FOURSTARDAVE VISITS BELMONT New York-bred gelding **Fourstardave** (Compliance), who came out of retirement after two years and nine months on the sidelines to finish in the middle of the pack in a charity race at the High Hopes steeplechase meet in Lexington May 17, is back in trainer Leo O'Brien's barn at Belmont Park. The 13-year-old millionaire made his 100th start the day after the Preakness, carrying 175 pounds to finish about seventh in the two-mile race. "He came out of the race without any problem," said O'Brien. "That was a one-time event for charity. He's still retired, but he will be here with me and when we go to Saratoga." A winner of 21 races and \$1,636,560, Fourstardave won at least one race at Saratoga every year from 1987 to 1994.

MIESQUE'S SON JOINS SHUTTLE ROSTER **Miesque's Son** (Mr. Prospector), a Group winner out of champion and two-time Breeders' Cup Mile winner Miesque, will stand the 1998 and 1999 Southern Hemisphere breeding seasons at Stone Lodge Farm in Australia. "We clearly believe Miesque's Son is a world-class stallion," said George Hofmeister, owner of Stone Lodge. "I'm most impressed with his first foals, which arrived this year, and he will bring impeccable genes to Australia for speed in the middle-distance range, as he was one of the top milers of Europe two years ago. We are extremely pleased to announce him as our first new stallion." A full brother to one of the top second-crop sires Kingmambo, Miesque's Son stands at Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky during the Northern Hemisphere season.

Although untried on turf, his last start was an impressive victory in the May 2 GII Mervyn LeRoy H. at Hollywood Park.

CALDER OPENS TODAY The Florida racing circuit returns to Calder this afternoon for a 122-day stand. The 48-race stakes schedule will be highlighted by the richest day in Florida racing, the 1998 Festival of the Sun, set for October 17. The six-stakes Festival program includes the In Reality and My Dear Girl divisions of the Florida Stallion S. for two-year-olds, worth \$400,000 each. The meet also features the \$200,000 GIII Azalea Breeders' Cup H. May 30, the richest sprint for three-year-old fillies in the country; the \$300,000 Miami Beach Sprint S. June 20; the \$200,000 Carry Back S. at six furlongs July 11; the \$200,000 Calder Turf Sprint August 1; and the \$200,000 Miami Breeders' Cup H. at a mile on the turf August 22. "Special non-racing promotions have their place, but in the end we must attract fans to the sport itself if we want to genuinely increase the popularity of racing," said Mike Cronin, Vice President of Marketing at Calder. "I don't want to simply boost attendance if those in attendance have little, if any, interest in the sport and the challenge of winning at the windows." The meet will also offer a split-screen view of all live races for the first time, and will unveil "The Park," an area on the west end of the track apron which features a beer garden, open air grill and picnic tables in a park-like atmosphere. Live racing will be held Thursdays through Mondays, with first post at 12:30 p.m. throughout the meet.

FAST TIMES BACK AT JERSEY SHORE The 1998 summer meet at New Jersey's Monmouth Park will open with a special Memorial Day weekend program. There will be live racing today, tomorrow and Monday, then three dark days before the track swings back into action Friday, May 29. Live racing will be offered Wednesdays through Sundays for the remainder of the season, with Mondays and Tuesdays dark. First post will be 1 p.m. daily. Highlighting the stakes schedule is the \$1 million GI Buick Haskell Invitational August 9, which traditionally draws the top three-year-olds in the country to Monmouth, and the \$250,000 GII Philip Iselin H. for older horses August 30. New this year is the track surface, put in under the supervision of superintendent Dave Harrington during the off season. The cushion now contains more clay, as opposed to the higher percentage of sand used in years past. "The clay will retain more moisture," said Bob Kulina, vice president of Thoroughbred racing at Monmouth and the Meadowlands. "The mix will help the track during the hot, dry summer. The other side of that is it won't dry out as quickly as it has after thunderstorms, but overall it will be a much safer track, much better for horses."

According to the Harness Tracks of America newsletter, Thoroughbred and harness horsemen in Michigan have filed suit to block the sale of Detroit Race Course. The Michigan Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association and the Michigan Harness Horsemen's Association have filed a suit which maintains that Ladbroke DRC, which has owned Detroit Race Course since January, 1996, is legally required to hold live Thoroughbred racing at the track until an alternative license is issued. DRC is scheduled to race until November 8, and close for good December 31.
