### FAVORITE TRICK TRUMPED IN

**ARKANSAS DERBY** There are only so many aces in any deck. **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick) reached up his sleeve at the top of the stretch in yesterday's GII Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn Park, but came away empty-handed and gave way grudgingly to finish third in what was his first-ever defeat. Bet down to 2-5 in his 10<sup>th</sup> career start, the 1997 Horse of the Year was on the losing end of a the three-way photo, two heads behind 7-1 **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) and 27-1 shot **Hanuman Highway (Ire)** (Alzao) at the wire. Winner of the seven-furlong GIII Swale S. in his first appearance for trainer Bill Mott, Favorite Trick broke sharply and pressed 131-1 **Battle Royale** (Beau Genius) (8<sup>th</sup>) through reckless fractions of :22 2/5 and :46, drove to the lead after three-quarters in 1:10 4/5, but just couldn't hold on as GIII Rebel S. winner Victory Gallop fought his way from the back of the pack to live up to his name. "Whether we win or lose, he deserves the trip to the Derby," said winning trainer Elliott Walden. Jockey Pat Day, who has been aboard Favorite Trick in every race, said, "For some reason he was just too anxious. I knew it was suicide to be up head-and-head with the leader around the first turn, but I couldn't talk him into relaxing. Once he got in front, he did get a little breather...I wasn't sure how much horse I had left, but I thought he could have enough to hold off any challenges. He fought all the way to the wire...he dug in and kept battling." The next battle may be between Mott and Favorite Trick's owner, Joseph LaCombe, as the two decide whether or not to take on the GI Kentucky Derby May 2. Mott said, "I'm a slow thinker. I'll have to sleep on it." But LaCombe countered with, "I think we can write this race off. He lost by what, a head, and he got pressed all the way. This doesn't change my opinion on where he is going. I didn't see anything in the race to change my mind." (*Chart, p2*)

Looking for his first win since taking a Belmont Park allowance last September, Halory Hunter followed third-place finishes in the GII Fountain Of Youth and GI Florida Derby with his first stakes score. The late-running chestnut, closer to the leaders than he had been at Gulfstream, sat third after a half as favored Lil's Lad set an unpressured pace, but as the odds-on choice drifted wide down the backstretch and around the far turn, Halory Hunter shot through on the rail and opened it up down the lane to win handily under new rider Gary Stevens. "What can I say about Gary Stevens?" said trainer Nick Zito, who has already won two Kentucky Derbies this decade (Strike The Gold, 1991; Go For Gin, 1994). "He's the best jockey in the world. He saved ground today and it worked out perfectly. I was not bragging coming up to this race. I was ecstatic with the way (Halory Hunter) was coming up to it. If he had a voice, he would have said how great he felt." As for Lil's Lad, who was disqualified for drifting out in the GI Florida Derby, jockey Jerry Bailey said, "He was trying to get out again. Why? I don't know. It's starting to trouble me. He ran a very game race, but he didn't run like he's capable of." Added trainer Neil Howard, "He was going good early, and we just got outrun. I am disappointed, but maybe I didn't do that good a job of preparing him for the race." Cape Town, an even third, did not disappoint his trainer. "I said before the race that the result would have no bearing on our Derby plans, other than we needed a good race to get some conditioning," said D. Wayne Lukas. The top three are likely to meet again in Louisville on the first Saturday in May.

Coming off the worst finish of his career, a fifth-place showing in the GI Florida Derby, and surgery to remedy an entrapped epiglottis, and hoping to leave his bad pre-race behavior behind at Gulfstream Park, Coronado's Quest had the backing of the crowd at Aqueduct and was bet down to even-money. The temperamental chestnut had shown a fondness for the Big A at two, going three-for-three with wins in the GII Cowdin, GIII Nashua and GII Remsen, and added yet another score here, leading nearly every step en route to a handy victory. "He was so relaxed out there," said jockey Robbie Davis. "He didn't have nearly the fire in his eye that he did the time before. He's a Jekyll and Hyde, this colt, but today he was the good one, whoever that is." Added trainer Shug McGaughey, "He has been an absolutely different horse since we got back from Florida. He was comfortable in his surroundings from step one and he handled everything fine. It wasn't like Florida where he wanted to rear and jump on the pony. Today was definitely a step in the right direction. We're right back on track." But will the track lead to Churchill Downs? "It was our goal going in, but if we went and he were to come apart, we'd be back at square one," said McGaughey of a Kentucky Derby bid. "I'd love to be able to go, but I'm not sure if we have the right horse to take down there." PROSPEROUS BID (Mr. Prospector), making his first start for trainer Bob Baffert, was steadied on the first turn and tired badly to be 10<sup>th</sup>. "I don't know much about this horse," said Baffert. "As soon as he got to the paddock, he fell apart on me. He was very nervous. I'll bring him back home and find out more."

