### FOURSTARDAVE TO STAR ONCE MORE

Unraced since finishing fifth in an allowance at Saratoga August 21, 1995 and winless since taking an allowance over that course July 24, 1994, millionaire **Fourstardave** (Compliance), 13, will come out of retirement for one more appearance. Making what will be his 100<sup>th</sup> start, the New York-bred gelding will run in the Blood-Horse Sportsman's Challenge at the High Hopes steeplechase meet at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington May 17. The race, a non-betting event restricted to horses which have not won this year and to amateur jockeys, will be run for charity, with a full field of more than a dozen expected to pay the \$500 entry fee. Proceeds from the two-mile turf contest will go to the Kentucky Horse Park Foundation and Central Kentucky Riding for the Handicapped. Fourstardave, who captured 21 races, 13 of them stakes, and earned \$1,636,560, is in training at his retirement home, New Episode Farm in Ocala, Florida. **Smiling And Dancin** (Lyphard's Wish {Fr}), who has not started since trying his luck over fences April 29, 1995 and finishing ninth, will also be pointed for the race. The nine-year-old gelding, a resident of New Episode as well, won six of 23 starts, including the Gill Laurel Futurity, Gill Pilgrim S. and Gill Lamplighter H.; he ended his career on the flat for a \$25,000 tag, winning a race at Calder December 3, 1994.

**OBS-APRIL PREVIEW CONCLUDES** A colt by **Robyn Dancer**, selling Thursday as Hip #1085, worked three-eighths in :33 3/5 to top the fourth and final session of the Under Tack Show for the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Annual Spring Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training in Ocala, Florida. **Sweep Well**, a colt by **End Sweep** who will go through the ring Thursday as Hip #1099, posted the fastest time for a quarter at yesterday's preview, getting the distance in :21 1/5. A pair of two-year-olds went in :10 2/5 to top the times at one furlong: **Stylish Kitten**, a **Mountain Cat** filly selling as Hip #918; and Hip #1073, a filly by **Tricky Creek**. The Spring Sale starts today and runs through Thursday, April 23, with bidding set to begin at 10:30 a.m. daily.

Looking to break a streak of three straight fourth-place finishes, **Amerique** was coming off a promising three-length loss in the Gil San Luis Rey S., but was given little chance to turn the tables on that race's winner, **Kessem Power (NZ)**, and third-place finisher, **Star Performance**, here. Content to bide his time near the back of the pack through the early going, the dark bay began his move on the final bend, driving between horses at the head of the stretch to take the lead and hanging on to the wire over the late-charging favorite. "The whole key was just trying to keep my position...it was getting very tight (heading into the far turn) and we were stuck, but then all of a sudden it just opened up for us...and we got through," said jockey Eddie Delahoussaye, who picked up the mount from the out-of-town Chris McCarron and picked up his second straight in this event. (Delahoussaye also rode **Marlin** to win the '97 Capistrano, subbing for McCarron, who was injured earlier that day). "Once I got through, I knew it was all over." Both the runner-up and third-place finishers encountered traffic trouble. "There was a lot of bumping, and I had to sit and wait a little bit," said Corey Nakatani, rider of **Star Performance**. "When we got through he came running, but the other horse got the jump on us." Added jockey Alex Solis, aboard **Kessem Power**, "He's a sweetheart of a horse, he tries so hard. Unfortunately, from the five-sixteenths to the three-sixteenths pole we had nowhere to go, and that was too bad, because I had so much horse. But he ran awesome, just like always."

Classic Cat broke his maiden in his second start Oct. 26 at Santa Anita and was sent straight into stakes company off the win. Second in the GIII California Juvenile at Bay Meadows and again in the Simply Majestic H. at Golden Gate as a two-year-old, he was seventh in the Golden Gate Derby Jan. 18 in his three-year-old debut. Rested two months after that start, he was third in a March 13 Santa Anita allowance and fifth in the GI Santa Anita Derby in his last start April 4, each of the last two behind top Triple Crown prospect Indian Charlie. The fifth choice, he settled near the back of the pack early, closed through the stretch and caught Voyamerican at the wire. Trainer David Cross said it was unlikely his colt would be pointed to the May 2 Kentucky Derby. "We were coming back two weeks off the Santa Anita Derby and now we'd have to come back in two weeks again," said Cross, who won the 1983 Derby with Sunny's Halo. "It would be three races within 30 days and I think that might be asking a little much. I'll be talking to the owner, Mr. (Gary) Garber. I'd prefer to point toward the (May 16) Preakness, I think, but it will be up to him." Runner-up Voyamerican will make his next start in either the May 9 \$500,000 GII Illinois Derby at Sportsman's or the Kentucky Derby, according to trainer Carlos Morales. "(The Kentucky Derby) may be too close," he said. "We'll wait a couple of days to make a decision." Multiple GISW Grand Slam, making his second start back off a four-month layoff after suffering an injury in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, was the favorite here, chased the speed down the backstretch, moved into second in the lane and gave way.

