TEAM BAFFERT DUO IN DERBY PREPS Trainer Bob Baffert sent out his two Kentucky Derby hopefuls, early favorite **Indian Charlie** (In Excess {Ire}) and **Real Quiet** (Quiet American), to breeze at Churchill Saturday morning. Indian Charlie, winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby April 4, went five-eighths in 1:01 4/5, getting the first quarter in :26 and the half in :49 under exercise rider Dana Barnes. Stablemate Real Quiet, runner-up in the Santa Anita Derby, went the same distance in 1:00 1/5 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:12 3/5, also with Barnes in the saddle. "I went a little lighter on Indian Charlie because he has never worked on this track and the other horse has," said Baffert, who is looking for his second straight Derby win after taking the roses with Silver Charm last year. "Basically I just wanted Indian Charlie to get used to this track. I didn't want him to do too much. He was a little green coming down the stretch, looking around. Real Quiet is more of an aggressive-type worker. He worked really well. Both of these horses are fit and they make it look so easy." In other Derby news, trainer Neil Howard has named Shane Sellers to ride **Parade Ground** (Kingmambo), and added that if **Comic Strip** (Red Ransom) also goes on the first Saturday in May, Sellers will have his choice.

OUT OF PLACE COLT SIZZLES AT OBS SPRING SALE PREVIEW Premier Property, a colt by **Out of Place** from the Shadybrook Farm (Michael Yates), agent, consignment set to sell Wednesday as Hip #746, worked three-eighths in :33 1/5 to top Saturday's third session of the Under Tack Show for the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Annual Spring Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training. The fastest time for a quarter-mile at the preview, :21 2/5, was clocked by a pair of juveniles--Hip #750, a colt by **Ghazi**, and **Long Distance**, a filly by **Expensive Decision** selling as Hip #765. There was also a tie for the fastest furlong at the Under Tack Show, with **Lightening Lassie** (Hip #622, a filly by **Red Wing Bold**) and **Cissy's Prospect** (Hip #848, a filly by **Prospectors Gamble**) both going in :10 1/5. The fourth and final session of the preview will be held today beginning at 9 a.m. The Spring Sale gets underway Monday, April 20 and runs through Thursday, April 23, with bidding set to start at 10:30 a.m. daily.

Beaten only once in her life, and that by only a nose after stumbling badly at the start in her U.S. debut following a five-month layoff in December, **Fiji** (GB) had ventured into graded stakes competition for the first time in her latest and come away with a decisive win in the GII Santa Ana H. March 21. The 2-5 favorite to repeat that performance this time, the talented bay had dead aim on the leaders as she stalked the pace in third, taking command at the top of the lane and leaving her four rivals in her wake in another impressive effort. "There's little more to do on her but aim her in the right direction, because she's really something special," said jockey Kent Desormeaux. "She is just a wonderful filly. She cuts all the corners and just does everything right. She has those long legs and she certainly knows what to do with them. Believe me, when I asked her, she just cut for home and I knew it was over." The filly, who gave trainer Neil Drysdale his second stakes win of the afternoon and his 12th of the meet, will be pointed for the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood June 7.

Star of Broadway put together a three-race winning streak to begin her career, then was second in the GI Las Virgenes before faltering to finish sixth in the GI Santa Anita Oaks going a mile and a sixteenth in her most recent outing March 15. Turning back to a sprint here, the Triple Crown-nominated filly was sent off the slight choice of the crowd and came through, rallying from ninth after stumbling at the break to take command in deep stretch and draw clear. "This is a pretty nice filly," said winning rider Pat Day. "She overcame a lot of obstacles. She stumbled leaving the gate and that put us behind. We got shuffled back, and we really had to work our way through traffic to even get a shot at it. At the half we dropped down close to the rail and got through a real narrow hole. After that she really accelerated and took off after the leaders. Once she was able to catch them, she flipped her ears and ran right on by. She showed a tremendous amount of courage."

It was confirmed Saturday that the Godolphin operation will set up a training centre for 100 juveniles at Evry racecourse, 30 miles south of Paris, with trainer David Loder joining the operation full-time and taking charge of the project. Only a last-minute hiccup at a meeting of the Board of Directors of FRANCE GALOP, the French racing authority, April 28 could prevent this ambitious move. Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford said that the Maktoum-operated organisation had been looking for a juvenile training centre "for a few years" and Evry was "one of several options under consideration." He added, "David Loder...will move to France with the horses towards the end of the year, if the deal is concluded. At Evry there is access to a variety of training surfaces and of all the options, it was the one which Sheikh Mohammed appreciated the most." However, Crisford was at pains to deny that this move to Evry had anything to do with the Maktoums' views on the poor prize money in Britain and their threat to cut back their bloodstock and racing interests if matters did not improve swiftly. "Our intended relocation of two-year-olds should not be seen to be connected with previously stated policies addressed by Sheikh Mohammed in his Gimcrack speech," said Crisford.
