caraballo) came up with the idea that whenever we raise money and it's not put to immediate use, it should go into a special fund for when it is needed." The \$5 weekly donations will also be used to make sure there is always something available in the fund.

A distant seventh in her lone start at two, Banshee Breeze came back running after more than seven months on the sidelines, breaking her maiden, then galloping to an eight-length victory in an allowance at Gulfstream March 1. Jumping right into the graded ranks and favored off that effort, the bay sat behind the leaders to the top of the stretch, shot through an opening at the head of the lane and wore down Santaria while lugging in through the final furlong. "That was something special," said winning rider Randy Romero. "I had so much confidence in her. I was just hoping to get running room...around the turn, I saw a hole and I had enough horse to go through real quick. When I called on her, she came a runnin'." Trainer Carl Nafzger admitted he had to be talked into running in this spot. "(Gulfstream Stakes Coordinator) Doug Bredar told me she belonged in there," he said. "I guess she did belong. A little more seasoning would have been nice, but she ran like she's been doing it all her life. Randy gave her a beautiful ride." Plans for the filly's future have not yet been set. Second choice UANME (Marquetry), winner of the GIII Forward Gal S. and runner-up in the GII Davona Dale in her two-turn bow last out, made a bid from midpack on the final turn but weakened late to be sixth.

Working in :21 4/5 were: hip #1, a filly by **Fortunate Prospect**--Cabildo Lake (Rainy Lake); hip #66, a filly by **Brocco**--Empress of Love (Czaravich); hip #93, a filly by **Valid Appeal**--Go Go Bride (Classic Go Go) named **Bride's Appeal**; hip #117, a colt by **Marquetry**--Intrepid Trek (Damascus); and hip #176, a filly by **End Sweep**--Miss Biscuit (Rich Cream) named **Sweeping Biscuit**. **CAPTAIN MAESTRI INJURED** Three-year-old **Captain Maestri** (Dynaformer), third in Sunday's GIII Louisiana Derby, came out of the race with a fractured right front cannon bone and will be out of action for at least four months. "After he cooled out, he was limping. He leaves (Monday) night for the Priest and Harthill Equine Clinic in Lexington, where he will have surgery," said Bobby Kelly, assistant to owner/trainer Louie Roussel III. Churchill Downs Incorporated (Nasdaq: CHDN) yesterday reported record basic and diluted earnings per share of \$2.50 for the fiscal year ended Dec. 31, 1997, an increase of 15 percent over last year. Net income was \$9,148,560 for fiscal year 1997, an increase of 13 percent over 1996. The earnings boost came on revenues of \$118,907,367, a 10-percent increase over 1996 levels. The 1997 results mark the fifth consecutive year of record earnings. "We believe our growth demonstrates that Churchill Downs is being viewed as the premier brand of racing in North America," said Robert L. Decker, Senior Vice President, Finance & Development & Chief Financial Officer.
