PEINTRE CELEBRE RETIRED Daniel Wildenstein's homebred four-year-old colt **Peintre Celebre** (Nureyev), the 1997 Horse of the Year in Europe who was due to make his seasonal debut in today's G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp, has been officially retired after damaging a tendon. Winner of the G2 Prix Greffulhe, G1 Grand Prix de Paris, G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) and last October's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in his final start, he will be shipped to Coolmore Stud in Ireland in the near future. Wildenstein's son Alec said yesterday, "Injuries like this always seem to happen to the good horses. It happens when they are right at the top and we experienced the same thing with Freedom Cry (GB), who was second in the (1995) Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. I think he will go to Coolmore in a few days' time, but I don't know if he will stand as a stallion this season." France's champion jockey Olivier Peslier, the colt's regular partner, said, "This is a catastrophe. I hope the injury is not too serious. Peintre Celebre was the best horse I have ever ridden." The Kentucky-bred won five of his seven career starts, with one second and one third. He earned \$1,419,573.

AUSTRALIAN GROUP 1 WINNER FOR QUEST FOR FAME Juddmonte Farms' shuttle stallion **Quest For Fame (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), 11, sired his first Group 1 winner in Australia when his two-year-old colt **Dracula (Aus)** won Saturday's \$201,748 Champagne S. over a mile on a heavy track at Randwick in Sydney. Owned and bred by Jack and Bob Ingham's Woodlands Stud and trained by John Hawkes, Dracula, ridden by Larry Cassidy, started the 7-4 favorite and edged home by a short head from the New Zealand-trained Group 1-winning filly **Happyanunoit (NZ)** (Yachtie {Aus}).

SLEEPYTIME TO BREEDING SHED The 1997 English 1000 Guineas winner **Sleepytime (Ire)** (Royal Academy) has been retired and will be bred to Zafonic, sire of next weekend's Sagitta 2000 Guineas favorite **Xaar (GB)**. The four-year-old filly was reported to have been suffering from soreness in her hind fetlocks. After a layoff of more than nine months, Sleepytime returned to action in the G3 Earl Of Sefton S. at Newmarket April 15, but finished a well-beaten last behind **Apprehension (GB)** (In The Wings {GB}). She won two of her six starts and bankrolled \$240,036.

SUCCESSFUL SURGERY FOR EVENT OF THE YEAR Event of the Year (Seattle Slew) underwent successful surgery yesterday morning to repair a slab fracture of the right knee suffered during a five-furlong workout at Churchill Downs Friday. The undefeated colt, expected to be one of the May 2 Kentucky Derby favorites, was operated on by Dr. Larry Bramlage at Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington, which released a statement reading, "A screw was inserted into the right knee to stabilize the fracture. The surgery went well; the injury is not life-threatening. The plan will be to return him to training in the year." Added trainer Jerry Hollendorfer, who disclosed that the colt had suffered a hairline fracture of his left knee as a two-year-old as well, "They told me the break was clean and there wasn't much cartilage damage at all. The break was about an inch and a quarter long and about a half-inch deep. It was a fresh fracture. He had a fantastic work and he walked good cooling out for about 20 minutes. About the last 10 minutes, he started walking funny. I checked him and found filling in his knee, so we ordered the X-rays and they found the fracture." As for his racing future, Hollendorfer said, "I think he'll be able to race again. I feel bad for (owners John and Betty Mabee) because he had a chance to win." Hollendorfer said he expected Event of the Year to remain in Kentucky for 10 days to two weeks, and then to be shipped to California to continue his rehabilitation at the Mabee's Golden Eagle Farm.

COMIC STRIP OUT **Comic Strip** (Red Ransom) will not run in the Derby, but may be pointed for the May 16 Preakness, trainer Neil Howard said yesterday morning. Howard said that the colt's third-place finish in the April 4 GIII Flamingo S. and his progress since then were the factors in the decision. "When the smoke cleared and we got back to Kentucky, he looked a little dull and he looked like he had lost a little weight," said Howard. "There was about a week or so where we thought he was a little lethargic. His temperature was good, the blood was good, but you could tell. We didn't feel that was the way to go to the Derby. If you go in with doubts, you usually come out confirming your doubts."

VOYAMERICAN POSSIBLE Trainer Carlos Morales has notified Churchill officials that **Voyamerican** (Mining), second in the GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland April 19, is a possible Derby starter. He will ship to Churchill Sunday or Monday.

DERBY WORK TAB Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance) turned in his final major pre-Derby work yesterday morning at Churchill, going five furlongs in :59 after the renovation break. The Arkansas Derby winner was caught in fractions of :24, :36, :47 1/5, and was out the six furlongs in 1:12. "He worked super," said trainer Elliott Walden. "In company, he's a little different horse than he is on his own. When he's in company, he rises to the occasion." Walden said the colt may breeze through the lane late next week. **Basic Trainee** (Majestic Light) worked six furlongs in 1:13 1/5 over a fast Aqueduct track yesterday morning under jockey John Velazquez. Coming out onto the track just after the break, Basic Trainee, fourth in the April 11 Gil Wood Memorial last out, turned in splits of :23 3/5 and :48 3/5 and pulled up seven furlongs in 1:26 4/5. "I might have gone too fast, but Mr. (trainer Jorge) Romero didn't say anything to me, so I guess he's happy," said Velazquez. "He was going so easily, I didn't think I was going that fast." Co-owner Luis Gambotto said the colt was scheduled to ship to Churchill Downs yesterday afternoon. **Nationalore** (Video Ranger) drilled a bullet seven furlongs in 1:24 3/5 at Hollywood yesterday. It was the fastest of nine works at the distance. Winless in 15 starts but boasting a bankroll of \$283,767, he is nominated to Saturday's Snow Chief at Hollywood, but is more likely for the Derby, according to his connections.

"She's a real nice filly and she's very fast," said Chavez. "When we opened up by two lengths, she wanted to put the brakes on, so I had to keep her mind on running." Trainer Martin Wolfson said the filly would return to her home base at Calder for her next start, the Azalea Breeders' Cup S. May 30, then could ship north again for the GI Acorn S. at Belmont June 7. "That looks like a good spot, too," he said.

Souvenir Copy, winner of the GII Del Mar Futurity and GII Norfolk S. at two, had been held winless in three starts this year; after running second in the GIII Santa Catalina and GII San Rafael, he was a disappointing fifth in the GIII Louisiana Derby March 15 and had been removed from the list of Kentucky Derby candidates. Looking to redeem himself as the favorite in the Derby Trial, the dark bay was bumped at the break, but circled the field on the far turn and drew away under a hand ride. The victory did not, however, earn him a berth in the starting gate next Saturday. "I liked the way he ran today, but a mile and a quarter may be stretching it a little bit," said trainer Bob Baffert, who won the Derby last year with Silver Charm and has Indian Charlie and Real Quiet ready to go this year. As for the improvement off Souvenir Copy's last start, Baffert said, "We've found that if a rider grabs him, he can't catch his breath. He displaces (his palate) really easily. Gary Stevens (who rode the three-year-old in the San Rafael) suggested we not use a pony today, because they grab on and he gets keyed up. We didn't use the pony, and I think he stayed more relaxed and calm." The trainer added the colt could head for the GII Illinois Derby at Sportsman's Park May 9, or wait for the GI Preakness May 16. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas will wait until Wednesday until deciding the Derby status of runner-up Yarrow Brae.
