KENTUCKY DERBY WRAP-UP Trainer Bob Baffert said yesterday that his Derby duo of **Real Quiet** (Quiet American), winner by a half-length, and **Indian Charlie** (In Excess {Ire}), third in his first-ever career defeat, came out of the race in good order and would likely head to Maryland for the GI Preakness May 16. "Right now, I would say they're both going to go," said Baffert. As for his second straight Derby triumph, the trainer said, "I sort of feel relieved, because I really thought I could win this thing. People expected me to win, too. All of the fans cheering for me--I didn't want to let them down. The closer it got, I felt the pressure of the fans." Runner-up **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) may skip the trip to Maryland and point instead for the GI Belmont S. June 6. The Canadian-bred is also expected to compete in the GIC Queen's Plate at Woodbine June 21. "We will stay here a week and probably skip the Preakness and go on to the Belmont," said trainer Elliott Walden. "We will kind of regroup and think about it; those plans are not definite." **Halory Hunter** (Jade Hunter), a late-running fourth Saturday, exited the race well. "I want to give it a couple of days, but I don't see why we shouldn't go to the Preakness," said trainer Nick Zito. "He is certainly one of the better three-year-olds. He never runs a bad race, and he is right there all the time." **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick), eighth as the second choice in the Derby, is a longshot for the Preakness, according to trainer Bill Mott. "The Preakness is a remote possibility, but we'll let the dust settle and give it a couple of days. We have to get him back in the right spots, and the mile-and-a-quarter Derby distance is not the right spot." **Old Trieste** (A.P. Indy), who stumbled badly at the start, then set the pace before fading to finish 10th, returned from his effort a little the worse for the wear. "He's okay, but he has a swelling in his right front," said trainer Mike Puype. "That's not any reason why he stopped or anything. He grabbed himself coming out of the gate. You watch the head-on replay in slow motion and see how bad he fell...to recover like that and get to the lead with a half in :45, I'm proud of him. He broke right on his face--he had never done that before." Trainer Randy Bradshaw intends to send Derby 13th-place finisher **Artax** (Marquetry) for a complete check-up. "I'm going to send him over to Rood and Riddle and just check him all over to see if they can find anything," said Bradshaw. "We will freshen him up and bring him back in a little bit. I know in my heart that when he is right, he is as good as Real Quiet, because he has run with him too many times."

All the good vibes about Cape Verdi (Ire)'s trial in Dubai a few weeks earlier were proven to be correct when she demolished this field, cantering home by five lengths to give jockey Frankie Dettori and the Godolphin team their first English 1000 Guineas success. The outfit has now completed the full set of five English Classics in only five years. The easiest kind of winner, Cape Verdi shot into the lead at the quarter pole and was soon clear. Aidan O'Brien's Shahtoush (Ire) just got home in a desperate scramble for second. Bookmakers who had Cape Verdi at 10-1 for the Oaks at Epsom June 5 have now shortened her to as little as 7-4. Purchased shortly before the G1 Cheveley Park S. in September from breeder Robert Sangster, Cape Verdi was fourth in that final juvenile start, a loss later attributed to the fact that she was in season. Said Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum, "I'm relieved. When I bought her before the Cheveley Park S. I knew she was a very good filly and I thought she would come back and be a very good filly." The Oaks will be next. Said Dettori, "She pulled up in a canter. That's the first time in my career that I have ridden a horse like that. I think she can win the Oaks." Trainer Aidan O'Brien said Shahtoush may run next in the Irish 1000 Guineas May 25. **TARASCON (IRE)** (Tirol {Ire}), winner of the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at two, was unruly in the gate, almost taking the stall door off its hinges. She took part early, but was soon a spent force and trailed home last of 16.

The winner of the GI Illinois Derby at three, Wild Rush had just one race under his belt as a four-year-old prior to this start, having finished fourth in the GI Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. after getting caught up in a speed duel last out at Santa Anita. Partnered again with Kent Desormeaux, who hadn't been aboard since their joint victory at Sportsman's, Wild Rush was taken off the pace, moved up on the bend to turn for home a head in front of Banker's Gold and dug in through the lane for the tight victory. "The mistake was rushing him early in his last race," said trainer Richard Mandella, "but today he was very handy and well within himself." The trainer said he would confer with owner Frank Stronach regarding the colt's next start. Said Desormeaux, picking up his second Grade I win of the weekend after his Kentucky Derby victory Saturday, "He was tested a lot more than I thought down the stretch, but he just didn't want to give way to anyone." Highweight KELLY KIP (Kipper Kelly), the second choice here, was looking for his first win at the distance and took the lead after a half, but tired to be fourth. "The weight got him today," said jockey Jean-Luc Samyn.

