EVENT OF THE YEAR ROLLS ON **Event of the Year** (Seattle Slew) kept his record unblemished and propelled himself into the upper echelon of Kentucky Derby contenders with a dominating five-length win in yesterday's GII Jim Beam S. at Turfway Park. The lightly raced colt, making only his fourth start, took the GIII El Camino Real Derby at Bay Meadows last time out and ventured outside of Northern California for the first time in his career to add a second graded victory. The Jim Beam was postponed one day after high winds knocked down three utility poles and cut electricity to the track on Saturday, but the extra wait didn't bother the precocious Event of the Year. The 3-5 favorite stalked the early leaders before powering to the front at the top of the stretch and drawing off with ease. "When I wheeled him out in the clear there, he was so relaxed I had to slap him a couple times on the shoulder," said winning rider Russell Baze. "But when I called on him, he came running and I knew no one would catch me." Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer added, "It was a very strong finish and I think he's pretty legitimate and he's going to get a shot at the Kentucky Derby." Event of the Year will head straight to Louisville for the May 2 Derby. The race was marred when two horses broke down in separate incidents. **Time Limit** (Gilded Time), winner of the GII Hutcheson S., sustained a compound fracture of his left ankle and was euthanized. **Sorcerer** (Summer Squall) suffered a condylar fracture of his left fore cannon bone and was transported to Lexington for surgery. "I'm crestfallen," said Shane Sellers, rider of second choice Time Limit. "It's the horses that make this game. One minute we were going along and the next thing I knew, he was on the ground and so was I."

GRAND SLAM LAST IN COMEBACK **Grand Slam** (Gone West) pressed the pace early before tiring to finish sixth and last as the 7-5 favorite in yesterday's 6 1/2-furlong San Pedro S. at Santa Anita. The three-year-old colt, winner of last year's GI Champagne and GI Futurity, had not raced since suffering a severe gash on his leg in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile last November. "He obviously needed the race," said Mike Marlow, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He was in perfect position early, he just needed it, that's all. We thought we had him a little tighter than that, but obviously we didn't. It will move him up." The race was won by last year's GIII Best Pal S. winner **Old Topper** (Gilded Time), making his first start since last October. *For complete San Pedro S. results, see page 6.*

Event of the Year won his debut by 5 1/2 lengths last October and returned for a six-length Feb. 8 allowance win before taking the March 7 GIII El Camino Real Derby by 3 1/2 lengths. The heavy favorite stalked the pacesetters early, charged to the front in upper stretch and drew off with authority. "I had a perfect trip laying close to the leaders," said winning rider Russell Baze. "He's maturing quite well. We take him to the backside, let him stand, he takes a deep breath, relaxes and is ready to go. He's an awesome horse. He does everything so easy." Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer was equally impressed with his young charge. "He was very strong--especially down the lane," Hollendorfer said. "I think he can do more. He has calmed down a lot. He came along a little slower than most, had a few problems. That's why we took our time with him, spaced his races out. I never got to see Seattle Slew run but he's obviously thrown a lot of nice horses." The 17-1 outsider Yarrow Brae dueled for the early lead and held on for the place spot.

Panama Canal, not originally entered for last Sunday's snow-delayed Next Move, was off for five months after a fourth-place effort in the Gill Cotillion last fall at Philadelphia Park and returned to run second in her turf debut in a Feb. 26 Gulfstream allowance in last out. The filly, always on or near the lead, opened a half-length lead at the top of the stretch and drew off to the wire. "She hurt herself in her previous start at Philadelphia Park and we're still not quite sure how it happened, but she needed 80 stitches on her left front," explained Ellee Diamond, assistant to winning trainer Mark Hennig. "She missed about two months of training." The win gave apprentice jockey Shaun Bridgmohan his first stakes victory. "It's an awesome feeling to win my first stakes race and I just thank Mark for giving me the opportunity to ride this filly," said Bridgmohan. "When I asked her to run at the top of the stretch she gave it her all and really ran a great race."

The 16-1 outsider ran wire-to-wire for a confident win. "I guess we got lucky because I really didn't expect to win this race," said trainer Juan Serey. "I knew she was good and right but this was a tough race for her. Things just went right for us today." With the win, Serey clinched his second straight trainer's title for the 64-day Aqueduct winter meet which ran from January 1 through March 29.

Star Stables' **Daniel My Brother** (Runaway Groom), who missed two days of training and yesterday's Jim Beam S. at Turfway with an infection, resumed training Sunday at Churchill and will now be pointed to the April 11 \$500,000 Gil Wood Memorial at Aqueduct, according to trainer Gary Sciacca. The winner of the March 7 Battaglia Memorial S. "had a guttural pouch infection that made him spike a fever Friday morning," said Sciacca. "Dr. (Alex) Harthill treated him and he was 100 percent in 24 hours. If the (Beam) had been three or four days later, I'd have run him. This is a very talented colt and I don't think anybody realizes how good he might be. I'll keep him at Churchill and train him for the Wood, then watch out. He's really starting to blossom."

Shot of Gold was a well-beaten fifth in his debut June 27 at Hollywood and was rested six and a half months after that start, reappearing at Santa Anita Jan. 18. Third that day, he was second in his next start before breaking his maiden by 10 lengths last out March 1. Posting two bullet works at Santa Anita since that time, he was sent off the 7-5 favorite here and led wire-to-wire for the win. Asked if the victory gave him Derby aspirations, Matt Young, one of five friends who own Shot of Gold, said, "I have no idea. When you have a trainer like Bob Baffert, it's not like you tell him what to do." The 2-1 second choice, WESTERN CITY (Carson City), finished 8th after displacing his soft palate, according to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He's been showing that in the morning and we tried to change his equipment to prevent it, but we didn't," he said.
