### SKIP AWAY SCORCHES IN MASS'CAP

Weighed down by a career-high impost of 130 pounds, **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) set all the pace in yesterday's \$614,000 GIII Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs and blazed down the stretch to stop the timer in 1:47 1/5 for the 1 1/8 miles, a new track record. The two-time Eclipse winner eclipsed the old mark set by Bounding Basque in 1985 by three ticks. Winning his sixth straight, he left **Puerto Madero (Chi)** (Gallantsky), carrying 116, 4 1/4 lengths in his wake as the 3-10 favorite. "I thought I could get an easy lead, and it was as easy as it looked," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "Usually he has a target to run at and someone to challenge him on the backstretch. I was a little concerned that Skip would ease up a little...that's why we waited longer to make our move. We waited until the 5/16ths pole...at that point, he really accelerated." Added trainer Sonny Hine, "He's just so superior, he makes the other horses look inferior." The five-year-old will make his next start in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 28, but while Gentlemen (Arg) will be waiting in California, Silver Charm will instead stay in Kentucky for the GII Stephen Foster H. June 13. "It would be great for racing if Silver Charm ran against Skip Away," said Bailey. "I know Sonny's all for it. But I don't see anyone beating (Skip Away)."

**GLANMIRE RETIRED** Eight-year-old **Glanmire** (Briartic), champion sprinter in Canada last year, has been retired, according to trainer Mike Keogh. The gelding had been plagued by foot problems and Keogh felt he had not recovered sufficiently to compete at the level he had in the past. "He just isn't the same old Glanmire," he said. "He has been retired to (co-owner and breeder Gus Schickedanz's) farm, where he can romp around in his own paddock. He'll probably ship down to the farm in South Carolina with us every winter." The Sovereign Award winner retires after taking 13 of his 49 starts and earning \$567,636 (Canadian). He captured five stakes at Woodbine during his career. His last start was a third-place finish in the Jacques Cartier S. at Woodbine April 5.

First in five of her last six appearances, I Ain't Bluffing was third in the GII La Canada S. February 8, took two months off, and came back to win the GII Hawthorne H. May 3. Heavily favored to take another, the bay was bothered slightly by the riderless BELLE'S FLAG (Avenue of Flags), who stumbled at the start and unseated jockey Corey Nakatani, then rushed up to lead the field around the first turn, floating the crowd's choice wide. Shaking loose from the loose horse, I Ain't Bluffing set the pace under some pressure, but had enough left to turn back the challenge of Fleet Lady in the drive. "My only concern was that the loose filly might get in our way, but she didn't," said winning rider Chris McCarron. "This horse, she's dead game. She had to work pretty hard to get there, and that's exactly what she did. She's very professional." Added trainer Ron Ellis, "I was a little bit worried because when they went into that first turn, it got a little shaky. But once she cleared (Belle's Flag), everything went well. She's a real tough filly. The Breeders' Cup, obviously, is a realistic goal. Now we have to think about what's best for her between now and the Breeders' Cup." Ellis cited the GI Vanity Invitational H. at Hollywood June 27 and the GI Hempstead H. June 20 at Belmont Park as possible targets for the winner.

Maxzene, winner of last year's Sheepshead Bay by a half-length, doubled that margin in this year's event as the overwhelming 1-5 favorite. Ridden for the third straight time by Jose Santos, who piloted the gray mare to victories in the GIII Jenny Wiley at Keeneland April 9 and most recently the GIII Bewitch S. at Keeneland April 23, she was reserved for seven furlongs while saving ground, moved up on the second turn, surged to the front in upper stretch and drew clear to remain undefeated in three graded stakes starts this year; her earnings now top \$1 million. "We just had a beautiful trip," said Santos. "When we reached the top of the stretch she switched leads and opened up on them. The last sixteenth, I just wanted to keep her busy." Trainer Tom Skiffington said the GI Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood Park July 4 or the GI New York H. at Belmont July 18 could be next for the winner. He may also ship across the Atlantic with her. "I'd like to take her to England for the Yorkshire Oaks (Group 1, August 19), because she's a special mare," he said.

Looking to add a second straight MassCap to a resume replete with stakes victories, Skip Away was sent off a deserving odds-on favorite and more than lived up to his billing. Coming off wins in the GI Donn H., GI Gulfstream Park H. and GI Pimlico Special this year, the gray carried 130 pounds as if it was a feather; he had the lead soon after the start and never relinquished it, dashing away from second choice Puerto Madero (Chi) down the lane to win impressively in track-record time. "I asked (jockey Kent Desormeaux) if Puerto Madero made his usual run, and he said yes," said winning rider Jerry Bailey. "Skip Away seemed like he did when he was carrying 126 to 128 pounds. I hit him just once." As for the future, trainer Sonny Hine said, "Carolyn (his wife and the colt's owner) would run him until he turned white, and that's out of enjoyment of watching him. But at the same time, I don't want to force him to carry 135 pounds." The five-year-old is not likely to run in any more handicaps this year; he goes next in the \$1 million Hollywood Gold Cup June 28.

**Deputy Commander** (Deputy Minister), winner of the GI Travers and GI Super Derby last year and runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, finished a disappointing seventh as the 4-5 chalk in the GIII New Orleans H. at the Fair Grounds March 8, but has been working sharply for his first start since. "He's a different horse than he was a month ago," said trainer Wally Dollase. "His attitude has changed for the better. His works have been easy and fast. Nobody has asked him to do a thing; he has done it all on his own." The four-year-old has been first or second in all three starts at this track, including a win in the GIII Affirmed H. last June. **Mud Route** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) has yet to win a stakes race, but is two-for-three at Hollywood and comes into this race off a 10-length allowance win May 3. He blew out with a half-mile in a bullet :47 1/5 Friday.

Cassidy won her stakes debut, the \$27,000 Jasmine S. at Hialeah April 26, by seven lengths, then followed with a fifth-place effort in the \$40,000 Hibiscus S. at Hialeah May 9. Dismissed at 7-1 odds here in her first try against graded company, the Florida-bred filly outran her odds, leading from gate-to-wire to win under a hand ride. "She stumbled pretty bad coming out of the gate in her last start at Hialeah and hit herself," said Cassidy's trainer Manny Estevez. "She just wasn't lucky that day. I've known she was a good filly from the beginning, when I picked her out for Mr. Mirabelli at the two-year-old sales last year. She bucked shins, so she didn't get to the races until November. Mr. Mirabelli turned down some serious offers for her right after she broke her maiden (at Gulfstream March 15). She got away good today and took them all the way. I think she has quite a future, even stretching out. We'll give her a little extra time now after running three races close together." Morning-line second choice RED CAT (Storm Cat) was scratched after coming down with a fever.
