POSITIVE PROGNOSIS FOR HEDONIST GI

Santa Anita Oaks winner **Hedonist** (Alydeed), reported to be in serious condition and not expected to race again after being diagnosed with laminitis Wednesday, was given a more encouraging prognosis yesterday. Dr. Rick Redden of Hagyard-Davidson-McGee Equine Clinic in Lexington determined that much of the damage he discovered was from a bout of laminitis the filly suffered as a two-year-old. He now believes she will recover and that a return to the races is possible. "When I flew out here (from California), it didn't look good," said trainer Randy Bradshaw. "For some unknown reason (the laminitis) started over again. We put some dye in her left foot, which seemed to be the worst, and we saw that most of the damage is old and has been there quite a while. (Redden) said, 'I feel great about this and the prognosis is going to be super.' He even came to the point that he said, 'I think this filly will be able to race again.' He's the guru of feet." As for her future, Bradshaw said, "We'll let her go for three or four months and then take a look and see whether to bring her back. I would love to have her back, but you have to think in her best interests and what's going to be best for her down the road. You have to look at whether you want to take that chance to put her back in training when she's such a valuable broodmare." The Canadian-bred three-year-old, owned by Jan and Mace and Samantha Siegel, was unraced at two, but won three of her four starts this year and earned \$200,400; she was a disappointing sixth in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland in her latest start April 4.

The only Grade I winner in the field, **I Ain't Bluffing** (Pine Bluff) looks to make it two in a row against a competitive field. In her last start, the May 3 GII Hawthorne H. over this same distance and track, she tracked a slow pace and rolled home to post a 1 1/2 length victory. She will have to chase **Belle's Flag** (Avenue of Flags), who was ambitiously placed in the May 1 GII Louisville Breeder's Cup H. at Churchill. Although out of action for 15 months, she disputed the pace and finished fourth, seven lengths behind GISW Escena.

"We look forward to coming to Boston. We really enjoyed it last year," said trainer Sonny Hine. If he enjoyed it last year when his horse **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) won by a desperate head over GISW Formal Gold, this year's trip should seem like a vacation. Skip Away enters this race off five consecutive Grade I victories. In his last start, the May 9 Pimlico Special, he sprinted to an uncontested lead and won by three lengths. **Puerto Madero** (Chi) (Gallantsky) is his most formidable challenger, having won three Chilean Grade I races last year. In his only U.S. start, he made up five lengths to win an April 30 Hollywood allowance at seven furlongs. Jockey Kent Desormeaux declared, "If he is within six lengths of the lead coming for home, put a W next to his name, raise the banner, because the race is his."

Trainer Tom Skiffington said of the talented gray, "Since she was a three-year-old, she's done nothing but compete in stakes, and she came right back this year to win two graded stakes right off the bench. I'm very comfortable with where we are with her now and she's probably a bigger and stronger mare than she was last year."

Trainer Elliott Walden, released from Monmouth Medical Center after seven screws and a steel plate were used to repair his fractured right ankle, was back at Belmont yesterday afternoon to see to his Belmont runner **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance), who is himself recovering from a skin condition. "I feel a lot better about him," said Walden. "He had a case of ringworm. It's usually more common in younger horses, but it can come up at any time. I would have been more concerned if there were only two weeks between the Preakness and the Belmont, but we were right on top of this. Before, you could run your hand on his coat and feel heat. (Friday) afternoon, everything was nice and cool, and we still have a week to go. He has quarter and dime-sized blotches on him that look like bald spots, so it's not the same beautiful coat. But everything else is perfect." The colt is scheduled to breeze Monday.

Limit Out (Northern Flagship), third in the GII Withers May 2, worked a mile in 1:39 4/5 over the Belmont Park training track yesterday morning. Now four-for-five, the Allen Jerkens trainee went the first half in company in :48, and finished the work on his own under jockey Jean-Luc Samyn.

Local News: Illinois

According to the *Chicago Tribune*, Illinois Governor Jim Edgar is returning nearly \$7 million to the state's purse accounts. The reimbursement comes from 1998 funds allotted to Illinois tracks as a result of the "recapture" clause of a bill which went into effect after full-card simulcasting became legal in 1995. The law divided simulcasting revenues 50-50 between tracks and horsemen, but included the clause which stated that in the event that total wagering on Illinois races in-state amounted to less than 75 percent of the base set in 1994, tracks would be entitled to "recapture" 2 percent of the difference. The clause went into effect immediately because the state's bettors heavily favored wagering on out-of-state signals; it caused purses in Illinois to drop dramatically.
