**PREAKNESS WRAP-UP** With the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness behind him, trainer Bob Baffert said yesterday of his Triple threat **Real Quiet** (Quiet American), "At a mile and a half, I'll take anybody on. The Triple Crown is a survival of the fittest. It takes a hell of a tough horse. When (Real Quiet) did it in the Derby, I knew he was tough. Yesterday was a much better race, I thought. He's getting bigger and bigger, stronger and stronger. If he stays like he is now, if I don't screw it up between now and then...he'll win the Belmont." Real Quiet will train at Churchill Downs before shipping to Belmont Park Wednesday, June 3. The participation of **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner) in the third leg of the Triple Crown June 6 is still very much up in the air. Scratched from the Preakness due to a bruised right rear foot, the colt continues to improve, but not as quickly as trainer Shug McGaughey would hope. "He's getting better, but he's not as far along as I'd like," said McGaughey. "We'll do a little more probing later (Sunday) when the blacksmith comes. We'll probably know more (Monday)." McGaughey hopes to have his colt ready to run in the May 25 GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont, but said that if Coronado's Quest couldn't return to the track by early this week, it would be very hard to make the race. Without a start in the Met as a prep, the trainer said he doesn't believe he can have Coronado's Quest ready to run the mile and a half of the Belmont S. Should he make it, however, he expects to have a good chance of derailing Real Quiet's Triple Crown bid. "We can stop (Real Quiet)," he said. "He'd have to catch us. I'm not going to be like Bob Baffert and go around predicting victory, but I think he's a good enough horse to win and I think he stacks up with the rest of them. I think he could be very competitive." Trainer David Cross will decide Tuesday whether to send Preakness third **Classic Cat** (Mountain Cat) to the Belmont S. "I'm very pleased," said Cross of his colt. "He's a contender. It would be nice to have a Triple Crown winner, but I'd like to beat him." **Cape Town** (Seeking the Gold) threw his right hind shoe three furlongs from home in Saturday's Preakness; the ninth-place finisher came out of the race missing some of the wall of that hoof, but the swelling which had been detected in his suspensory had subsided by Sunday morning. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, himself sporting a cut on the left side of his head from a Cape Town head butt, said the three-year-old would get a break, but that stablemate **Yarrow Brae** (Deputy Minister), winner of the GI Illinois Derby, will run next in the Belmont.

Extending her lifetime record to four-for-four, the Aga Khan's Zainta (Ire) looks set for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 7, where she may be joined by her stable companion Zalaiyka (Fr), winner of the Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) May 10. Unlike the G3 Prix Vanteaux here April 26, when she led wire-to-wire for an unconvincing win on a very soft track, Zainta settled in mid-division as stablemate MANNARSARA (IRE) (Royal Academy) set the pace. Loving Claim took over on the final turn, but Zainta came between horses in midstretch, quickening well in the final eighth to win going away. "Zainta was not at ease on the soft ground last time and had to lead all the way," said the Aga Khan. "She is better coming from off the pace like today. We now have her and Zalaiyka in the Prix de Diane and we might run both, although I would prefer not to." Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said: "Zainta is a tough staying filly. We will not rush into a decision over which of the fillies, or both, run in the Diane." Loving Claim's trainer Criquelette Head was happy with her G1 Prix Marcel Boussac winner, saying: "We've no excuses. She was beaten by a better filly on the day. Loving Claim is still not yet at her best, but she is getting there."

A winner on her debut at Santa Anita February 28, Brulay took a break before her second start, returning to notch an allowance win at Santa Anita April 16. The odds-on choice despite leaping into graded-stakes company in her third outing, the bay filly went head-and-head with Unreal Squeal, shook loose at the head of the lane and earned her easiest victory to date in a time just two ticks off the track record. The second leg of a Group race double on the day for the Aga Khan, trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre and jockey Gerald Mosse, with Tajoun (Fr), winner of the G3 Prix de Barbeville April 26, taking his lifetime record to eight-for-10, and three-for-three this season. The two English challengers BOOK AT BEDTIME (IRE) (Mtoto {GB}) and Windsor Castle (GB) cut out the pace, pursued by Tajoun. On the final turn the English pair tried to quicken away, but Tajoun could not be shaken off. Although he did not win as impressively as in the Barbeville, where he found the very soft track much to his liking, he got the job done here on a much faster surface, while Lucky Dream (Fr) finished well for second. "He was not as impressive as last time," said the Aga Khan. "He's a one-paced horse and they race much faster on a surface like this, on which he was not as much at ease. He's entered in the (G1) Ascot Gold Cup (June 18), but the track at Ascot might not suit him, so we'll wait until a later date to decide whether he will go there or not."

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

The even-money chalk following a third-place finish against Oaklawn allowance company in his latest April 10, the veteran was fourth in the five-horse field after a half, but closed to put a head in front as they straightened into the lane and outfinished outsider Beau Sierra for the victory. Trainer Noel Hickey said the winner could come right back to defend his title in the National Jockey Club S. May 23.

He stalked the pace to the far turn, drove up three-wide to take the lead in the stretch and outgamed Identity in a head-bobbing finish. "You really don't want to make the lead too early with him," said jockey Jerry Bailey, who picked up four winners on the day. "I knew I was coming back, but I didn't think we got the win. Then again, I'm old and my eyesight is failing."