"He's got a little allergy and he'll just have the day off today," said trainer Kathy Walsh Sunday morning. "I don't like to get them hot, especially with the track muddy." The GII Arkansas Derby runner-up will be back at the track today and could work Tuesday.

Littlebitlively had come out on the losing end of photo finishes in his last three starts, most recently running second by a head in the Fifth Season Breeders' Cup S. at Oaklawn April 8, but got the nod this time. Away from the gate first, the John Franks homebred came up the rail to duel with REALITY ROAD (Believe It) for a half, then was joined by last year's Lone Star Derby winner Anet, but prevailed in a hard-fought finish. "He's running some big races for us," said trainer Bobby Barnett. "He hasn't been campaigned a lot, but he wasn't a surprise to us. His future looks very bright." The 3-5 chalk, Reality Road bore out after losing the lead and stopped badly to finish last. "I think he pulled up fine," said his jockey, Chris McCarron. "He was tired. He didn't even gallop out a sixteenth of a mile past the wire, and he is usually really hard to pull up."

Smolderin Heart wired the field in an Oaklawn allowance race in his latest March 28, winning the mile-and-a-sixteenth test by five lengths, and stepped up to the stakes ranks off the score. Changing tactics this time, the grey rated in fifth for a half-mile, made his way between horses to join the leaders as they headed into the far turn, then switched to the outside for the drive and wore down Shot Of Gold in the final strides. "We've been thinking about this race since he broke his maiden," said winning trainer Terry Brennan. "This was the plan the whole time. Every single race and work, he gets better. He's not lost a pound since we put him in training at Oaklawn, and we've trained him hard. He always bounces back out of his races good. He'll tell us when he's ready to run again." Brennan added that he is more likely to point for the GII Illinois Derby May 9 than the GI Kentucky Derby May 2. Owner Jeff Rand said, "We'll sit down tonight or tomorrow and talk about the (Kentucky) Derby, but we will do what's right for the horse." The 6-5 favorite FUTURISTIC (Future Storm), third in the GII San Rafael S. March 1, pressed the pace early, made a bid after six furlongs, but weakened late.

The only three-year-old in the field, Golden Mirage (Ire) got in with a featherlight 104 pounds here, accepting 10 to 19 pounds from her older rivals, and used it to her advantage to score her first North American win in her '98 debut. After breaking her maiden in her second start in Britain, she was a listed winner at five furlongs on the turf in Ireland before shipping to Canada last summer. Fourth in the Ontario Debutante Aug. 11 in her only start on the dirt and third in the GIC Natalma Sept. 14, she made her first start since that race here. Bumped at the break, she pressed the front runners early, took over at the sixteenth pole and held on for the win.

Top Priced Fillies Sold**

**New York Stallion S. (Park Avenue div.) cont.**

The winner of the Astoria S. at Belmont as a two-year-old, Jersey Girl wrapped up her two-for-four juvenile season with her only off-the-board finish, a fifth in the Gill Schuylerville S. at Saratoga. Off seven months after that start, she made her sophomore bow Feb. 27 at Gulfstream, taking a six-furlong allowance, and scored again last time out in the March 29 seven-furlong Gill Cicada S. at Aqueduct. In her longest effort to date here, she was sent off the prohibitive favorite and acted the part, taking the lead shortly after the break and cruising home to win under a hand ride. Dancewiththebride was easily best of the others to complete a one-two sweep for her sire. "Now that we got a mile into her, we really don't want to back her up, so we'll look at our options and take it from there," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "But as for right now, the (GI, one-mile) Acorn (at Belmont June 7) would be the main goal."

A two-time graded stakes winner last year with victories in the Gill Discovery H. and the Gill Queens County H., both at Aqueduct, Mr. Sinatra had not fared as well as a four-year-old, missing in three straight starts.
