**FAVORITE TRICK ON TRACK FOR DERBY** Last year's Horse of the Year **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick) arrived at Churchill Downs from Oaklawn Park yesterday morning none the worse for the wear after his first career defeat, and trainer Bill Mott said the May 2 GI Kentucky Derby is still very much in the plans. "We're going to proceed forward as though we're going to run in the Derby," said Mott. "Unless we see some reason not to in the next three weeks, then we're going to keep pointing in that direction." As for his colt's third-place finish in Saturday's GII Arkansas Derby, Mott said, "You can't throw out this race, but he managed the mile and an eighth with no problem. It was kind of a learning experience for everyone. It was not a matter of (jockey Pat Day) misjudging the pace, but probably the horse. Even though he was beaten, he ran good, he ran game. He didn't quit. I think that's the test of a true champion, that you don't give up. And he didn't give anything up."

**NO DERBY QUEST FOR "CORONADO"** Trainer Shug McGaughey said before Saturday's GII Wood Memorial that **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner) would not be at Churchill Downs on the first Saturday in May, and he is sticking with that decision despite an impressive 2 1/2-length Wood victory. The capricious colt handled the pre-race festivities at Aqueduct like a gentleman, and handled his 11 Wood rivals with equal poise, but McGaughey fears the hectic Churchill paddock would bring a return to the bad behavior which plagued **Coronado's Quest** through three losses at Gulfstream Park. "He's been a different horse since he came to New York. If he'd acted like he did (Saturday) when he was in Florida, he'd be on a plane to Churchill," said McGaughey. "But I can't risk going to Churchill and have everything come unraveled. The horse has a lot of talent and ability, but with all those people down there on Derby Day and even the two or three days before, I don't want him to become a side show. I don't want to compromise him, I don't want to compromise the other horses and I don't want to compromise Churchill Downs." The Stuart Janney III homebred could, however, make an appearance somewhere down the Triple Crown trail. "I'll look at the Preakness and the Belmont," said McGaughey, "and I'll take a long look at the Met Mile. The Met Mile is a prestigious race and it's very important among breeders."

Criquette Head's runners are enjoying a 'purple patch' at present and her **Special Quest (Fr)** (Rainbow Quest) looks certain to start odds-on favourite for this French Classic trial. The winner of two of his three starts as a juvenile, including the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud Nov. 1 in his last outing, he was second in the G3 Prix de Conde at Longchamp in his only loss. **Jeopardy (Fr)** (Funambule) won three of 10 starts last year and was victorious in his '98 debut, an April 1 allowance at Maisons-Laffitte going a mile and a half on the turf. **Roli Abi (Fr)** (Bering {GB}) is a perfect two-for-two, breaking his maiden at Maisons-Laffitte Nov. 17 and coming back off the layoff to win a Saint-Cloud allowance in his first start this year March 7.

### Arkansas Derby Wrap-up

The first two finishers in Saturday's GII Arkansas Derby, **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) and **Hanuman Highway (Ire)** (Alzao), flew to Churchill Downs yesterday morning and both will now get ready for the GI Kentucky Derby May 2. "We thought we had a shot (Saturday)," said Victory Gallop's trainer, Elliott Walden. "Having a race over the track worked to our advantage. If everything continues to go well, we should be looking toward the Kentucky Derby." Trainer Kathy Walsh, who handles Hanuman Highway, said after Saturday's race, "I had a feeling when we came here, he could turn out to be something special. I was very pleased with his race and we are planning on the Kentucky Derby." But also rans **Hot Wells** (Go and Go {Ire}), fourth; and **Quake** (Capote), fifth; will look for softer spots. "We gave him a chance to show if he was ready, and he's not quite ready," said trainer Richard Mandella of Quake. "We're going to Kentucky, but we're lowering our expectations a little."

