RECORD FAIR GROUNDS MEET ENDS For the third straight year, Fair Grounds ended its Thoroughbred racing season with a record overall mutuel handle. During the 87-day meeting, total handle reached \$278,901,423, an increase of 25.8 percent from last year's figure of \$221,652,207. The daily average mutuel handle was \$3,205,763, an increase of 27.3 percent from the 1997 average of \$2,518,775. The highest one-day handle total in the track's history was reached when \$5,555,023 was wagered at Fair Grounds January 10. The on-track handle was \$25,789,351 for an average daily handle of \$296,429. The total marked a 27.7-percent increase from a year ago when the on-track handle was \$420,200,754 and the average reached \$229,554. Jockey Robby Albarado dominated the riding colony, earning 127 races from 545 mounts, a 23.3-percent win clip. Al Stall, Jr. was the top trainer of the meet, saddling 42 winners. Louie Roussel III successfully defended his owner's title with 27 victories.

KEENELAND SHUTTLE TO OFFSET NTRA PURSE DEDUCTION To compensate horsemen for the purse deduction which will help fund the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, Keeneland is picking up the tab for vaning horses stabled at other Kentucky tracks and training centers for the spring meet, which runs April 3 through 24. To qualify, horses must be stabled at Churchill Downs, Turfway Park, the Kentucky Horse Center, or Sports Spectrum, and must be entered in a race at Keeneland that day. Horses will ship to Keeneland in the morning and return to their home base after they cool out. Sallee Horse Vans will provide the shuttle service. "With the advent of the NTRA, we felt it would be helpful to offset the expense owners are incurring through the NTRA's cut of the purse structure," said Keeneland President and Chief Executive Officer, Bill Greely.

WASATCH OUT OF WOOD GIII Gotham S. winner **Wasatch** (Time for a Change) will be forced to miss the April 11 GII Wood Memorial after X-rays revealed a chip in the colt's left ankle, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Trainer Marty Wolfson told the *Form* Wasatch will be flown to Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital and will be operated on by Dr. Larry Bramlage. A winner of three of seven lifetime starts, Wasatch has earned \$143,660. Chris McCarron, originally scheduled to ride Wasatch in the Wood, is now expected to ride **Daniel My Brother** (Runaway Groom).

WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

The GIII Next Move H. victory of **Panama Canal** (f, 4, **Gulch--Colonial Waters, by Pleasant Colony**) means that four of the 13 unrestricted stakes winners (30%) out of Pleasant Colony mares have been sired by sons of Mr. Prospector. So it's obviously a good cross. Or is it? This is one example where looking behind the statistics sounds a cautionary note. Two of the stakes winners bred on the cross are by Silver Ghost, a mating which gives the brother/sister Misty Flight and Misty Morn. Another is Deming, by Seeking the Gold, and owner of the Busanda/Blue Banner three-quarters relationship. In the case of Panama Canal there is also a possibility that the key pattern lies outside the Mr. Prospector/Pleasant Colony cross. The pedigree is quite an outcrossed one, but there is an interesting connection between Asbury Mary (granddam of Gulch) and Hillbrook (granddam of Colonial Waters), who both appear in the third generation of Panama Canal. Both are by sons of Roman (by Sir Gallahad III) and on the distaff side, both have a combination of daughters of Sir Gallahad III with the three-quarters related Fasnet and Anna Horton (sixth dam of Panama Canal).

We reviewed the pedigree of **Silver Charm** (c, 4, **Silver Buck--Bonnie's Poker, by Poker**) in detail after last year's Kentucky Derby. However, his magnificent victory in the \$4 million Emirates Dubai World Cup March 28 allows us to present a brief review for those who missed it first time around. Silver Charm is the first stakes winner from more than 70 foals produced by his first three dams or their daughters. What his pedigree does have is the three-parts-sisters Busanda and Striking 3x4. This pair are both by War Admiral out of daughters of La Troienne, and there are few, if any, greater influences for upgrading a pedigree than inbreeding and linebreeding to genetic relatives from the La Troienne family. For good measure, Silver Charm also has the three-parts-brothers Royal Charger and Nasrullah 5x4, with Mahmoud (three-parts-brother to Mumtaz Begum, the dam of Nasrullah and granddam of Royal Charger) thrown in.

WHO'S HOT, WHO'S NOT

THE EARLY LEADERS

Deputy Minister (Vice Regent), 19, came into his own in 1997 when he led all North American-based stallions with 16 individual unrestricted stakes winners. With five stakes winners during the first three months in 1998, he continues to make his case as the heir-apparent to Mr. Prospector and Danzig. When Keeper Hill won the Las Virgenes S. in February, she became Deputy Minister's eighth Grade I winner in the last 14 months.

There are seven stallions tied for second place with three stakes winners apiece. Two of those seven, Jade Hunter and Marquetry, are the only two stallions with three first-time stakes winners (FTSWs) in 1998. **Marquetry** (Conquistador Cielo), 11, ranked as the third-leading freshman sire of 1997 by progeny earnings behind Gilded Time and Belong to Me. Because of his own racing career, I didn't expect to see Marquetry as a two-year-old sire. His high ranking last year was undoubtedly due in part to the fact that he had 102 named first-crop foals, the highest of any freshman sire. At three, his first crop looks like it is getting ready to rumble. Two of his three FTSWs are graded, including major Kentucky Derby contender Artax, the probable favorite in Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby.

Jade Hunter (Mr. Prospector), 14, not only has three FTSWs this year, including Golden Gate Derby winner Clover Hunter, but he is also the sire of Celtic Park Stables' highly-regarded Halory Hunter, who is scheduled to run in the April 11 Blue Grass S. Jade Hunter's stud career has been tumultuous. In 10 years, he has stood in the U.S., Japan and Australia. He stud fee has been as high as \$30,000 and as low as \$7,500. He now stands for \$10,000. This is a stallion who has never been popular with breeders or buyers and yet he is just one of six stallions to ever sire 10 or more stakes winners from his first crop. This elite group consists of Theatrical (Ire) (13), Sadler's Wells (11), Blushing Groom (Fr) (10), Jade Hunter (10), Northern Dancer (10) and Nureyev (10).

Jade Hunter is an atypical son Mr. Prospector--a late developing router who won his first stakes, a Grade I, at age four going 10 furlongs. His two best runners to date, Stuka and Diazo, also both won Grade I races at 10 furlongs. Jade Hunter is just what the doctor ordered for the North American Thoroughbred breed, whose routing capabilities continue to shorten--a son of Mr. Prospector who puts stamina back into the pedigree.

Considering the slew of unproven stallions who have gone to stud over the past couple of years for \$15,000 and \$20,000, Jade Hunter's \$10,000 fee looks the best deal around since 50 cent gasoline.

Last year, daughters of **Mr. Prospector** were responsible for 18 individual stakes winners. In most years, that would have been good enough to lead all broodmare sires. But in 1997, Nureyev's daughters came up with 19 stakes winners. However, this is a new year and Mr. P just keeps on rollin' with five stakes winners during the first three months. There will likely be a day in the future when Mr. Prospector will rank as the all-time leading sire of stakes winners *and* all-time leading broodmare sire of stakes winners at the same time. And to think this great stallion is 28 years old and still covering a full book of mares.
