**CORONADO ON PREAKNESS QUEST** The GII Wood Memorial S. winner **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner) will make his next start in Saturday's GI Preakness S. "After days of thinking about it, actually since Thursday, I decided it was the best place to go," explained trainer Shug McGaughey. "I think he figures big in the race. If he wins, it would make a bigger impact, rather than the Met Mile." As for the behavioral problems that kept the temperamental colt out of the Kentucky Derby, McGaughey said, "I'll bring my own pony boy that has worked with him in New York at Aqueduct. He'll saddle with the rest of the horses on the turf course. There is plenty of room out there if he gets to acting up. With the pony we ought to be able to get him to settle down." Mike Smith, who returns to riding Wednesday after an injury suffered in a Gulfstream spill, will ride Coronado's Quest. The addition of Coronado's Quest brings the list of definite Preakness starters to seven: **Real Quiet** (Quiet American), **Indian Charlie** (In Excess {Ire}), **Halory Hunter** (Jade Hunter), **Cape Town** (Seeking the Gold), **Hot Wells** (Go and Go {Ire}), **Classic Cat** (Mountain Cat). **Chilito** (Strawberry Road {Aus}), **Black Cash** (Deposit Ticket) and **Basic Trainee** (Majestic Light) remain on the fence.

 A first French 2000 Guineas win for owner Robert Sangster and a great triumph for his trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam, who made the decision only last week to supplement **Victory Note** at a cost of 100,000 francs (\$16,610). The colt won the G3 Tripleprint **Greenham S.** at Newbury April 18 on heavy ground, but handled the firm going here, setting a stakes record. **Muhtathir** (GB) set a fast pace, with **Victory Note** racing well in rear. On the final turn **Muhtathir** quickened clear of the field and looked the probable winner, but jockey John Reid brought **Victory Note** out of the pack to throw down his challenge inside the final furlong and assert his superiority close to home. Said Sangster, "Firsts are always great. It's also great for Peter Chapple-Hyam. He made the decision to supplement and it was money well spent. The horse has been working brilliantly since the **Greenham S.** We were worried whether he would stay or not...but he won well here and the (one mile) **G1 St. James' Palace S.** at Ascot (June 16) must be a possibility. Let's strike while the iron is hot." Chapple-Hyam said: "I thought **Victory Note** was only a sprinter...that's why we didn't enter him for some of the major mile races. But he worked tremendously last week and I didn't have to persuade Robert Sangster and John Magnier to supplement him for this race. John Reid rode him brilliantly, taking him back and keeping him covered up. He mustn't see daylight too soon or he takes off." The **St. James' Palace S.** is also next for **Muhtathir**. Trainer **Criquette Head**, downcast after the dismal effort by favored **WITH THE FLOW** (Irish River {Fr}), said: "That was just too bad to be true, but we have no clues as to why. Something will probably turn up."

An impressive French 1000 Guineas victory for the Aga Khan's Zalaiyka (Fr), winner of the G3 Prix de la Grotte here April 19. As late as last week there were serious doubts about her participation, with blood tests showing that she had problems; her owner/breeder explained: "Yes, we were worried. Fortunately (trainer) Alain de Royer-Dupre noticed that she had a problem and didn't work her. He had some tests done on her, which apparently showed that she had too many enzymes in her muscles. She missed one day in her preparation, but that helped clear the problem up fast. She showed today just how classy she is and the way she ran suggests she might get further. We have some other good fillies running during the next week and only after we have seen their results will we decide whether or not Zalaiyka runs in the (G1) Prix de Diane (French Oaks at Chantilly June 7)." Godolphin's La Nuit Rose (Fr), on only her second racecourse appearance, set a good pace, but Zalaiyka closed before the final turn and made her challenge early in the stretch, soon going several lengths clear of the field and winning unchallenged. Criquette Head's Cortona (Ire) finished well to snatch second from La Nuit Rose at the wire. Head said: "I'm very pleased with my filly, but we were beaten by a better horse on the day." Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford said of La Nuit Rose: "That was a very good effort considering her lack of experience. She will stay at a mile for the time being and the (G1) Coronation S. at Ascot (June 17) is a possibility for her."

Wafic Said's Croco Rouge (Ire), who won the G2 Prix Greffulhe here on his previous start April 19, now looks set to take his chance in the G1 Vodafone Epsom Derby June 6 in preference to the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly May 31, at least if trainer Pascal Bary has his way. The colt was well back early as SMARTLY TAX (Miswaki) set the pace for stable companion Special Quest (Fr), who raced in third. Special Quest quickened to take the lead on the turn, but Croco Rouge came with his challenge while the blinkered Daymarti (Ire) began his move from several lengths behind. Inside the final eighth of a mile, Croco Rouge asserted his superiority and ran on well, with Daymarti finishing strongly to grab second. "Croco Rouge is probably the best middle-distance colt I've ever trained," said Bary. "He's very handy and has good acceleration. I now have to make a decision between the French Derby at Chantilly or the Epsom Derby a week later. Personally I am leaning towards Epsom."

#### Local News, South Africa:

Laurie and Jean Jaffee's South African Horse Of The Year **London News (SAf)** (Bush Telegraph {SAf}) returned to the winner's circle for the first time since his victory in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong in April, 1997 when, ridden for the first time by Piere Strydom, he captured Saturday's G2 Drill Hall S. over seven furlongs at Greyville in Durban. Trainer Alec Laird is now expected to target London News at the Rothmans July H., run over a mile and three-eighths at Greyville on July 4. The five-year-old won the race in 1996.