Disqualified and placed third as the even-money choice in the GI El Encino S. January 18 and third again as the 7-5 chalk in the GI La Canada S. in her latest February 8, I Ain't Bluffing was well-bet to rebound for her first win of the year. The bay was in hand while sitting behind pacesetter Fun In Excess through three-quarters in 1:10 4/5, challenged for the lead at the top of the lane and inched away in the final furlong for her first score since taking the GI La Brea S. December 27. "The plan was--if she would cooperate--just to try and not get in a speed duel," said jockey Chris McCarron. "She cooperated nicely. I just made sure Fun In Excess didn't gallop for seven-eighths of a mile before I went after her. I made her run around the turn a little bit to soften her up some. That was it from there." Trainer Ron Ellis said the filly will face MGISW Exotic Wood, a former Ellis trainee, in the GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. May 30. "She'll go against one of the best fillies in the country," said Ellis. "It'll be a good race. That's why I was so concerned about her relaxing in here. She doesn't have the type of speed as Exotic Wood. She can't go with her, so I'd like to see her lay a little behind her. To face her next time--it'll be an interesting twist."

124TH DERBY SETS WAGERING RECORDS Preliminary handle figures on Saturday's Kentucky Derby card at Churchill Downs established across-the-board records. Total handle from all sources (including on-track) on the 10-race program was \$88,718,167, breaking the mark of \$82,812,456 set last year. On-track wagering was a record \$18,733,283, while off-track the Derby Day card attracted \$69,984,884 in wagers, up from the previous peak of \$65,692,489 set in '97. Total handle on the 124th running of the Kentucky Derby was an all-time high \$55,017,632. A record \$5,104,486 was wagered on the Derby at Hollywood Park and its satellite sites, boosting the track's handle for the day to a meet-record \$23,500,459. The Derby generated a total handle mark of \$8,723,810 at Golden Gate Fields. Fans at Lone Star Park wagered \$720,594 on the "Run for the Roses," setting a new Texas standard for handle on a single race. The total handle on Saturday's Lone Star card was a record \$3.3 million, and wagering from all sources was over \$6 million, highest in track history. The Kentucky Derby Day card propelled the handle at Woodbine over \$7 million (Canadian) for the first time, with \$7,000,904 wagered on-track and at its affiliates.

Owner Stuart Janney III said yesterday that Saturday's Kentucky Derby did nothing to help him decide whether Gil Wood Memorial winner **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner) would make his next start in the May 16 GI Preakness or the May 25 GI Metropolitan H. "It was not a race that struck fear into your heart, but that doesn't mean anything more than that," said Janney. "I'm going to New York on Wednesday or Thursday and will talk to (trainer Shug McGaughey). It's just whether we can get the right conditions to get him to the gate (for the Preakness) so that we have a chance to win."

Sent off the favorite after winning his last three, Zap Happy's lone loss had come in his career debut October 25. A winner of a six-furlong maiden and a 1 1/16-mile allowance last season, he came out running in his sophomore debut April 19, taking a seven-furlong allowance by 5 3/4 lengths. Fourth early here, the gelding moved to the lead on the turn and passed pacesetter Vobiscum for the win. Trainer Bob Tiller said that Zap Happy would now be pointed to the June 21 GIC Queen's Plate at Woodbine, but he hasn't yet mapped out the exact road. "We're not going to panic," said Tiller. "We're in great shape right now. I do know one thing--we're going to have a fresh horse. You're not going to see this horse run too often before the Plate."

The third-longest shot in this eight-horse field, Born Mighty came into this race with three '98 turf allowance wins to his credit, but had faltered in his lone stakes attempt, finishing ninth in the GIII Bougainvillea H. at Hialeah March 29 in his last outing. The colt, who was competing in \$32,000 claiming events as recently as November, sat second-to-last early here, swung five-wide on the turn and was hard-ridden to get up for the win. The 3-5 favorite, Ok by Me, winner of the GIII New Hampshire Sweepstakes last year, was second in the Bougainvillea in his last start, his '98 debut. He rallied into the stretch to take a short lead, but was outfinished by the top two.

Local News: Florida

When the Florida legislative session closed on May 1, Hialeah walked away with the biggest pari-mutuel prizes. The new law, which goes into effect on July 1, gives the fabled old track at least three more years to run, through the year 2001, and the hope for many more years. Included in the bill is a grant of \$185,000 for a feasibility study. The money has to be used by the city of Hialeah to look at the possibility of buying out owner John Brunetti. The plan is the dream child of Mayor Raul Martinez, who wants the city to purchase the track. Martinez hopes to use some of the track's 220 acres to develop a mall and entertainment center, in addition to conducting a yearly race meeting. The appraisal for the track and grounds has to be submitted to the legislature by November 15. Also in the recently passed pari-mutuel bill is the removal of a 10 p.m. curfew on simulcasting. Now tracks can take simulcasting around the clock if they wish. Hialeah's tax was reduced from \$0.07 to \$0.02 on each dollar handled. Both Calder and Gulfstream will be allowed to direct 0.25 percent of each tax dollar to purses rather than returning the money to the state. Also excluded was a tax that each track had to pay on guest passes. Included in the bill was a double taxation on a track that runs outside its allotted dates, which Gulfstream and Calder had tried to have removed.
