KENTUCKY DERBY NOTES Trainer Bob Baffert confirmed Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby winner **Indian Charlie** (In Excess {Ire}) and stablemate runner-up **Real Quiet** (Quiet American) are on their way to GI Kentucky for the May 2 Kentucky Derby. The pair will ship to Churchill Downs on April 15. **Artax** (Marquetry), third in the Santa Anita Derby, is questionable for the race. "We'll send Artax to Churchill and at least train him there," said trainer Randy Bradshaw. "A lot of things can happen and we'll sort of play it by ear." Also questionable for the Derby is fourth-place finisher **Orville N Wilbur's** (Out of Place). "His problem is, he isn't relaxing," explained trainer Wally Dollase. "His mind isn't there yet, and obviously, a mile and a quarter isn't his game." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said GI Jim Beam runner-up **Yarrow Brae** (Deputy Minister), on the fence for the Derby, may start in the April 25 GIII Derby Trial. In other three-year-old news, trainer Graham Motion announced that GIII Flamingo S. winner **Chilito** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) will make his next start in the Kentucky Derby. After speaking with Lazy Lane owner Joe Allbritton, Motion said, "We're going to Kentucky, all being well. I had no plans to go to the Derby before (Saturday), but we nominated him (at the late closing March 28) with the thought he might be able to run a big race in the Flamingo, but I never imagined he'd run as big a race as he did. I would have been very pleased if he had been a good second or third. He's improving and doesn't mind a distance at all. He finished up very strongly in the Flamingo." Asked if Gary Boulanger, aboard for the ride Saturday, would be back as his Derby pilot, Motion said, "We haven't gotten that far, but he did a super job so he's a prime candidate to ride."

CHURCHILL WORK FOR EVENT OF THE YEAR **Event of the Year** (Seattle Slew), undefeated winner of the GI Jim Beam S., turned in a half-mile work Sunday at Churchill Downs as he continues preparations for the May 2 GI Kentucky Derby. Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer flew in from his Northern California base to oversee the three-year-old breeze four furlongs in :49 4/5 over a fast track with jockey Donna Barton in the irons. It was the colt's first breeze over the Churchill Downs track and was fourth fastest of 30 moves at the distance yesterday. "He was kind of tentative the first part of the work, but he finished real well," commented Hollendorfer. Barton added, "It was his first work since the Jim Beam (March 29) and he just needed to stretch his legs. He went nicely and handled what we asked him to do."

The Clarry Conners-trained **Prowl (Aus)** won an incident-packed Golden Slipper S., taking the world's richest two-year-old race at Rosehill, Australia Saturday. Mick Dittman, the jockey of the second-place **Shovhog (Aus)**, was found guilty of careless riding after allowing his mount to shift out at the eighth pole and forcing **RUBICALL (AUS)** (**Rubiton {Aus}**) to check and almost fall. Dittman was fined \$13,513, the mandatory five percent of the \$270,270 second-place prize, and suspended for six weeks. The jockey of **Rubicall**, John Powell, was also asked before the stewards for his riding as the field entered the home straight but was let off with an official reprimand. The 8-1 shot **Prowl**, fourth in the March 28 G2 **Pago Pago S.** last out, had the perfect number 2 post position and a trouble-free run to give his trainer his third Golden Slipper victory following **Tierce** in 1991 and **Burst** in 1992. Racing behind pacesetter **SPLENDID HORSE (AUS)** (**Geiger Counter**) from the gate, **Prowl**, ridden for the first time by 28-year-old Chris Munce, burst clear of the field inside the final furlong and won comfortably by 1 1/4 lengths for his third win from seven starts. The colt also won the G3 **Blue Diamond Prelude** Feb. 14 and the G3 **Skyline S.** March 14 and has earned \$968,473.

Might And Power (NZ), the highweight stayer on the 1997 International Classification, returned to the winner's circle for the first time since taking last November's Melbourne Cup. The four-year-old, favored at 8-11, led from the gate and was unchallenged to record an emphatic five-length success, avenging an earlier loss to three-year-old Gold Guru (Aus) in the March 21 G1 Ranvet S. Might And Power's next run will be in the \$202,702 G1 Queen Elizabeth S. over 1 1/4 miles at Randwick April 25, which may be the last race of his current campaign. Gold Guru will now aim for the \$676,590 G1 AJC Australian Derby over a mile and a half at Randwick on Saturday, April 11. Might And Power has won 8 of his 22 lifetime starts for earnings of \$2,139,123.

Sent off the 9-2 third choice here, she broke well, set the pace while racing off the rail, battled with Came Unwound through the stretch and got clear for the win. "We had planned to give this filly some time off after Oaklawn," said winning trainer Bobby Barnett. "She has had some hard races. Now, I just don't know. I will have to see how she comes out of the race and we will discuss it with Mr. Franks." Canadian import Misty Hour, making her first start for trainer Bill Mott and her first start around two turns, was sent off the 2-1 choice and was up late for the runner-up spot. CLARK STREET (Cox's Ridge), a multiple-graded stakes winner at two, had finished last in the Gill Rebel against colts in her '98 debut and showed little to be last again here.

The Aga Khan's Astarabad heads now for the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp April 26 after this narrow victory over Majorien (GB). The winner was undoubtedly helped by his runner-up finish to Loup Sauvage in the G3 Prix Exbury March 14 and by the receipt of weight from both the runner-up and the third-place finisher. Majorien led from the gate, followed by Taipan (Ire) and Astarabad. On the turn into the stretch Majorien and Taipan quickened, but Astarabad split the leaders and in a battling finish to the wire, just prevailed. Winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said, "We feared the ground because Astarabad's only bad run last year was on similar going in the Prix Lupin. But he has strengthened and matured during the winter and that probably helped him to run well this time. A mile and a quarter is also his best trip." Said Majorien's trainer, Criquette Head, "He ran a very good race for his first start of the season. He was also giving weight to the winner, who had run previously, so there was no disgrace in defeat."

SILVERLEAF TO RELOCATE Following Saturday's disclosure that David Hutson's Silverleaf Farms' property in Summerfield, Florida had been sold to Satish Sanan's Padua Stables, Hutson announced yesterday that Silverleaf would construct a new farm in Ocala. "I have been wanting to build another farm for the last couple of years," said Hutson. "I sold my construction company last year and had plans to begin construction on the new farm even prior to Mr. Sanan's interest in Silverleaf." Hutson added that Bob Cromartie would remain on as general manager of Silverleaf. Said Cromartie, "The scope of the Silverleaf operation will not change. Silverleaf owns other property in Marion County and will begin construction within the next few weeks." The Silverleaf stallions will remain in place throughout the breeding season and be relocated to the new Silverleaf Farm once the stallion complex there is complete.

Said winning trainer Mick Channon, "We're keen to try him over a mile and may run him in the G2 Chrysalis Group Mile at Sandown (April 24). He has hung on to win over seven furlongs on soft ground before now. He was a good juvenile and ran well in the (G3) Greenham S. last April, but then came home lame in the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket last May. Toward the end of last season he showed enough to justify keeping him in training."
