Sister Act started her career with back-to-back wins at Oaklawn, jumping into graded stakes company after a seven-length allowance score in her most recent outing April 5. Kept close to the leaders from the start, the grey swept to the lead on the far turn and galloped away to a dominant decision over the muddy strip despite preferring a fast track. "She doesn't like the mud, believe me," said her jockey, Calvin Borel. "Her first start she hated the mud and just barely won. She won today, but she's great on a better track. She could be a real champion on a fast track. She's getting better and better now." The winner could go next in the GIII Dogwood S. May 23 at Churchill. Favored Marie J, fourth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and most recently third in the Providencia S. on the grass at Santa Anita April 5, trailed the field to the stretch and made up some ground late, but was no match for the top two. "We haven't been able to get a line on her," said her rider, Gary Stevens. "(Trainer Bob Baffert) said she has been lazy since she came (to Kentucky) and she hasn't been working very well. He put blinkers back on today because she had been so dull. She didn't break well and she dropped further and further back. She ran like she didn't care."
