SKIP AWAY WORKS TOWARD MASSCAP Two-time champion **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) posted his final work before Saturday's GIII Massachusetts H. yesterday at Belmont Park. The grey five-year-old went five furlongs in :58 1/5 before vaning to Suffolk Downs. "He went nice and galloped out in 1:11, something like that," trainer Sonny Hine said from his Belmont base. The move was the second fastest of 15 at the distance. "He did it like he's supposed to and he'll probably go up to New England and do what he's supposed to." Skip Away will be the 130 pound highweight in the race. Another New York-based MassCap hopeful, **K.J.'s Appeal** (Valid Appeal) worked at Belmont yesterday. The four-year-old, winner of Gulfstream's GIII Creme Fraiche H. before finishing second in the April 26 GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup last time out, went a bullet half-mile in :46.

ORVILLE N WILBUR'S MAY BE BELMONT

BOUND Orville N Wilbur's (Out of Place), winner of the GII San Rafael S., may make his next start in the June 6 1 1/2-miles GI Belmont S. Since his San Rafael victory, the colt has run fifth in the GI Santa Anita Derby and most recently ran second but was placed third via disqualification in the May 9 GII Illinois Derby. "He certainly has the breeding to run a long ways," explained trainer Wally Dollase. "The only thing he has to learn to do is settle down. He's so athletic, it's sickening." Orville N Wilbur's worked a half mile at Hollywood Thursday in :48 1/5.

OPENING-DAY RECORD AT MONMOUTH New Jersey's Monmouth Park opened its summer season Saturday and the \$5,534,585 wagered at the track and its simulcasting outlets established a new opening-day handle record. "It was perfect weather and a perfect opening," said Bruce Garland, senior vice president of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "We're quite happy with the opening, everybody had a great time and we're hoping the three-day holiday weekend gets us off to a good start for the rest of the meet." Eddie Broome, leading trainer at the 1997 Meadowlands meet and Tommy Turner, the track's leading jockey last year, will be honored at Monmouth Monday. The Meadowlands season was shortened due to inclement weather.

Seventeen-year-old Tipperary-born apprentice jockey Jamie Spencer stole the show here, riding the 37th winner of his career on the G1 Moyglare Stud S. winner **Tarascon (Ire)**. The filly put behind her all the misfortunes of her trip to Newmarket May 3 for the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas, when she was injured de-planing after her flight from Ireland and then tried to destroy her starting stall before the race and trailing in last behind **Cape Verdi (Ire)**. After again playing up at the start, **Tarascon** finally consented to be loaded, but was well back in the field early before young Spencer conjured a great finish out of his mount. She found an extra gear and cut down **Kitza (Ire)** inside the final yards for a narrow victory, her third from six lifetime starts. "It's a dream come true," said Spencer. "Mr. Stack told me only on Friday that I would ride the filly here and I had been thinking about it ever since." Stack, who became famous as a jump jockey when riding **Red Rum** to win his third Grand National steeplechase and who trained **Robert Sangster's Las Meninas (Ire)** to win the English 1000 Guineas in 1994, was full of praise for the young apprentice. "I told him to treat it as just an ordinary race and not to panic or feel under any pressure if the filly ran badly. He's been riding work for me for the past month and he's got a very bright future. I was very pleased with the way the filly ran for him and he did the job very well." Asked about the Vodafone Oaks at Epsom June 5, Stack said, "She's in the race and also the French and Irish Oaks, but I wouldn't want to fly her after her experience."

Peter Pan S.-GII results cont.

Running his Belmont record to a perfect four-for-four and scoring again on the only surface over which he has ever won, Grand Slam added the Peter Pan to his victories in the GI Futurity and GI Champagne and an 11-length maiden win in his debut July 18. Injured in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Hollywood, he was sixth in the San Pedro S. March 25 at Santa Anita in his return and third last out in the GII Lexington April 18 at Keeneland. Taken to the outside off a quick early pace, he brought rider Jerry Bailey to the front on the turn under his own steam and drew clear through the lane for the win. Asked whether June 6 GI Belmont S. could be next, trainer D. Wayne Lukas said, "I'll look at the Belmont for about six or eight days. Another option is the (GII, July 19) Swaps (at Hollywood) but he does have an affinity for this racetrack. This is a giant step forward for us. Big time." Bailey was equally impressed. "This really was a great race for him considering what he has overcome in the past," he said. The runner-up, Rubiyat, second in the GII Withers May 2 at Aqueduct in his last, lugged in through the stretch. "We're definitely not going in the Belmont," said trainer Scotty Schulhofer. Favored DICE DANCER (Ogygian) took a short lead on the turn and weakened in the stretch and has been removed from consideration for the third leg of the Triple Crown. HANUMAN HIGHWAY (IRE) was scratched this morning after trainer Kathy Walsh detected heat in the inside quarter of his right front foot.
