AJINA BACK IN ACTION SATURDAY Eclipse Award winner and GI Breeders' Cup Distaff champion **Ajina** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) will make her four-year-old debut in the mile-and-a-sixteenth Bayakoa S. tomorrow at Oaklawn Park. Trainer Bill Mott, who also sends out Favorite Trick in the GI Arkansas Derby, will have two Eclipse Award winners competing on the same card. Mott had been considering Ajina for today's GI Apple Blossom H., but chose the \$40,000 race because it was an easier spot. "We brought two fillies here and both were nominated to the Apple Blossom, but Escena is older and she has run a couple of times this year," Mott said. "She was ready for a race like the Apple Blossom. After the Breeders' Cup, we gave Ajina 60 days off and she was out of training. She's doing fine, but we didn't feel it was time to take on the best fillies in the country with her."

KTFD NIXES '98 TWO-YEAR-OLD BONUS The Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund's \$1 million bonus series for two-year-olds has been cancelled this year because of scheduling problems with the four races. According to David Switzer, executive director of the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association, which ran the series, every attempt will be made to revise the series in 1999. "It got down to a matter of T.V. versus the bonus and, basically, we want to support putting racing on T.V. as much as possible," Switzer said. "In order for the tracks to get some of the races on T.V., they had to be scheduled too close together and it wasn't in the best interest of the horses to ask them to run back so quickly." According to Switzer, the Kentucky Cup Juvenile at Turfway Park and the Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland will be run just 10 days apart this year. "We'll try very hard to come back next year with a schedule everyone can live with," Switzer said. The \$1 million bonus has been won twice since the inception of the series in 1992, both times by horses owned by William T. Young's Overbrook Farm and trained by D. Wayne Lukas. **Mountain Cat** (Storm Cat) won in 1992 and **Boston Harbor** (Capote) collected the bonus in 1996.

JAMES MOSELEY DEAD James Brady Moseley, Chairman of the Board of Suffolk Downs and a former Massachusetts state legislator, died from respiratory failure following a short illness at Massachusetts General Hospital yesterday. He was 66. Moseley was responsible for the return of racing to Suffolk in 1992 after the East Boston track had been closed for three years and he was instrumental in the purchase of the 200-acre track property by Sterling Suffolk Racecourse LLC in 1997. "New England racing meant everything to Jim Moseley," said Suffolk Downs Chief Operating Officer Bob O'Malley. "His spirit and generosity will be missed by everyone." Moseley's wife Patricia is expected to replace her late husband as chairman of Suffolk Downs. Funeral arrangements have not been released.

JOCKEY CLUB CLOSES '95 CROP The Jockey Club announced yesterday that it has closed the North American registered foal crop of 1995 at 34,958. The number may increase slightly due to a few cases that are still pending. The North American registered foal crop of 1995 dipped 1.1 percent compared to the 1994 crop of 35,338, the ninth consecutive decline in foal crop size since 1987. The foal crop decline appears to have stabilized, however, with a 1.3-percent increase to 35,400 foals projected for 1996 and 1997 and 36,000 foals projected for 1998.

G1 Middle Park S. winner HAYIL (Dayjur), making his French debut for new trainer Freddie Head, attempted to win wire-to-wire, but inside the final furlong the lack of a previous race this season and the heavy ground took its toll and he beat a hasty retreat, while Ippon (Fr), relishing the ground, found an extra gear and quickened well to go away and win comfortably from Silic (Fr). The favorite Diableneyev struggled on to finish five lengths behind the winner. Ippon, who was starting for the first time this year, has now won four of his six lifetime starts. He ended his juvenile season with a victory in the listed Prix Zeddaan over six furlongs here on heavy ground November 24.

Trainer Criquette Head is enjoying a purple run with her Classic hopefuls and she unveiled another possible contender for the French 1000 Guineas on May 10 in Gerry Oldham's homebred filly Cortona (Ire), a game winner here. Always in the front rank, Cortona stole the race when she quickened well over a furlong out and just held on by a neck from Uninhibited (Ire), whose strong finish only just failed. Criquette Head said: "Cortona does show a lot of speed, but I think she will stay a mile. The French 1000 Guineas is a possible target, but she is not engaged in the English equivalent."

Jockey Walter Swinburn finally made it back to a British winner's circle after an 18-month absence when partnering the Peter Harris-trained filly **Oh Hebe (Ire)** (Night Shift) to victory in Thursday's Keythorpe Maiden Fillies S. at Leicester. Swinburn missed all of last season in Britain after sustaining serious injuries in Hong Kong early in the year and then experiencing further problems with his weight and general health. Earlier this year he returned to race-riding in Dubai, where he rode one winner from a handful of mounts.

Local News, Sportsman's Park:

Confirming earlier reports, Sportsman's Park President Charles Bidwill III announced Thursday that he is teaming with Target/Chip Ganassi Racing to develop a dual purpose facility for both Thoroughbred and auto racing at the track's present location. Renovation will begin after the current Sportsman's meeting ends June 30 and is expected to continue through the late summer of 1999. According to Sportsman's Chief Operating Officer Ed Duffy, it is hoped the project will be completed in time to hold a Championship Auto Racing Team's (CART) race on Labor Day, followed by a fall Thoroughbred meet. The one-mile asphalt auto track will be constructed outside a seven-furlong Thoroughbred track, which will replace the current strip. The asphalt pit area, running along the entire stretch of the auto track, will serve as the base for the Thoroughbred track. The present barn area will be demolished and new barns built across the street in what is now a parking lot. "We're taking an 11,000-seat facility and expanding it to 67,000 in the first year and eventually to 90,000," said Duffy.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.
