FAVORITE TRICK TO DWYER? Trainer Bill Mott said yesterday that 1997 Horse of the Year **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick), eighth in the GI Kentucky Derby, could make his next appearance in the GII Dwyer S. July 12. "We had been pointing for the Riva Ridge (June 6), but the Kentucky Derby just took too much out of him," said Mott. "He's been back galloping, and I just want to get him ready for the summer. He's had a couple of tough races this year. I would think if he comes along the way I hope, the Dwyer is a logical race for him."

SKIP AWAY GETS 130 FOR MASS'CAP Two-time Eclipse champion **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), a winner of five straight Grade I races, has been assigned top weight of 130 pounds, the highest impost of his career, for the GIII Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs May 30. The five-year-old carried 128 pounds to victory in the GI Pimlico Special May 9. "It's a big challenge," said trainer Sonny Hine. "But I'm just surprised by the spreads. I wouldn't mind carrying 130 pounds if there were some horses closer to us in the spread. What I want to know is why he wasn't Horse of the Year. They certainly think he's weight carrier of the year." Only two rivals are expected to oppose Skip Away. **Puerto Madero (Chi)** (Gallantsky), trained by Richard Mandella, was assigned 116. The four-year-old, a three-time Group 1 winner in his native country, took a Hollywood allowance race in his U.S. debut April 30. He worked seven-eighths in 1:25 4/5 at Hollywood yesterday morning. MGSW **Semorán** (Phone Trick), who came back after a 5 1/2-month layoff to win an allowance at Churchill by six lengths May 2, is in with 113. Skip Away, scheduled to have his final prep at Belmont Park this morning, will be in elite company if he can handle the weight. Cigar in 1996, Whirlaway in 1942 and Seabiscuit in 1937 all won the MassCap carrying 130.

HIALEAH WRAP-UP The 61-day Hialeah meet ended Friday with slight gains in on-track and inter-track wagering. Offering 24 percent more simulcasting signals, the track saw a 1-percent increase in on-track handle, and a 5-percent increase in inter-track handle. "After a rough opening week (plagued by heavy rains and tote problems), the meet rebounded very strongly," said Mike Mackey, vice president and general manager. Jockey Gary Boulanger took the riding title with 54 wins, while Bill White led all trainers with 28 victories. F.W. Ballou was leading owner with 15 winners.

A late change of plans brought about this surprise victory for **Desert Prince (Ire)**, who won for the third time from seven lifetime starts and gave trainer **David Loder** his first Irish Classic success. The winner of the Listed European Free H. at Newmarket April 15 and third to **Victory Note** in the G1 **Poule D'Essai des Poulains** (French 2000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 10, **Desert Prince** traveled smoothly off the pace early on. At the quarter-mile pole, he shot into the lead; he was soon challenged by Godolphin runner **Fa-Eq (Ire)**, having only his third lifetime start, but **Desert Prince** quickened brilliantly and soon left his challenger behind, going clear to win impressively. Odds-on favorite **Second Empire (Ire)**, well back early on, made some late progress, but never threatened the two principals, with rider **Christy Roche** being easy on him in the closing stages. **Roche** was questioned by the stewards, who accepted his explanation that the colt wouldn't have been any closer with more aggressive riding through the stretch. "I have to take my hat off to owner **Edward St George** for persuading me to change my plans and run **Desert Prince** here," said **David Loder**. "I had planned to save him for the (G1) **St. James' Palace S.** at Ascot (June 16). But he persuaded me to come here in the meantime." The Godolphin team were delighted with the inexperienced **Fa-Eq**, who broke his maiden at Newmarket May 3, and the top two will renew rivalry in the **St. James' Palace Victory Note (Fairy King)**, winner of the French 2000 Guineas, is also expected to be supplemented to that race. **Second Empire's** trainer **Aidan O'Brien** said he would reserve decision on the G1 June 6 **Vodafone Derby** at Epsom.

