**ASTARABAD SOLD** Astarabad (Alleged), winner of the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp April 26, has been purchased privately for an undisclosed sum from the Aga Khan by Hubert Guy of Bloodstock Management Services. "I bought the horse for (television producer) David Milch," said Guy. "Astarabad will stay in Europe for now and will continue to be trained by Alain de Royer-Dupre. There is an agreement for the horse to run under the Aga Khan's colors in Europe until October. Then his main objective will be the Breeders' Cup Turf." Julio Canani will train the four-year-old in America. Bred in Kentucky, Astarabad has won four of his 11 starts, including the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at three, and earned \$324,846; he was also third to French champion Peintre Celebre in last year's G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby). He will make his next start in the Prix d'Ispahan May 21 at Longchamp.

**CAPTAIN MAESTRI EUTHANIZED** According to the *Daily Racing Form* on-line, three-year-old **Captain Maestri** (Dynaformer), who suffered a fractured right front cannon bone when third in the GIII Louisiana Derby March 15, had to be put down last week due to complications following surgery. The colt, a multiple-stakes winner of three of his 10 starts and \$238,670, underwent reconstructive surgery at Priest and Harthill Equine Clinic in Lexington, but developed a staph infection and had to be euthanized.

"My original plan was to run in the Peter Pan (GI, May 24 at Belmont Park) and then go in the Belmont S. (June 6), but he worked so good this morning on a muddy track that he really didn't like," said trainer Pat Byrne. "Now I'm saying to myself it might be foolish to skip the Preakness when this horse is doing so well."

**Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner), pointing for the GI Preakness May 16 or the GI Met Mile May 25, worked six furlongs in 1:12 4/5 at Belmont yesterday morning. As for the colt's next start, trainer Shug McGaughey said, "I probably won't make up my mind until Wednesday. I'll see how he's doing between now and then and make a decision."
