THE "REAL" THING: KENTUCKY DERBY DOUBLE FOR BAFFERT

He is for real, but after **Real Quiet's** (Quiet American) victory at Churchill Downs yesterday, Bob Baffert's Kentucky Derby dossier is fast becoming legendary. Just two years ago Baffert was a virtual unknown, a Quarter Horse guy who stormed into Bluegrass country and nearly stole the show, missing out on the 1996 Derby by a nose with Cavonnier. Undaunted, he returned in '97 and this time saw the photo go his way, with Silver Charm the winner by a head. Real Quiet, the less-fancied half of the Baffert entry for this year's "Run for the Roses" at 8-1, saved ground around the first turn, was guided to the outside by jockey Kent Desormeaux on the final bend and rocketed past pacesetter **Old Trieste** (A.P. Indy) (10th) and stablemate **Indian Charlie** (In Excess {Ire}) (3rd) to take a length-and-a-half lead past the eighth pole. GII Arkansas Derby hero **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) was charging hard, but Real Quiet responded to win it by a half-length, giving Desormeaux his first Derby victory. "Turning for home, I asked him for his life and he gave it to me," said Desormeaux. "I switched to the right hand (whip) and the Fish (Real Quiet) switched to the right lead and he gave me four more jumps of strain and guts to the wire, and then all the emotions hit me. I couldn't throw my fist up in the air high enough. I was on the highest cloud in the sky." How did it feel for Baffert winning the second time around? "All week long I told my wife it was hard for me to get up for this race," he said. "I've been here three years in a row. It was old hat, everything was running smooth and I didn't think I'd ever feel the excitement like I did with Silver Charm. But it's unbelievable when those horses turn for home. It feels better every time I run in this race. I've just got to get back here next year." A Churchill crowd of 143,215 was on hand for the 124th running of the Kentucky Derby, third-highest attendance in the race's history. Real Quiet gave his trainer a second straight Derby victory, a feat accomplished in the past by such racing legends as Ben and Jimmy Jones, Lucien Laurin, D. Wayne Lukas and "Derby Dick" Thompson. Thompson won four Derbies, going back-to-back with Burgo King and Brokers Tip in 1932-33, but he may yet lose that nickname. A month ago he was "Dubai Bob" Baffert, but "Derby Bob" has a nice ring to it, too.

Real Quiet, thought to be the steady galloper of the two-horse Bob Baffert entry and owning an unfashionable 5.29 dosage, showed a brilliant turn of foot this time, sweeping to the lead with a quarter-mile to run, opening it up in the stretch and holding off a valiant Victory Gallop to give his trainer a second straight Kentucky Derby score. Runner-up to stablemate Indian Charlie in the GI Santa Anita Derby April 4, Real Quiet had only two wins to his credit entering the Derby, but one of those came in last year's GI Hollywood Futurity. A disappointing eighth in the Golden Gate Derby in his three-year-old bow, the bay came back to be second in the GII San Felipe before his Santa Anita Derby test and had been working bullets at Churchill. "I told (jockey Gary Stevens, on Indian Charlie) the only horse capable of running by you is Real Quiet," said Baffert. "I told (Real Quiet's rider, Kent Desormeaux), 'Put him in the race, don't worry about it, the horse has trained well.' He showed me he loves this racetrack." Victory Gallop, with just one horse beaten after six furlongs in 1:10 3/5, was still seventh after a mile, but finished fastest of all to just miss. "The post position (13) just killed us," said jockey Alex Solis. "I had no chance to drop in. He was flying at the end, but the post made the difference." Favored Indian Charlie made his bid at the top of the stretch; he was no match for the top two, but held off the late-charging HALORY HUNTER (Jade Hunter) for third. The 1997 Horse of the Year FAVORITE TRICK (Phone Trick), the second choice at 4-1, came with a run up the rail on the far turn, but tired badly and finished eighth. "I felt real good going past the half-mile...because I hadn't called on him," said his jockey, Pat Day. "But between the three-eighths and the quarter pole, he just kind of emptied out."