**KEENELAND APRIL SALE SET FOR TUESDAY**

Keeneland's one-day April Two-Year-Old in Training Sale will be held this Tuesday afternoon at the Keeneland Sales Pavilion, with bidding set to begin at 3 p.m. A total of 160 horses have been catalogued for the auction, which last year produced Grade I winners Beautiful Pleasure, Keeper Hill and Vivid Angel. Hip #156, a filly by **American Chance** out of SW Idle Affair (Try My Best) clocked the fastest time for a furlong on the turf during the under-tack preview April 6, getting the eighth in :10 1/5. Hip #155, a filly by **Meadowlake** out of Hot Love (What a Pleasure) zipped in :10 1/5 to top the works at one furlong on the main track. The co-fastest quarters at the preview, timed in :21 3/5, were turned in by Hip #108, a colt by **End Sweep** out of Charming Fappiano (Fappiano) already named **Charming Sweep**; and Hip #129, a colt by **Silver Deputy** out of Doradoradora (Runaway Groom). Other top stallions represented include Dehere, Deputy Minister, Devil's Bag, Forty Niner, Gilded Time, Gone West, Gulch, Mr. Prospector, Nureyev, Pine Bluff, Salt Lake, Unbridled and Woodman. The second Preview Day will be held today beginning at 10:30 a.m., and all previews are available on videotape.

**SILVER GOBLIN SCARES UP ANOTHER WIN**

It may have been better than three years since his last visit, but MGSW **Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost) remembered the way to the winner's circle. The seven-year-old millionaire, who hadn't posted a victory since taking the GII Razorback H. at Oaklawn Park March 25, 1995, galloped to a 5 1/2-length victory in a \$31,000 allowance race at Texas' Lone Star Park yesterday afternoon. Second to superstar Cigar in the 1995 GI Oaklawn H., the grey gelding was the 7-5 favorite in his next start, the GI Met Mile, but finished ninth after suffering a condylar fracture and was out for nearly 17 months. He was injured again after running sixth in his first start back, the Remington Park Sprint Championship H. in October, 1996, and was on the shelf for another 17 months before finishing third in an allowance at Oaklawn this March 18. The veteran, bet down to 3-5 yesterday, covered the mile and a sixteenth in 1:44 4/5. "He's back!" said regular rider Dale Cordova. "He did everything easy. (Trainer Kenny Smith) had him sitting on go." Added Smith, "I thought it was a beautiful race. I'll probably wait a month before I run him back again. I haven't really tested him yet. But the next time you see him will be in a stakes race."

**ISITINGOOD EUTHANIZED** According to a report on *The Blood-Horse* on-line, millionaire **Isitingood** (Crusader Sword) was put down at the Equine Medical Center in Cypress, Colorado due to complications from laminitis. The seven-year-old was retired last July after suffering a condylar fracture of his left front cannon bone during a workout at Del Mar. His left front fetlock was fused, but the stallion developed an infection and laminitis; he eventually had to have a hoof reconstructed, but efforts to save him finally failed. Isitingood broke Dr. Fager's world record for a mile in February, 1997, winning The Bart S. at Santa Anita in the time of 1:32. He won 11 of 24 starts, including six stakes and four graded stakes, and earned \$1,219,430.

"There was no speed at all in the race and all I wanted was a clean break," said jockey David Flores. "He broke perfectly and made the lead easily. He loves to be in front, too. Turning for home, I knew I had a lot of horse left and I just let him roll."

**ALAN PORTER, Alan Porter Pedigree Research**

1. **Dehere** -- Champion Two-Year-Old; By sire of sires Deputy Minister out of a Secretariat mare and has highest numerical representation.
  2. **Holy Bull** -- Great racehorse; Has had enough mares with the "right" kind of pedigrees to give him a shot.
  3. **Boundary** -- Very fast son of Danzig, who is now turning into a sire of sires.
- BEST VALUE** -- **American Chance** - MGSW won three of five starts at two years, and just missed winning a Grade I; From a very strong family; Yearlings sold pretty solidly, too.

1. **Strolling Along** -- While I can't help but like Dehere as 1998's leading freshman sire, nevertheless I am going to roll the dice on a longshot--Strolling Along! He died in Australia while on shuttle duty, but not before he left 60 foals from his only U.S. crop. Some of my admiration for Strolling Along may be left over from another son of Danzig I was very high on--Belong to Me--my "best value" pick last year. After comparing their pedigrees and race records, anyone who likes Belong to Me should love Strolling Along.
2. **Dehere** -- Of all of this year's freshman sires, I think Dehere has the best long-term future. A GISW and Champion Two-Year-Old by a sire of sires out of a daughter of a broodmare sire of sires, he's got the goods. With 79 foals and the highest yearling sale average of all freshman sires, everything points to Dehere as king of this crop.
3. **Williamstown** -- At \$7,500, he is also my best value selection. What a pedigree! He is by Seattle Slew out of the family of Broad Brush, Capote, and Baldski. He set the Belmont track record while winning the Gil Withers S. at one mile (1:32 3/5). This one could follow in the steps of Capote.
