KENTUCKY CUP HIGHLIGHTS TURFWAY

FALL MEET Turfway Park's fall meet, which opens September 9, will feature nine stakes worth \$1.4 million. The highlight of the 23-day season is the fifth running of the \$1,150,000 Kentucky Cup Day of Champions set for September 26. The six-race series includes the \$500,000 GIII Kentucky Cup Classic at nine furlongs for three-year-olds and up, the \$250,000 GII Turfway Breeders' Cup for fillies and mares at 1 1/16 mile, the \$150,000 GII Kentucky Cup Sprint for three-year-olds going six furlongs and the \$100,000 GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile over 1 1/16 miles. The meet's opening weekend feature will be the \$100,000 GIII Kentucky Cup Preview on September 12. "Our Fall Meet schedule promises to give the racing fans of this area the opportunity to see some of the biggest and brightest stars of our sport," commented Damon Thayer, Turfway's director of communication. "Offering a high-caliber racing product to our fans both locally and across the nation, via simulcasting, continues to be an important component of our business plan."

TOUCH GOLD WORKS GI Belmont S. winner **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister) worked for the first time since a last-place finish in last year's Breeders' Cup Classic Wednesday at Churchill Downs. The four-year-old colt, now trained by Patrick Byrne, breezed three furlongs over a fast track in :36 4/5. In 11 starts to date, Touch Gold has won five races, including the GI Haskell Invitational, and has earned \$1,585,627.

Reversing the form of the G3 Sagaro S. at Newmarket May 1 when beaten by Persian Punch (Ire), Busy Flight (GB) won his first Group race and for the sixth time from 16 lifetime starts with this clever victory. The win owed much to the good judgement of his rider Michael Hills, who, like his trainer father Barry, was winning the Yorkshire Cup for the first time. Persian Punch cut out the pace with Busy Flight sitting fourth; at the quarter-mile mark SACHO (IRE) (Sadler's Wells) grabbed the lead, only to be immediately challenged by Strategic Choice, who took over inside the final eighth of a mile. But Michael Hills had timed Busy Flight's run to perfection and the five-year-old quickened well to take the race in the final strides and earn himself a possible tilt at the 2 1/2-mile G1 Ascot Gold Cup June 18. "We've tried to teach him to settle and he's started to learn," said Michael Hills. "He had a good lead from Strategic Choice and had enough left for the sprint home. He's a very versatile horse, from a mile and a half to two miles or more, so the Ascot Gold Cup is a possibility." Last year's winner CELERIC (GB) (Mtoto {GB}), making his second start for trainer John Dunlop, was always in the rear and never showed with a chance.

A first Group race win for the progressive mare Bollin Joanne (GB) and her trainer Tim Easterby and she will stay in the top flight in future, heading for either the six-furlong G2 Cork & Orrery S. at Ascot June 18 or the five-furlong G2 King's Stand S. at the same track June 19. Making her first start since October, Bollin Joanne was winning for the sixth time from 19 lifetime starts. Responding well to the continual driving of champion jockey Kieren Fallon, Bollin Joanne came to challenge the 5-2 favorite Elnadim (from whom she was receiving nine pounds) at halfway and outbattled him to the wire. "She's always been a very nice filly and has just kept on improving," said Easterby. "Fortunately her owner Lady Westbrook is very patient and gives her horses and her trainers plenty of time. Kieren thought this filly would get better with age and thinks she will improve still further. She'll go for all the best sprints now, including one at Ascot and the (G1) July Cup at Newmarket (July 9)."

Mahboob went into the lead from the outset, followed by the eventual winner; as the field hit the top of the stretch, Mahboob quickened, but was soon joined by Gold Away. A tight duel ensued in which Gold Away triumphed by a neck at the wire. The winner now points to the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly May 31.

Pascal Bary will have a strong hand in either the English or French Derby this season judging by the manner in which the aptly named Dream Well (Fr) swooped fast and late to land the spoils in this French Derby trial. Vezing (Fr) set the early pace on a four-length lead, with Dream Well restrained in mid-division. As the field rounded the home turn Epistolaire (Ire) joined Vezing for the lead and pressed ahead at the 3/16th-pole, but Dream Well quickened well to run out an impressive winner at the wire.

Local News, Australia:

Champion stayer **Might and Power (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) continued his winning ways with a record-breaking 5 3/4-length win in Tuesday's G2 A. D. Hollindale Cup over a mile and an eighth on the Gold Coast in Queensland. Taking the lead after the first quarter-mile, the Jack Denham-trained four-year-old gelding cruised home in a new race-record time of 1:47.20, taking almost a second off the previous mark. Might And Power now heads for the G1 Doomben Cup over a mile and a quarter in Brisbane May 23. Victory there would enable him to become the first horse in Australian racing history to win \$3 million (Australian) (\$1,939,739) in one season.

Breeders' Cup Mile winner **Barathea (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), eight, who stands at Rathbarry Stud in Ireland, sired his first winner with his first runner when Prince Fahd Salman's homebred colt **Red Sea (GB)**, trained by Paul Cole, won Wednesday's Grosvenor Casino Newcastle Conditions S. over six furlongs for two-year-olds at York.

Lord Weinstock's **Greek Dance (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), trained by Michael Stoute, shot to the head of the betting for the G1 Vodafone Epsom Derby June 6 with a six-length defeat of Prince Fahd Salman's highly-rated colt **Capri (GB)** (Generous {Ire}) in the Michael Seely Memorial Glasgow Conditions S. at York yesterday. Ladbrokes were most impressed of all the bookmakers, making him 4-1 favorite, while William Hills have him at 5-1. "He has to be considered as a serious Derby contender after that effort," said Stoute, who has trained three Epsom Derby winners. Jockey Walter Swinburn, who rode all three of Stoute's Epsom Derby winners, could not contain his excitement, saying: "I've always liked the horse and I was nervous before the race because we've always thought of him as a Derby horse. I was very pleased with the way he quickened three times today when he had to. Once he hit the front he was only doing what he had to do and no more. I'm delighted. He's a manoeuvrable horse and Epsom will be no problem, nor will the ground. People knocked the form when he won his maiden, but he's made the step up to this now and now we've got to ask him to make the big leap."

Local News, New Zealand:

In a deal negotiated by New Zealand bloodstock agent Andrew Seabrook and Australian agent John Foote, the two-year-old New Zealand-trained gelding **Alf (NZ)** (Masterclass), winner of the G1 AJC Sires Produce S. in Sydney April 13, has been sold to race in Hong Kong for a reported price of \$1 million (New Zealand) (\$534,102). Trained by father and son team Dave and Paul O'Sullivan, Alf also won twice in four starts in New Zealand, including the NZ Magic Millions Classic at Trentham in Wellington in January.
