REAL QUIET RETURNS TO CHURCHILL Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Real Quiet** (Quiet American), who will train for his Triple Crown bid at Churchill Downs, returned to the Louisville oval yesterday morning after an uneventful flight from Baltimore. "He's amazing--he ran me out of the stall (Sunday morning)," said trainer Bob Baffert. "We're just basically going to enjoy him and keep him healthy, because I'm the only one who can screw this thing up. We've got the horse, we've got the rider. So, to me, if he gets beat it's my fault." Following the blueprint which got him to within three-quarters of a length of a Triple Crown triumph last year with Silver Charm, Baffert will set up camp at Churchill for the next two weeks, shipping to New York Wednesday, June 3. "He loves this track," he explained. "This is one of the best surfaces in the world and he likes to train over it." Baffert also believes he has an easier task getting this colt ready for his date with destiny. "Last year, Silver Charm had to really work. I was behind on him and he was tired coming out of these races. He won the Preakness on guts and class. This horse, he didn't have to run that hard. He went around there, smoked 'em, came back and he's fine. It's unbelievable that here's this poor horse that I took to New Mexico and got him beat and he's going for the Triple Crown. It just goes to show you that trainers, we don't know anything." Baffert fully expects to find himself in the winner's circle at Belmont Park come June 6. "If he stays healthy and I can get him to the race healthy, he will destroy that field," he boasted. "I don't care who they throw at him."

THOMAS JO JOINS TRIPLE CROWN FRAY

Texas-bred gelding **Thomas Jo** (Strong Performance), who earned his fourth straight victory in Saturday's \$100,000 Sir Barton S. at Pimlico, will make his next start in the GI Belmont S. June 6. Purchased by Earle Mack and Team Valor last season, the three-year-old is undefeated this year. Jockey Chris McCarron will pick up the mount for the third leg of the Triple Crown.

NUMBERS UP AT FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC

OPENER Showing a gain of 28 percent in aggregate sales and 3 percent in average, Fasig-Tipton's 1998 Midlantic Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale got underway at the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium, Maryland yesterday. A total of 157 juveniles sold for \$4,477,100, an average of \$28,517. There were 49 horses listed as not sold, 24 percent of the offering; that figure was down from the 31 percent that were listed as not sold during last year's first session. Monday's top-selling two-year-old was Hip #97, a filly by **Jolie's Halo** out of Italian Princess (Bold Bidder) named **Jolie's Princess**. Consigned by James Layden, agent, the half-sister to MSW Hustle Your Bustle (The Minstrel) was purchased for \$360,000 by Joseph Brocklebank, agent for Antsu Stable. The underbidders after a spirited duel were trainer Jeff Jacobs and agent J.B. McKathan. The filly will head to New York, where she will be trained by Todd Pletcher. The second-highest price of the day came in for Hip #153, a filly by **Saint Ballado**--Medieval Baird (Medieval Man). Consigned by H.T. Stables (Jenkins Bros.), agent, the bay was also purchased by Brocklebank for Antsu Stables, bringing a final bid of \$180,000. The final session of the two-day auction begins this morning at 10 a.m.
