XAAR OUT OF EPSOM DERBY **Xaar (GB)**

(Zafonic), who finished fourth as the favorite in the May 2 G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, will miss the G1 Vodafone Epsom Derby June 6, it was confirmed yesterday. "He is absolutely sound, but he is below par," said owner Prince Khalid Abdullah's racing manager, Grant Pritchard-Gordon. "I saw him earlier this week and he clearly wasn't right and was visibly out of sorts. I think you can rule him out of the Derby." Last year's two-year-old champion in England and France, Xaar has won five of his seven career starts, earning \$416,611.

COUNTESS DIANA RETURNS WEDNESDAY

Last year's Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Countess Diana** (Deerhound) is scheduled to make her three-year-old debut in the GIII \$75,000a Nassau County S. at seven furlongs, to be run during this Wednesday's opening day card at Belmont Park. The former Patrick Byrne-trainee, who has now switched to Bill Mott's barn, has not started since winning the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies by 8 1/2 lengths at Hollywood Park Nov. 8. In mid-December, Richard S. Kaster's filly underwent surgery to remove chips in her knee, and was back walking a month later. During her championship season, she won five of six starts with one second-place finish for earnings of \$1,019,785.

BARRETT'S SPRING PREVIEW RESULTS

Wormser, Inc. consignee covered the distance in :10.21. The fastest two furlongs of the sales preview was logged by Hip 129, an unnamed chestnut filly by Dehere-Our Little Margie (Majestic Light). Consigned by Jerry Bailey Sales Agency, Agent, the Kentucky-bred breezed in :21.77. The fastest three furlongs, :34.20, was posted by Hip 205, a dark bay or brown filly by St. Jovite-Spring Innocence (Sharpen Up {GB}). Named **Sweetness Follows**, the filly is consigned to the sale by Sequel Bloodstock, Inc. (Becky Thomas), Agent.

Second to Gentlemen (Arg) in last year's Pimlico Special, Skip Away rode a four-race Grade I winning streak into this year's event. The Champion Older Horse of 1997 wrapped up his four-year-old season with wins in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, and picked right up where he left off, scoring in the GI Donn H. and the GI Gulfstream Park H. this winter. Off since that Feb. 28 victory but sharpened by four bullet works in the past month, Skip Away bounded out of the gate here, led the field through the first turn and down the backstretch and drew away at the top of the stretch for the victory while never seriously challenged as the crowd's overwhelming 1-5 choice. "He was great," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "He took command on the turn. I just shook my whip at him and he dropped down two inches and took off so hard it threw me right into the back seat. Right now, anyone would be hard pressed to beat him." Skip Away's trainer Sonny Hine added, "When somebody told me that it was the most weight anybody had carried since 1937, it worried me a bit. One more to go (Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs May 30), and then it's weight-for-age races. He's a great racehorse. I think he's going to go down in history as a great horse. He deserves it. He's just a special horse."

Yarrow Brae managed just one win from seven starts at two, but hasn't missed hitting the board since finishing second in the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill in his next-to-last start of '97. While winning just once this year coming into this event, he had been second in two graded stakes--the March 29 GII Jim Beam at Turfway and the April 25 GIII Derby Trial--in his last two outings. The fourth choice here, he stalked the early pace of Orville N Wilbur's, took a short lead entering the stretch and edged away for the win. Orville N Wilbur's lugged in during the final furlong, forcing One Bold Stroke to check on the rail, and was demoted from second to third. Winning jockey Willie Martinez said of Yarrow Brae, "He broke good, then scrambled a little bit for position. We were right in the race without much trouble. The colt was pretty much his own pilot after that." GIII Derby Trial winner SOUVENIR COPY (Mr. Prospector) was seventh as the 2-1 favorite. "He just didn't have it today," said his rider, David Flores. "We had no trouble, no traffic. I thought I was placed in a perfect spot in third, but it seemed like he didn't like the track, which seemed a little deep and loose, and he didn't handle the turns too well."

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

FINAL KENTUCKY DERBY WAGERING

FIGURES RELEASED It's official: the final figures for wagering on the 124th Kentucky Derby are in, and new records have been established across the board. The combined total for the entire Derby Day card climbed to \$88,941,006, an increase of 8.10 percent from the previous record set last year. The on-track total at Churchill Downs provided the largest gain from 1997, up 8.63 percent to \$18,467,859. Total wagering on the Kentucky Derby race rose to an all-time high of \$55,240,673, an increase of 7.25 from last year. The on-track figure for the Derby was \$8,343,844, a gain of 6.81 percent from 1997. Kentucky Derby attendance totaled 143,215, the third-largest crowd in Derby history.

DANCE FLOOR TO CALIFORNIA Dance Floor (Star de Naskra), a multiple graded stakes winner of \$863,299 who finished third behind Lil E. Tee in the 1992 Kentucky Derby, will return to the U.S. from New Zealand for stud duties beginning in 1999. The nine-year-old stallion was purchased by Jeff Gangi of Texacali Racing and will be syndicated to stand at stud in Solvang, California at Monty and Pat Roberts' Flag Is Up Farms for a stud fee of \$3,500. "I'm looking forward to adding a stallion of Dance Floor's caliber to my stallion roster," said Gangi. "There's no doubt Dance Floor will have an immediate impact on a booming California breeding market."

PREAKNESS S.-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo, 1 3/16m

Kentucky Derby fourth **Halory Hunter** (Jade Hunter) arrived at Pimlico for the Preakness after a 14-hour van trip from Louisville, Kentucky Friday. The GII Toyota Blue Grass winner took to the Maryland track for the first time Saturday, taking what trainer Nick Zito called a "light gallop" under regular exercise rider Terri Berwanger. "Everything's fine," Zito reported.

Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance), who missed by only a half-length when second in the May 2 Kentucky Derby, is back on the Preakness possibles list, said David Fortner, assistant to trainer Elliott Walden, yesterday. "It's a very, very strong possibility," Fortner said. "He came out of the race very, very good, and it looks like a much smaller field than the Derby."
