### ALL'S "QUIET" AT PIMLICO: DERBY WINNER PREVAILS IN PREAKNESS

**Real Quiet** (Quiet American) lived up to his name before the Kentucky Derby, sneaking into the starting gate on the first Saturday in May at 8-1, but thundering down that long Churchill stretch to victory. The Kentucky-bred made even more noise at Pimlico yesterday afternoon, moving one step closer to that elusive Triple Crown, charging to a 2 1/4-length triumph in the second jewel, the GI Preakness. "He was never taken seriously," said trainer Bob Baffert. "But I told (owner Mike Pegram) before the Derby, 'I've got to pay more attention to this horse, he's really coming around.' He has been in the shadow of (stablemate and Derby favorite Indian Charlie), but I think we'll take him real serious now. 'The Fish' has turned into a shark." The 5-2 second choice, Real Quiet had good position outside of slight favorite **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) down the backside as the rabbit **Baquero** (Forty Niner) (7<sup>th</sup>) set a solid pace. The Derby winner had dead aim on the leaders, firing his best shot as they raced around the far turn, sweeping to the front at the top of the lane and drawing off impressively. Victory Gallop, the runner-up at Churchill, followed him home, second best once again. Kent Desormeaux, who dominated the Maryland jockey colony before shifting his tack to California, was winning his first Preakness. "Oh my God, I'd be remiss if I didn't thank you, Maryland," said the jubilant jockey. "You gave me the credentials to have the opportunity to move to the next level." Desormeaux was full of praise for his Preakness champ as well. "Real Quiet was in the bridle, telling me, 'I've got these guys whenever you want, just let me know.' He wasn't really giving it his all. He was sharper today than before the Derby. I think I got a bigger run out of him; he ran better today than he did in the Derby. He's a wonderful horse." It has been 20 years since Affirmed dueled Alydar for his Triple Crown, but trainer Bob Baffert, who came within three-quarters of a length of pulling off the feat with Silver Charm last year, will take another crack at it in the Belmont S. June 6. It is the first time a trainer has had that chance two years running. "I'm not going to let you guys down," Baffert told the media. "We will get the third leg." But trainer Elliott Walden has other ideas. His Victory Gallop will be in the gate at Belmont Park. "He just got beat fair and square, but we'll see next time. We're not going to just give them the Triple Crown," said Walden.

Following in the hoofsteps of stablemate Silver Charm, Real Quiet came off a narrow half-length victory in the GI Kentucky Derby May 2 looking to add the second leg of the Triple Crown to his resume. The second choice behind Derby crown second Victory Gallop, he proved much the best this time. The bay came away from the gate sharply, settling near the back of the pack from his outside post position in the run to the first turn, then moving up down the backstretch to sit just off the leaders, and just off the flank of Victory Gallop. When that rival launched his bid going into the far turn, Real Quiet answered with an explosive move of his own, striding into the lead as pacesetter BAQUERO (Forty Niner) and third choice CAPE TOWN (Seeking the Gold) faded; he easily kicked away from Victory Gallop in the stretch. Looking forward to the Belmont S. June 6, jockey Kent Desormeaux said, "There's going to be some nerves there. Now that we've got the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness out of the way, we're messing with history." Real Quiet will attempt to become the 12th Triple Crown winner. Victory Gallop will also go next in the third jewel in the Crown.

**POWER OUTAGE DISRUPTS 123<sup>rd</sup> PREAKNESS**

After losing three favorites in the final days before the race, the 123<sup>rd</sup> Preakness was hit by more bad luck yesterday afternoon when a transformer went down, causing a power failure in the Pimlico grandstand just after 1 p.m. With temperatures rising into the 90s, the grandstand was not only without power, but also without air conditioning, lights, closed-circuit television, a public address system, elevators and escalators--and without betting. There was wagering in the infield as the races went on as scheduled, and limited power was restored to the clubhouse during the course of the afternoon, but the betting windows never opened in the grandstand. A record crowd of 91,122 was on hand at Pimlico yesterday, but an estimated \$1.5 million in on-track handle was lost because of the problem.

**CAPE TOWN INJURED** Cape Town (Seeking the Gold), who loomed boldly to move into second six furlongs into yesterday's G1 Preakness at Pimlico, but faded badly by the time the field hit the stretch and finished ninth, came out of the race with filling in his sesamoid. "It doesn't look career-threatening, but he's going to need some time off," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who was himself on the losing end of a head butt with his horse. Back at the barn after the race, Lukas knocked heads while handling the colt and came away bleeding profusely from a cut on the forehead that may have required stitches.

Cape Cross (Ire), entered as the stable's second-string runner in this event to KAHAL (GB) (Machiavellian), winner of the seven-furlong G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket last October in his prior outing, caused a major upset when winning this Group 1 contest in course-record time. Although running on his own merit, Cape Cross was put in the race to ensure a good pace for his stablemate, admitted Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford. The winner went to the front early and, as the field entered the final furlong, showed no sign of stopping, running on courageously to land the spoils from the fast-finishing Poteen. Centre Stalls (Ire) also finished strongly to grab third from Kahal, who appeared to run out of stamina. The win took Cape Cross's record to three wins from 11 lifetime starts with earnings of \$179,357. "That was a surprise," said Crisford. "He only arrived from Dubai five days ago. He likes to run from the front and was there to set a good pace for Kahal. (Jockey) Daragh (O'Donohoe)'s instructions were to make plenty of use of him." Crisford said Kahal would now drop back to seven furlongs.