Who Did It And Run came into the Jersey Derby flashing some impressive form over the Garden State strip, having won her four starts at the track by a combined total of 28 3/4 lengths. Supplemented to the race for \$6,000, she prepped with a 12-length win in the May 9 Garden State S. against the boys at a mile on the turf, but, despite that impressive tally, the filly was sent off the fourth choice facing colts again here. Favored Cryptic Rascal was undefeated on the turf entering this race with two graded stakes wins to his credit, including the GIII Forerunner in his last April 17 at Keeneland. When the gates opened, Who Did It And Run broke on top and never looked back, becoming the first of her sex ever to win this race. "The filly is strong," said winning rider Felix Ortiz. "She beat the boys two times and I knew she could do it again." Cryptic Rascal chased the pace, but lacked a closing kick and was overtaken by the fast-closing Essential. The GI Mother Goose S. June 27 on the Belmont main track could be next for the winner.

A winner of her previous four starts, including the GIII Humana Distaff at Churchill on Derby Day in her last, Colonial Minstrel was sent off the second choice to another filly carrying a winning streak into this event, Dixie Flag. The latter rode in on a trio of graded wins, the GII First Flight H. and GII Top Flight H. at Aqueduct last fall, and Aqueduct's GIII Bed O'Roses Breeders' Cup H. in her '98 debut April 18. Dixie Flag was off awkwardly, but recovered quickly to open up a four-length lead before drifting off the rail through the stretch and giving it up to Colonial Minstrel, who drove through on her inside at the eighth pole for the win. The victor, who had won her four straight in sprints, earned her first win beyond seven furlongs here. "Today we wanted to try her at a longer distance and with this race she really answered a lot of questions," said winning trainer Mark Hennig. "We'll wait and see how she comes out of this race and then we'll look at going in the (GI, 1 1/16-mile) Hempstead H. (June 20 at Belmont) and maybe the (GI, seven-furlong) Ballerina (Aug. 23 at Saratoga.)"

Not content to be a two-time Grade II winner in 1998, Hawksley Hill (Ire) shipped north from his Southern California base looking for more. He started off the year with victories in the GII Arcadia H. and GII El Rincon H. at Santa Anita before finishing third in the GI Early Times last out. After trailing the field through the first half-mile here, he angled out to begin his rally on the turn, caught Fantastic Fellow in midstretch and had no trouble putting away that rival to improve his U.S. record to three wins in five starts. "Today he settled real nice," said jockey Gary Stevens. "He can go a mile and a half when he settles. I think today's win was his easiest."

Fourth in the GIII California Derby at Golden Gate April 18, she earned her first graded win here with an off-the-pace move on the turn. "She can get fractious, but today she was the perfect lady," said winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "She kicked hard today."

**National Jockey Club H. cont.**

Twice a graded-stakes winner at two, Polar Expedition took the Gil Jim Beam S, at three, but picked up his last victory at the level in the 1996 Gil Washington Park H. The veteran came off the 3 1/2-month layoff to capture a handicap at Sportsman's in his latest April 18 and made it two in a row with a return to the graded ranks. The leading Illinois-bred money winner of all time, he closed from fourth as the second choice and outfinished Bucks Nephew for the victory. There was a claim of foul from the rider of the runner-up, Juvenal Diaz, alleging interference in the stretch, but the stewards allowed the result to stand. Four-year-old gelding **Might And Power (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) raced into the history books yesterday when he became the highest single-season money-earner in Australian racing history with victory in the \$324,675 G1 Doomben Cup over a mile and a quarter in Brisbane. Nick Moraitis' Caulfield Cup and Melbourne Cup hero, trained by Jack Denham, has earned \$2,331,877 thus far this season, breaking the 1990-91 season record of Better Loosen Up (Aus). It was Might And Power's 11th victory from 25 lifetime starts and took his career earnings to more than \$2,467,532. Starting the 2-11 favorite, Might And Power had to work for his victory after the 200-1 outsider **Spirit Of Oregon (NZ)** (Oregon) took him on up front and led until halfway. But at the three-eighths pole Might And Power grabbed the lead and had enough left in reserve to win by a length and a quarter. Might And Power will now be rested until the Australian Spring, when he will be prepared for the G1 Cox Plate, run over a mile and a quarter at Moonee Valley in Melbourne.

Local News, England:

Trainer Aidan O'Brien confirmed yesterday that his G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas winner **King of Kings (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) will definitely go for the G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom June 6. "We've talked things through," said O'Brien, "and it looks like he will run in the Derby. He is very well and has done well since Newmarket. He is our number one, but we may run a couple in the race."