Victory Gallop, three-for-five at two, made his three-year-old bow after a 4 1/2-month absence and rallied to win the GIII Rebel S. in a photo even after his jockey dropped the whip at the eighth pole. Trained at Churchill since that score, the bay returned to Hot Springs to take on Horse of the Year Favorite Trick and proceeded to hand the Eclipse winner his first defeat, charging through traffic to get up in the last jumps for the win. "When we encountered a traffic jam at the quarter pole, he spotted a hole on the outside and headed for it," said winning jockey Alex Solis, on board the colt for the first time. "It makes my job easier when the horse has that kind of natural talent. He has some learning still to do, but has a world of talent and should keep on getting better." Trainer Elliott Walden said, "I told Alex I thought there was plenty of speed in the race, and that this horse had a good late kick and would get a route of ground. I felt we had a decent shot to beat (Favorite Trick)...better than most." The 2-5 chalk Favorite Trick dragged jockey Pat Day up to press a very rapid pace in only his second start since winning the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile November 8, took a clear lead into the stretch and dug in when Victory Gallop closed on the outside and Hanuman Highway (Ire) challenged on the rail, but could not hold on to his unbeaten record. "He has always been a push-button type of horse, but today he was up on the bit and would not relax," said jockey Pat Day. Added trainer Bill Mott, "The :22 2/5 for the first quarter was too fast for a mile-and-an-eighth race. I had a bad feeling coming by the first time. I was surprised to see him where he was." The winner is definite for the Kentucky Derby May 2, and Favorite Trick's owner, Joseph LaCombe, also said he expects to send his colt out to run for the roses.

**EVENT OF THE YEAR SHARP AT CHURCHILL**

GII Jim Beam S. winner **Event Of The Year** (Seattle Slew), looking to follow in his sire's hoofsteps as an undefeated Kentucky Derby winner, worked seven furlongs in 1:25 2/5 under jockey Russell Baze yesterday morning. The colt breezed through fractions of :23 3/5, :48 2/5 and 1:12 4/5 and galloped out the mile in 1:41 2/5. "I think the track was fairly dead today, so I'm very pleased with the move," said trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. Added Baze, "The track was deep and loose, so he was having to work a little bit to get across it. We didn't want to knock him out. We just wanted him to get a little exercise, get a little air in him." Event Of The Year was the only horse to work seven-eighths at Churchill Saturday, but his time for the half was faster than the 25 workouts posted at that distance, and his six-furlong split was a full two seconds better than the four breezes recorded. "I would have been surprised if he hadn't handled the track," said Baze. "He'll handle just about anything."

**AJINA LAST IN RETURN** Last year's champion three-year-old filly **Ajina** (Strawberry Road {Aus}), making her first start since winning the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff November 8, was sent off at 2-5 in yesterday's Bayakoa S. at Oaklawn Park, but tired in the mile-and-a-sixteenth test and finished eighth and last. Difficult to load and fractious once in the gate, the Eclipse Award winner pressed the pace for six furlongs, but faded badly in the drive and ended up about 12 lengths behind 22-1 winner **Water Street** (Storm Bird).

After finishing second in a troubled trip in the GIII Kentucky Cup Classic to finish out 1997, he came back with a fourth-place finish in the Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H. at the Fair Grounds in his last start March 22. The winner of that race, **VICTOR COOLEY** (Cool Victor), Canada's champion three-year-old colt in 1996 and the winner of the GI Vosburgh H. at Belmont last fall, was sent off the favorite here. Distorted Humor pressed the pace early, took over at the quater pole and was ridden out through the stretch for the win. The winner of the Nureyev S. at Keeneland at this distance over this surface Oct. 11 in his last winning effort three starts back, Sesaro failed in two longer tries in his next two before taking the winter off. First or second in seven-of-nine starts on the turf, he won his third grass event here as the second choice in a nine-horse field. Outsprinted early, he split rivals while five-wide at the top of the lane and wore down the front runners to win in course-record time.