KING OF KINGS REIGNS IN 2000

GUINEAS "This horse is pure class and there is no substitute for that," said remarkable young Irish trainer Aidan O'Brien after Mrs. Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **King of Kings (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), his very first runner in an English Classic, lived up to the hype with a convincing 1 1/4-length victory in yesterday's G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, England. Making his three-year-old bow after a seven-month absence, the bay was last seen winning the G1 Aga Khan's National S. at The Curragh September 21. Coming off knee surgery, the sometimes temperamental colt was looking for his fifth win from six starts. The result was never in doubt as the 7-2 chance grabbed the lead from **Lend A Hand (GB)** (Great Commotion) inside the final eighth of a mile; although his rider Michael Kinane had to give up a couple of flicks with the whip, he stayed on well up the hill. Kinane, winning the one-mile Classic for the third time after success with Tirol (Ire) in 1990 and Entrepreneur (GB) last year, said: "If anyone had doubts about this horse's temperament, they have been dispelled with that performance. His attitude is fine and although he plays around and is a bit of a showman, he was better here than he is at home. I only had to give my horse a couple of flicks with the whip and he's done it very well." Coolmore boss John Magnier, husband of Susan Magnier, said: "We've always felt he was a good horse, although he didn't always show it on the track, but we felt like we should go on treating him like a good horse until he let us down. I'd also like to praise everyone at home, especially (jockey Christy Roche, who rode King of Kings at two). Without Christy, this horse would never have gone to the races. King Of Kings is one of those brilliant horses who could have gone either way, dare I say like Nijinsky, and Christy is a past master and always had faith in the horse." The winner could go next in the Vodafone Epsom Derby June 6. **Xaar (GB)** (Zafonic), the 10-11 favourite, was outpaced early, made very late progress on the wide outside, and just missed getting third. Said his trainer, Andre Fabre: "He ran to me as if he needs more distance, as he was making good ground at the end of the race. I will have to discuss the Derby with his owner, but it is still a possibility." Bookmakers, not convinced that Xaar's pedigree will enable him to get the 1 1/2 miles of the Vodafone Epsom Derby, have him at odds of 14-1.

Winner of the G1 Aga Khan's National S. last September 21, King of Kings (Ire) was off at 7-2 making his first start since that triumph. The colt settled just off the pace set by TAMARISK (Green Desert), moving up as Lend A Hand (GB) took command at the quarter pole and cutting down that rival as he quickened smoothly and went on to a decisive victory. "King Of Kings is a stronger horse this year and has answered every question we have asked of him," said trainer Aidan O'Brien, who won last year's Irish 2000 Guineas and Budweiser Irish Derby with Desert King (Ire). "I think this horse is just brilliant. He's entered for the Epsom Derby, but we'll have to discuss that. He was the King today, but tomorrow's another day. All credit must go to my staff for this victory and especially to Christy Roche, who rode him in all his races last year and who worked wonder with the horse. The ground in Ireland has been very wet this year and all of my horses have been needing a race, so I was a little worried about coming here first time out, but he's a brilliant horse and did it well." Lend A Hand's rider Darryl Holland said: "We've beaten some nice horses today and I would think Lend A Hand will now go for the (G1) St. James' Palace S. at Ascot (over a mile June 16)." The crowd's 10-11 choice XAAR (GB) (Zafonic) was well back in the early going, coming on late but being run out of third by the fast-finishing and previously undefeated Border Arrow (GB), who is now 12-1 second favourite for the Vodafone Epsom Derby.

A winner of all three of his 1998 starts, all stakes and all by impressive margins, Joyeux Danseur capped that streak with a six-length win in the GIII Explosive Bid H. at Fair Grounds March 29 for his first graded stakes win. He earned his first Grade I with another impressive score as the favorite here and has now taken eight of 10 outings since shipping to the U.S. from France in May, 1997. The five-year-old broke sharply and was sent to the lead past the stands the first time while well out in the course. Four-wide into the first turn, he remained wide and on the lead from that point on and cruised home while never seriously challenged. "This is something we have seen before," said trainer Albert Stall Jr. "He's a free-running colt who likes to be out in the middle of the track. He's a brilliant athlete. He's a Grade I horse who's been looking for a Grade I race."

The most seasoned performer in the field with 12 starts coming into this race, Dice Dancer finished second to Coronado's Quest in the GII Wood Memorial in his last start April 11; that came on the heels of a third to Favorite Trick in the GIII Swale March 14. The colt was looking for his first win in his last seven starts and was sent off the second choice. The role of the favorite went to the other Allen Jerkens' trainee in the race, Limit Out, four-for-four with a win in the GIII Bay Shore April 11. Settling just off the early pace, Dice Dancer made his move after a half and drew clear in the lane. "I think the (May 16, GI) Preakness is a little bit close for Dice Dancer, but you can't totally rule it out," said Jerkens. "Most likely, we'll point him toward the (July 12, GII) Dwyer." Jerkens said that Limit Out, a rallying third, would be aimed for the GII Peter Pan May 24, and perhaps the June 6 GI Belmont S.

Now it's on to the (GI, May 25) Met Mile (at Belmont Park)." Said trainer Elliott Walden, "He does it time and time again as long as I put him at the right distance."
