EDDIE MAPLE ACCEPTS VENEZIA AWARD – THEN CALLS IT A CAREER

Jockey Eddie Maple announced his retirement Monday morning at Belmont Park, where he was accepting the 1998 Mike Venezia Award. The 49-year-old rider, who has notched 4,397 career victories and earnings of \$105,318,593, was voted the 10th recipient of the Venezia Award, which honors riders "who exemplify extraordinary sportsmanship and citizenship." About his retirement, Maple said, "I hinted around to my family for a while, but I guess they thought I was kidding. But to tell you the truth, I really didn't make up my mind until this morning when I was heading out to the tent for the ceremony. I surprised everybody, even myself. I haven't had a chance to tell my father or my brother yet." Maple was the eighth jockey in history to earn \$85 million in purses, and was the 22nd to ride 4,000 winners, a milestone he reached in March, 1992. He counts among his major accomplishments two Belmont Stakes wins, with Temperance Hill (1980) and Creme Fraiche (1985). A native of Carrollton, Ohio, Maple began his riding career at Charles Town in 1965 and rode his first winner, Swami, April 13, 1966 when he was 17 years old. After stints in Ohio, Maryland, New Jersey and Florida, Maple joined the New York jockey colony in 1971. He was aboard for three upsets of Forego: with Arbees Boy in the 1974 Met Mile; with Foolish Pleasure in the 1976 Suburban and with Quiet Little Table in the 1977 Suburban. Maple rode 1982 Horse of the Year Conquistador Cielo to three of his four stakes wins, but had to watch his mount win the Belmont S. from his hospital bed after he broke his rib in a spill the day before the race.

SILVER CHARM SIZZLES Silver Charm (Silver Buck) took to the fast Churchill Downs track yesterday for his final "super serious" work before the \$750,000-added GII Stephen Foster H. June 13. Exercise rider Dana Barnes was aboard as the 1997 Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner chased Rushaway S. winner and stablemate Shot of Gold (Jolie's Halo) through much of the drill before passing his workmate and completing the seven furlong distance in 1:23 flat. The work was five seconds faster than the second-best move at the distance. "He was awesome," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He's coming around. It was a nice, cool morning and (Track Superintendent) Butch Lehr had the track perfect."

After an inconsistent three-year old season that showed flashes of brilliance (victories in the Illinois and Remington Park Derbies) and monumental drubbings (such as a 26-length defeat in the Belmont S.), Wild Rush's connections were trying to place the colt where he could reach his full potential. "In hindsight, a mile and a half (in the Belmont S.) was probably too much for him," recounted assistant trainer Gary Mandella. "He's a horse that has a lot of natural speed and we now have him where he can utilize that very well." With a two-length win in the Met, his second consecutive one-turn, Grade I victory, the talented four-year old seems to have found his spot. Breaking from the rail, Wild Rush took well to the muddy going, settling just off of ELUSIVE QUALITY's (Gone West) quick pace. He seized command three-eighths out and drew off while drifting out in the stretch. Wild Rush began his 1998 campaign April 4, finishing fourth in the lightning fast GII Potrero Grande Breeder's Cup H at Santa Anita. He then shipped to Belmont to score by a neck in the seven-furlong GI Carter H. May 2. Mandella's long-term plans now include the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Post-time favorite DISTORTED HUMOR (Forty Niner) did not like the wet track and faded after a mild middle move.

Runner-up in the GII San Luis Rey S. at Santa Anita March 22 and the GIII Hialeah Turf Cup H. April 18, Storm Trooper opened the year with victories in a Santa Anita allowance and the restricted San Marino H. and added his third score of the season here. Graduating to the Grade I ranks, the bay enjoyed a ground-saving trip behind a pedestrian pace, came between horses on the final bend and swept to the lead in the stretch to win going away. "I was really high on this horse after I rode him the first couple of times," said jockey Kent Desormeaux, who had not been aboard Storm Trooper since his first start of the season, but turned down the mount aboard Met Mile winner Wild Rush to ride him again. "This horse, his future is unlimited." The even-money favorite River Bay was last early despite the very slow fractions and made up a lot of ground in the stretch, but could not challenge the winner. "We got killed by the slow pace, that was the whole story of the race," said his rider, Alex Solis. "Unfortunately, that's his style and there wasn't anything we could have done differently. He ran a very courageous race to finish second." The fractions of :26 2/5, :51 2/5 and 1:16 were the slowest in Hollywood Turf H. history.

A great triumph for young rider Carl Lowther; just out of his apprenticeship and riding in a Group race for the first time, he lands the 100th winner of his career. He was the first to admit that, at halfway, he thought Bolshoi (Ire) had too much ground to make up as the 4-5 favorite Einadim and Lochangel (GB) had set a fast pace. At the eighth pole Lochangel took command, but then Lowther conjured a strong finish from Bolshoi, who flew home on the outside to land a comfortable victory at the wire, his eighth win from 40 lifetime starts. "He was taken off his feet early on," said Lowther, who has spent all his career apprenticed to winning trainer Jack Berry. "I was worried that we had too much ground to make up on the leaders, but this old horse loves a strong pace and a stiff uphill finish and he ran on really well." Bolshoi is expected to head for the G2 King's Stand S. over five furlongs at Ascot, another track with a stiff uphill finish and where he has won previously.

PARADE GROUND JOINS BELMONT STAKES FIELD

Parade Ground (Kingmambo) showed trainer Neil Howard enough with his third-place finish in Sunday's GII Peter Pan S. to merit a shot in the June 6 Belmont S. The three-year-old was beaten only three lengths by winner Grand Slam in the Peter Pan after encountering a traffic jam in the stretch. "The effort was there," Howard said. "He had a little trouble in behind horses, but he kept running and that was what we wanted to see." Howard added, "To tell you the truth, he coughed twice back at the barn, so we scoped him and we found a drop of blood. We're going to treat him with Lasix from now on. I have no doubt that will clear it right up, because like I said, it was just a small trace, but you want to take precautions early." Parade Ground, winner of the \$150,000 Tampa Bay Derby March 22, finished sixth in the May 2 Kentucky Derby.

Local News, Calder:

Calder's opening weekend May 23-25 was a success in every department. Opening-day attendance Saturday numbered 10,948, up 8.5 percent from last year's 10,099. Sunday's attendance of 7,009 was up 11.5 percent from last year's corresponding day and Monday's tally of 10,331 fans represented a five-percent increase. Saturday's opening day total on-track handle, which includes simulcasting handle, was \$1,693,173, up 9.4 percent from 1997. Sunday's handle of \$1,109,818 was up 3.4 percent from last year. Monday's handle has not yet been announced, due to night-time simulcasting.

Local News, Monmouth Park:

Monmouth Park established attendance and handle records for its opening weekend May 23-25, as a total of 50,267 fans wagered \$14.7 million over the three-day Memorial Day holiday. Palio Sky took command with a quarter mile to go, only to be challenged by Persian Punch, who went clear of his rivals then had to battle on bravely up the stiff Sandown hill to just hold the strong finish of Samraan. Winning owner/breeder Jeff Smith confirmed that the Ascot Gold Cup will be next for Persian Punch. "I hope he has more luck than last year, when he banged his head in the stalls and finished well down the field," he said. "He's a real battler, never gives in. (Trainer) David Elsworth always said he would reach his peak as a five-year-old and he's been proven right."
