KENTUCKY DERBY-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo, 1 1/4m

Artax (Marquetry) worked five furlongs in :58 yesterday at Churchill Downs with jockey Donna Barton in the irons. "I was looking for a minute or 1:01," said trainer Randy Bradshaw after the move. "But this horse can be deceiving. I know he fooled (regular rider) Chris (McCarron) a couple of times and I think he deceived Donna this morning. She came back and thought she might have gone too slow."

Rock and Roll (Cure the Blues), third in the Tampa Bay Derby, worked six furlongs Sunday in company, covering the distance in 1:12 3/5. The clockers caught early fractions of :23 2/5 and :35 3/5. "It was a good work," commented trainer Bill Mott. "We sent him behind two horses and he followed them to the quarter pole and then went on passed them and opened up on them. He should have gotten what he needed."

Hanuman Highway (Ire) (Alzao) turned in his last serious work before the Derby yesterday, going six furlongs in 1:12 3/5 under jockey David Flores. The GII Arkansas Derby runner-up registered fractions of :24 4/5 for the first quarter, a half-mile in :48 3/5 and a final quarter in :24 flat. He galloped out seven furlongs in 1:26 4/5. "He went off slowly and picked it up progressively through the lane," said trainer Kathy Walsh. "I think he got a lot out of it. These horses come from Europe and they're not aggressive in their workouts because of the way they're trained there. But he's getting better all the time."

Old Trieste (A.P. Indy), second in last year's GII Norfolk S., worked a blistering six furlongs in 1:09. "I've worked horses in 'ten' but that was pushing and driving," commented jockey Robby Albarado. "What this horse did this morning, he did effortlessly, the right way. He was blowing a little bit when we came back, but nothing like it took anything out of him." Trainer Mike Puype, who caught the colt galloping out seven furlongs in 1:23 1/5, added, "Sure, I'm a little concerned that he went too fast. But I know this horse is peaking. He's fresh and lightly raced and it's just a matter of keeping him where he is right now."

Nationalore (Video Ranger) will be ridden in the Derby by Goncalino Almeida, agent Michelle Barsotti reported.

Heart Surgeon (Kerosene), whose only win in seven starts to date came in a January state-bred maiden race at Sam Houston, has been added to the list of possible Derby starters. If the colt runs, he will be ridden by Marlon St. Julien.

The 1997 Melbourne Cup winner Might and Power (NZ) simply crushed his opponents in this mile-and-a-quarter contest, beating the New Zealand-trained three-year-old filly Champagne (NZ) by 10 1/2 lengths, the largest winning margin in an Australian Group 1 race since 1969. Starting the 9-10 favorite, Nick Moraitis' four-year-old gelding went to the front from the gate and was never challenged, stamping himself as the favorite for Horse of the Year honors.

A racing career in California could be the ultimate destination for Astarabad, who was the highlight of a great day for owner the Aga Khan, trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre and jockey Gerald Mosse. The trio scooped a Group race treble with homebreds Astarabad, Zainta (Ire) in the G3 Prix Vanteaux and Tajoun (Fr) in the G3 Prix de Barbeville. Conditions were expected to suit Taipan (Ire) and he led from the gate, attempting to make all the pace. Astarabad, last early, made his move at the top of the stretch and at the eighth pole he hit the front and stayed on resolutely with Que Belle finishing well to grab second spot. "We have received several serious offers for Astarabad," said a delighted Aga Khan. "He might end up in California, but nothing has been decided yet. He has continued to improve, especially as he was not favored by the weights this time. Gerald Mosse also rode a very good race."

This race proved a fortunate win for the Italian-trained Crisos Il Monaco (Ire), who was comfortably beaten by the English-trained Trans Island (GB) before being awarded the race in the stewards' room after the authorities viewed the head-on patrol film. The judges decided that Trans Island had edged left and caused interference to the runner-up. Trans Island and Crisos Il Monaco dominated the race from the start; Trans Island took command at the quarter-mile pole, Crisos Il Monaco made his challenge on his outside and the pair brushed in the stretch. Crisos Il Monaco gave his veteran trainer Luigi Camici an Italian Guineas double as he won last weekend's Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) with Sopran Londa (Ire). "This horse had always been nervous in the stalls and was always slowly away," said Camici, "but he has a tremendous finish, which enabled him to win his first four races. So when he came to us, we schooled him in the gate, teaching him to relax and today he broke really well."

This has been a good week for the rider as he became a father for the first time on Thursday.

Local News, England:

Irish trainer Aidan O'Brien confirmed yesterday that **King of Kings (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), off since winning the G1 National S. at The Curragh in September, will represent the stable in the May 2 G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. O'Brien also confirmed that **Shahtoush (Ire)** (Alzao) will run in the May 3 Sagitta 1000 Guineas.

Despite their recent defeats at the Craven meeting at Newmarket, trainer Henry Cecil confirmed yesterday that **Daggers Drawn** (Diesis {GB}) and **Jibe** (Danzig) will run in the Sagitta 2000 and 1000 Guineas, respectively.

Last year's G1 Vodafone Derby runner-up and G1 Doncaster St Leger winner **Silver Patriarch (GB)** (Sadler's Hall {Ire}) will reappear in Friday's G2 Jockey Club S. over a mile and a half at Newmarket.

Local News, South Africa:

The four-year-old colt **Golden Hoard (SAf)** (All Fired Up) survived a difficult race to score his first win of the season in Saturday's 1 1/4-mile \$201,207 G1 Premiers Cup at Turffontein in Johannesburg. Starting the 16-10 favorite, Golden Hoard quickened well late and scored by 3/4 lengths over **Keeneland Gold (SAf)** (Rakeen).

The three-year-old gelding **Kale (SAf)** (Elliodor {Fr}), third in the G1 Cape Of Good Hope Derby February 15, captured Saturday's \$50,301 G1 S. A. Derby over a mile and a half at Turffontein. Trained by Patrick Shaw and the mount of Jonny Geroudis, the winner scraped home by a neck over **Royal Tours (SAf)** (Northern Guest) with **Harvest Rose (SAf)** (Rakeen) a neck back in third.

Prompting the pace here, he took the lead at the quarter-pole and held off the closing kick of the favorite, K.J.'s Appeal. "I think he ran a super race," said winning trainer Ralph Ziadie. "This was my first stakes win in New York and I hope to be back for more. We'll take him back to Florida and then map out what to do with him next.
