**CAPE TOWN RETIRED** **Cape Town** (Seeking the Gold), who came out of his ninth-place finish in Saturday's Preakness S. with filling in the sesamoid of his left front leg, apparently suffered a fractured sesamoid during the race and has been retired. X-rays taken Monday revealed the fracture. The colt will not require surgery, but will be confined to his stall for 60 days. "It could have been repaired and we could have brought him back, but to bring him back as less than he went out wouldn't be fair to him," Overbook Farm syndicate manager Ric Waldman said. "It's in his best interest to retire him." Winner of this year's GI Florida Derby after the disqualification of Lil's Lad, Cape Town also captured the GIII Brown & Williamson Kentucky Jockey Club S. at two and the GIII Holy Bull S. at three; he retires with a record of five victories from 12 career starts and earnings of \$795,817. He will stand at Overbrook Farm in Lexington, Kentucky next year.

**LIMIT OUT TO BELMONT** **Limit Out** (Northern Flagship), winner of the GIII Bay Shore S., will skip Sunday's GII Peter Pan S. and point instead towards the June 6 GI Belmont S. The Allen Jerkens trainee suffered his first loss in five career starts when third in the May 2 GII Withers S. Jerkens will be represented in the Peter Pan by Withers victor **Dice Dancer** (Ogygian). **MCCARTHY PERFECT AT DELAWARE** Jockey Michael McCarthy equaled the Delaware Park record for most wins on a card when he won with all six of his mounts yesterday. It was the first time in track history that a jockey has gone six-for-six. Previously, the best percentage day was held by Eldon Nelson, who had six winners from seven mounts on June 20, 1958. McCarthy also won six races at Delaware on Nov. 2, 1997, making him the only rider in the track's history to accomplish the feat twice. Yesterday, he won the second, third, and fifth through eighth races. "As far as I am concerned, this was my Powerball hit," McCarthy said. "It is just an unbelievable feeling to win six in a day. I am just going to enjoy it as long as I can."

**Cape Cross (Ire)** (c, 4, **Green Desert--Park Appeal** {GB}, by **Ahonoora** {GB}), winner of the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. in England Saturday, is the owner of a very interesting pedigree. In the male line, Cape Cross goes back to Nearctic, and in tail-female line he goes back to Nearctic's three-parts-sister, The Veil, the pair appearing 4x5. The combination of Nearctic-line sires with this family has previously come up with group winner Dumaani (by Cape Cross's grandsire, Danzig, out of a half-sister to Cape Cross's dam), classic winner Shadayid, and other group and stakes winners Allurement, Peking Opera and Massyar. *Pedigree shorts cont. p. 7*

Suffolk Downs will host a "retirement party" on Massachusetts H. Day for **Playing Politics** (In Reality), the nation's oldest Thoroughbred currently in training. The 16-year-old is ending his racing career after 203 starts and 25 wins and will be cared for at the farm of his owner/trainer Richard Fruzzetti. **Playing Politics**, who captured a Jan. 4 claiming race at the Boston oval, is the only active member of the 1982 foal crop of 42,894 Thoroughbreds and began his career racing against the likes of Kentucky Derby winner **Spend a Buck** and champion sprinter **Smile**. The veteran runner developed a non-life threatening tumor on his neck that may be affecting his breathing, according to Fruzzetti. "It's the right thing to do, to give him a rest and let him enjoy the rest of his days in familiar surroundings," the trainer said.

Napoleon's Sister (Ire) caused a 20-1 shock when trouncing her rivals in what is the last recognised trial for the Epsom Oaks. Running in the colours of Mrs. Anne Coughlan, carried successfully to win the 1995 Breeders' Cup Mile by Ridgewood Pearl (Ire), the filly completely missed the break and was still last, 12 lengths off the pace, when the field hit the top of the stretch, but got it into gear a quarter-mile from home. Making only her second start and looking for her first victory, she came with her challenge on the outside and shot clear at the eighth-pole to win in impressive fashion. A delighted winning trainer David Elsworth enthused, "It wasn't a total surprise, although she's always been a backward filly. I ran her at Bath (in her debut) when she was backward, as I knew that a race would accelerate her progress. She is in the Oaks, but I don't know if she'll run as it's a tricky course. She might run in the Irish Oaks. She knows she is a good filly, she's a filly with a future." Bookmakers weren't overly impressed by the manner of victory, but cut her odds from 66-1 to 33-1 for the Epsom Oaks.

## WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

### PEDIGREE SHORTS

Sunday's G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp saw **Zainta (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}--Zaila {Ire})**, by **Darshaan {GB}** confirm herself as a very good filly by taking her record to four-for-four with a one-length win over Loving Claim. Typically for an Aga Khan-bred, Zainta owns some interesting pedigree patterns. To start with, her sire and her dam go back respectively to the close relatives Bara Bibi (fourth dam of Kahyasi) and Star of Iran (third dam of Zaila). This pair are both by Bois Roussel, and Bara Bibi's second dam, Majideh, is by Mahmoud, a three-parts brother to Mah Iran, the dam of Star of Iran. Bara Bibi's dam, Masaka, also has an important part to play. Since she is by Nearco (sire of Nasrullah and Royal Charger) out of a mare by Mahmoud (three-parts brother to Mumtaz Begum, dam of Nasrullah and granddam of Royal Charger), Masaka is obviously closely related to both Nasrullah and Royal Charger. Zainta has Nasrullah and Masaka in her sire, and Nasrullah and Royal Charger in her dam. The Aga Khan's grandfather acquired Mumtaz Mahal (ancestress of Mahmoud, Nasrullah, Royal Charger and Star of Iran) over 75 mares. One wonders how many stakes winners the Aga Khan's studs have now produced with various combinations of relatives descending from the "Flying Filly."
