CORONADO'S QUEST OUT OF

PREAKNESS The much-anticipated appearance of the obstreperous **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner) in today's Preakness has been called off due to a bruised foot. The colt, morning-line favorite after winning the Gil Wood Memorial April 11, came up with a bruised right rear foot, his only white foot, after a routine gallop yesterday morning. "He galloped this morning and when he went by me, he looked fine, but when the exercise rider pulled him to a jog, he said he didn't feel exactly right," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "We cooled him out and gave him a bath and he was off, but not that off. We put the hoof testers on him and he walked out of his stall on his toes. The vet took five pictures of his pasterns and they were clean. The blacksmith came by and as soon as he pulled that shoe off, he said he had a hot spot...it's half to two-thirds of the way up on the outside of the right rear foot, about the size of a dime. I hope now that we've pared it away, by 6:00 tonight, he'll be much better. I'm hoping to make the Met Mile...he can't run in the Belmont without another race first. I'm disappointed. You can always catch the next maiden race, but he can't catch the next Preakness."

ADDED GOLD BANKS BLACK-EYED SUSAN

Making her stakes debut in what was only her fourth career start, **Added Gold** (Gilded Time) was bet down to even-money in yesterday's Gil Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico and came through for the crowd, getting up in the final strides for a three-quarter length victory over 41-1 outsider **Tappin' Ginger** (Fred Astaire). Stretching out after finishing second in a mile allowance at Aqueduct April 11, the chestnut miss was rated near the back of the pack after breaking a step slowly, but closed with determination to wear down her longshot rival at the wire. "There was a lot of speed in there and she rated very nicely," said winning trainer Dave Donk. "We're still learning about her. She has speed, but we're trying to teach her to rate." Added jockey John Velazquez, "David likes to teach his horses to come off the pace. Since she broke slow, it worked out fine. As we went down the backside she began to relax real nice, and my worries went out of my head." (*Black-Eyed Susan Chart, p2*)

Added Gold broke her maiden by an impressive 12 1/4 lengths in her second lifetime start and two-turn debut at Gulfstream March 8, then showed good speed and finished second in an Aqueduct allowance race at a one-turn mile in her most recent outing April 11. Trying two turns once again, the chestnut jumped right into graded-stakes company and was strongly backed as the even-money favorite. She settled well off the pace after a slightly tardy break, but rallied from between horses in the stretch drive and just got up to edge longshot Tappin' Ginger in the closing yards. "She was a little farther back than I had hoped early, and turning for home she looked like she was second-best," said winning trainer Dave Donk, who will take his filly back to Belmont Park with an eye toward the Triple Tiara, which begins with the GI Acorn S. June 7.

Limnos (Jpn) becomes the first European Group race winner for sire Hector Protector, who has been based this season at the English National Stud at Newmarket, but who returns to John Messara's Arrowfield Stud in Australia in August. LUSO (GB) (Salse) shot from the gate and was soon several lengths clear, setting a moderate pace, but jockey Cash Asmussen on Limnos was only biding his time and once he asked his mount for his effort, the race was settled quickly. Kashwan (Spa) finished well for second, while For Valour was perhaps unlucky, hitting traffic problems in the stretch. The Niarchos family's racing manager Alan Cooper said: "Limnos is a very nice colt. He has had four races this spring and we will probably wait now until the (G1) Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud at the end of June (June 28). But his long-term target is the (G1) Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (October 4)."

TWO PUNCH COLT TOPS FASIG-TIPTON

MIDLANTIC PREVIEW The Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, which produced last year's champion sprinter Smoke Glacken, saw another son of Two Punch top the three-furlong workouts at the auction's under tack preview Friday. Hip #485, a colt by Two Punch out of Chief Appeal (Valid Appeal), a half-brother to MSW Turkappeal (Turkoman), went the distance in :34 3/5. There was a three-way tie for the fastest one-furlong work, with the time of :10 3/5 shared by Hip #315, **Speculation**, a colt by Allen's Prospect--Stay Up Late (Aloma's Ruler); Hip #331, **Out Of Sweets**, a filly by Out Of Place--Sweet Side (Topsider); and Hip #462, a colt by West by West--Braid (Devil's Bag). Hip #478, a colt by Aloha Prospector--Carni Gal (Carnivalay) clocked the quickest work at a quarter, going in :21 3/5. A total of 529 two-year-olds have been catalogued for the two-day sale, set for May 18-19. Bidding begins at 10 a.m. daily.
