**LIL'S LAD BACK ON TRACK** Lil's Lad (Pine Bluff), one of the early favorites for the Kentucky Derby before being sidelined by a chip in his left front ankle, is ready to resume training. The colt, second in the GII Toyota Blue Grass S. April 11, underwent arthroscopic surgery in May. He will go back to the track for the first time since the operation Wednesday at Churchill Downs. "He's right on schedule," said trainer Neil Howard. "We gave him a little extra time, but he has done well. This horse really has a brain in his head and he took everything in stride. He'll come back quick." Howard is hoping to have the three-year-old ready for a fall campaign. "We are thinking it would be fairly realistic to get him to a race possibly at the end of Saratoga, with the hopes of prepping him for some of the one-turn races this fall," he said.

**MEADOWLANDS CUP TO RETURN** The Meadowlands Cup, which was scrapped from the stakes schedule last year so that its purse money could be used to boost the GII Buick Pegasus H. pot to \$1 million, is coming back. New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority Vice President and General Manager of Thoroughbred Racing Robert Kulina said yesterday, "We will have both races (the Meadowlands Cup and the Pegasus) this year, but we haven't figured out yet what we're going to do with them or where we'll put each one (on the schedule). We'll see how everything shapes up and what makes sense for us." Past winners of the Meadowlands Cup include Spectacular Bid, Alysheba and Creme Fraiche; Dramatic Gold beat Formal Gold by three-quarters of a length in the 1996 running. This year, the Pegasus and Meadowlands Cup will be worth \$1 million between them, but just how that purse money will be divided has yet to be decided. While it's too late to make the change this year, Kulina also mentioned the possibility that Monmouth would close a day early beginning in 1999, allowing the Meadowlands to open its Thoroughbred season on Labor Day with the Meadowlands Cup as the featured race. "It would open the meet with some pizzazz," he remarked.

Trainer Pascal Bary and jockey Cash Asmussen each landed his third French Derby victory here. Making his fourth lifetime start after breaking his maiden in the G3 Prix La Force at Longchamp May 14, Dream Well (Fr) was well back in the field as MAKARUKA (Tremolino) and PROLIX (GB) (Kris {GB}) set a hot pace. At the top of the stretch, the pacesetters faded and Sestino (Ire) took to the front as Dream Well's stablemate, G1 Prix Lupin winner Croco Rouge (Ire) launched his challenge. However, Cash Asmussen had timed his move on the blinkered Dream Well to perfection, closing on Croco Rouge and edging ahead at the wire. Bary, successful in this event with Celtic Arms (Fr) in 1994 and Ragmar (Fr) in 1996, said, "Dream Well showed more staying power in the end than Croco Rouge. A furlong out I thought Croco Rouge would win, but, to be honest, at the top of the straight I didn't think either of them would finish in the money; they were so far behind the leaders. Croco Rouge then showed his usual turn of foot, but Dream Well showed how well he stays. Croco Rouge is still engaged in the (June 6) Epsom Derby and we don't have to declare to run until (today). I'm very proud of my horses." Asmussen added, "Pascal and I were associated with the Niarchos family and their late trainer Francois Boutin for a long time, so this win brings back good memories." Dream Well is owned in partnership by the Niarchos family and Jean-Louis Bouchard, who also owned both Celtic Arms and Ragmar. Bouchard purchased part of Dream Well after the Niarchos family bought back the colt from the 1996 Deauville yearling sales when he failed to reach his reserve of \$100,477.

Central Park (Ire), winner of the G3 Lanson Champagne Vintage S. at two, disappointed in the G1 Thoroughbred Corporation Dewhurst S. in October when only seventh to Xaar (GB), then again when ninth behind King of Kings (Ire) in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 2. Making his first start at further than a mile here, he was sent to the lead by young Daragh O'Donohoe and was joined up front by stablemate Mutawwaj (Ire). The two Godolphin runners set a leisurely pace, then quickened early in the stretch. Central Park ran on stoutly, giving his young rider his second Group 1 success this month, following Cape Cross (Ire) in the Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 16.

Almutawakel (GB), seventh in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas May 2 in his seasonal debut, was brilliantly ridden by Frankie Dettori, who stole the race with easy fractions on the front end. On the final turn, Dettori set sail for home and although challenged on all sides, his mount battled on bravely for the win, his third from six starts. It was the jockey's third Prix Jean Prat win in four years. "Frankie has learned to ride Chantilly to perfection," said Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford. "This horse was outpaced in the 2000 Guineas and the extra furlong today certainly helped him."

Runner-up to Silver Charm in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. and the GII Strub S. earlier this year, Mud Route was fourth as the favorite in the GI Oaklawn H. April 4, but bounced back to score by 10 lengths against Hollywood allowance foes May 3. Looking to pick up his first stakes win, the chestnut shadowed pacesetter Worldly Ways (GB) through six furlongs, drove to the lead as they straightened into the stretch and drew away as the odds-on choice. Said winning jockey Chris McCarron, who also captured Saturday's GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. with I Ain't Bluffing, "I figured if he had a chance to beat Deputy Commander, today would be the day. He trained so forwardly for the race, and he had a good race over the track. Everything was in our favor." Trainer Ron McAnally said he will consider the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 28 for the colt. Deputy Commander stumbled slightly at the start, then raced just off the lead before launching his bid at the top of the lane. Unable to gain on the winner in the final furlong, he was easily second best. As for the Gold Cup, trainer Wally Dollase said, "Oh yeah, he'll run, and it doesn't matter who is in there. He deserves to be."

**WOODBINE CANCELS SUNDAY'S CARD** High winds and the threat of even higher gusts forced the cancellation of Sunday's live Thoroughbred racing card at Woodbine in Toronto, Canada. "The jockeys felt the extremely high winds would make it too dangerous to ride," said The Ontario Jockey Club's Vice President of Thoroughbred Racing John Whitson. "Contrary to weather forecasts, the gusts accelerated significantly between 11:30 and 12 noon." Woodbine continued to offer full-card simulcast wagering from Fort Erie, Belmont and Hollywood Park yesterday. The \$109,600 Plate Trial S., Sunday's feature race, will be postponed to Wednesday night and will be run as the fourth race with no re-draw of post positions. First race post-time Wednesday is set for 6:35 p.m. EDT.

Elusive Quality posted two straight allowance scores before finishing a disappointing eighth in the nine-horse GI Metropolitan H. field May 25. Back on only six days rest and making his turf debut here, the crowd's 3-1 second choice forced the early pace from outside, moved up to challenge on the turn, battled heads apart with Bristling through the stretch and prevailed in a hard drive. "We had reservations about running him back so quick, but I'm glad we brought him up here (from Churchill)," said trainer Bill Mott. "The Met Mile didn't work out for us, but he seemed to be okay coming out of the race. We'll keep him on the grass and see if he'll go a mile. The Poker (GIII, July 4) is a logical spot." The 7-5 favored entry of ZA-IM (GB) (Green Desert) and INDIAN ROCKET (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), both making only their second starts in the U.S., finished 10th and 11th respectively.
