CORONADO'S QUEST TO MET MILE? While not ruling out a start in the May 16 Preakness, trainer Shug McGaughey said yesterday it is more likely that MGSW **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner), winner of the Gil Wood Memorial April 11, will run next in the May 25 GI Metropolitan Mile at Belmont. He also reiterated that there is no chance his high-strung colt will start in the Kentucky Derby May 2. McGaughey is concerned that the atmosphere at the Preakness could be more than his horse can handle, a reason he is leaning toward the Met Mile. "In the Preakness, I'd saddle him in the indoor paddock," McGaughey said. "But my biggest concern would be the walk from the receiving barn to the paddock. He'd have to walk a quarter-mile on the main track and that could be a problem." The trainer added that he would still consider the June 6 GI Belmont S. if the three-year-old were to run in the Met.

IRGUN JOINS DUAL HEMISPHERE ROSTER

John T. L. Jones Jr., owner of Walmac Int'l in Lexington, Kentucky, announced Friday that GI Wood Memorial and Gil Gotham S. winner **Irgun** (Sunny's Halo), owned by Brandon and Marianne Chase, will begin Southern Hemisphere shuttle stallion duty at Furlong Stud in Australia later this year. The seven-year-old, who won three-of-five career starts for earnings of \$476,975, first entered stud in 1997 at Walmac. "Ken McLean worked on putting this arrangement together along with Furlong Stud's Rob Atkinson," said Jones. "Both men are astute students of pedigree and felt Irgun would have a good opportunity in Australia. His speed and impressive turn-of-foot at three were very appealing to them and both men believe his bloodlines will complement the general population of Australian-sired mares." Furlong Stud is the first stallion station located in Queensland. In addition to Irgun, they stand second-year stallion **River of Light** (Riverman). Irgun's 1998 Northern Hemisphere stud fee is \$4,000; a fee of \$6,000 Australian funds (approximately \$4,000 U.S.) has been set for his first Southern Hemisphere season.

Fiji (GB) (Rainbow Quest) goes for her fourth straight after taking a Santa Anita allowance by nine lengths Feb. 19 and the nine-furlong Gil Santa Ana H. by 4 1/2 in her latest Mar. 21. The four-year-old has tackled the mile-and-a-quarter distance once before, winning the Daffodil S. in her final English outing last July. **Queen Maud (Ire)** (Akarad {Fr}), winner of the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp last September, finished 15th in the 1997 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October, then came back after a five-month layoff and finished seventh after pressing the pace in the Gil Orchid H. at Gulfstream Mar. 8. The four-year-old has been working well in California and should benefit from her first U.S. start.

KENTUCKY DERBY-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo, 1 1/4m

Undefeated **Event of the Year** (Seattle Slew) continues to show a fondness for the Churchill strip, breezing a mile in 1:37 4/5 over a track labeled "good" yesterday morning. With jockey Donna Barton in the saddle, the colt clipped off fractions of :23 2/5, :47 4/5, 1:12 3/5 and 1:25 1/5. Every one of those splits would have been bullet works on the day. He galloped out nine furlongs in 1:52 3/5. "We're happy he's working well over the racetrack," said trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. "It's an indicator that he likes the racetrack and it's an indicator that he's pretty fit. Our major workout is done."

Churchill Downs officials received word Friday that British-based three-year-old **Saratoga Springs (El Gran Senor)**, trained by Aidan O'Brien, may ship to Kentucky for the Derby. The colt, winner of the G1 Racing Post Trophy at two, has won four of his seven starts, but has yet to race this year. He is owned by Mrs. John Magnier and Michael Tabor. Tabor's Thunder Gulch took the 1995 "Run for the Roses." Saratoga Springs' connections are getting information on quarantine requirements, and will make a final Derby decision Monday.

GII Toyota Blue Grass S. winner **Halory Hunter (Jade Hunter)** shipped from Keeneland to Churchill yesterday morning. "He looks great," said trainer Nick Zito. "He galloped very strong (Friday) and he came off bouncing. Everything is good. We've just got to keep it up."

Sent off the 4-5 favorite to maintain his perfect grass record, the bay colt strode to the lead soon after the break and never relinquished command, posting a convincing score. "This horse has so much personality," said winning jockey Julie Krone. "He has such a good time out there, especially in the post parade. He has all this confidence. He shoots out of the starting gate and just runs." Added trainer Bill Badgett Jr., "He's one of those horses that you love to be around. He loves to train. He loves the race-track. He's a lot like a Labrador Retriever--he just wants to make you happy."

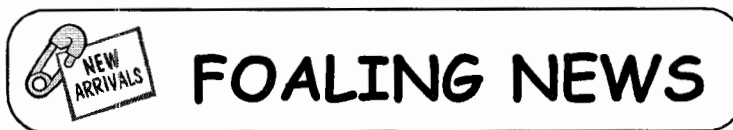
