Irish trainer Aidan O'Brien landed his second English Classic of the season with this unexpected victory and is now Britain's leading trainer by money won. Shahtoush (Ire), second in the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas at Newmarket before a disappointing 10th in the G1 Airlie Coolmore Irish 1000 Guineas May 24, displayed a devastating finish to overtake the previously unbeaten Bahr (GB). Jockey Michael Kinane settled Shahtoush well in the rear as TROPHY WIFE (FR) (Double Bed {Fr}) set the pace for stablemate Midnight Line. At the half-mile mark, CLOUD CASTLE (GB) (In the Wings {GB}) grabbed the lead, pressed by Midnight Line, who quickened to take over at the quarter-mile pole, with Bahr and Shahtoush now in hot pursuit. Bahr took command at the three-sixteenths pole, but Shahtoush quickened brilliantly and swept past her rival. Bahr briefly fought back, but the Irish filly ran out a deserving winner and the pair pulled six lengths clear of Midnight Line in third. Kinane said of Shahtoush, "The plan was to drop her out and get her settled and relaxed. The others set a good pace, which I was glad to see. My filly was always travelling sweetly and I followed Frankie (Dettori, on Bahr) through and I think I took him by surprise, coming up behind him and grabbing the lead." O'Brien added, "There wasn't enough pace in the Irish 1000 Guineas; they only quickened in the last half-mile and she needs a good level pace to be at her best. But she had thrived since that race and so we let her take her chance today." A surprised and disappointed Frankie Dettori said, "I thought I'd won, I thought Bahr had enough left, but he (Kinane) came and did me."

The supplemental fee of \$125,208 being paid to run **Cape Verdi (Ire)** indicates the confidence Godolphin has in their filly, the winner of the May 3 G1 Sagitta 1,000 Guineas by five lengths over subsequent G1 Epsom Oaks winner Shahtoush (Ire). But the bookmakers, who had installed her as the 2-1 favorite, now rate her as the third choice. Aidan O'Brien's two strongest entries, **Second Empire (Ire)** and **King of Kings (Ire)** figure to present the most formidable challenges. The former was the winner of last year's G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp, and enters this race off a third in the Irish 2,000 Guineas at The Curragh May 23. The latter has won five of six career starts, the most recent a 1 1/4-length victory in the May 2 Sagitta 2,000 Guineas. **Greek Dance (Ire)**, two-for-two in 1998 against weaker competition, has also been attracting support.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

Totally compromised by a dawdling pace in his 1998 debut, a second in the April 22 GIII Elkhorn S. at Keeneland, last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Turf winner **Chief Bearhart** (Chief's Crown) looms the horse to beat in what appears to be a speed-laden race. Earlier this year, **Buck's Boy** (Bucksplasher), fourth in the Breeders' Cup Turf, ran away with the March 7 GII Pan American H. at Gulfstream Park. He enters this race off of a 1 1/4-length score in the Riggs H. at Pimlico May 23. **Casey Tibbs (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), second in the G1 Secretariat S. last year at Arlington, got back on track with a three-length allowance score at Belmont May 16.

A front-running victory in the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H. May 16 at Pimlico put **Richter Scale** (Habitony {GB}) back on the winning track in his 1998 debut for his new trainer. He will have to contend with **Kelly Kip** (Kipper Kelly), who can be freakishly fast, as he was in a six-length score April 11 in the GIII Bold Ruler H. at Aqueduct. He races again only a week after his last outing, a 3 3/4-length victory in the Suffolk Breeders' Cup H. **Partner's Hero** (Danzig) disappointed in his first (and probably last) turf attempt, checking in last of 11 in the GIII Red Bank H. at Monmouth May 25. The winner of last September's GII Kentucky Cup Sprint at Turfway should appreciate a return to the dirt.

Coronado's Quest (Forty Niner), scratched from the Preakness due to a bruised foot, was last seen impressively taking the GII Wood Memorial S. April 11 at Aqueduct. This will be his first sprint since finishing second to the ill-fated Time Limit at this distance in Gulfstream's GII Hutcheson S. January 31. A potential stumbling block will be the fractious colt's pre-race behavior in front of the large Belmont crowd.

Dice Dancer (Ogygian) will look to rebound from a poor performance last time, fourth by 7½ lengths, in the May 24 GII Peter Pan S. In the two races prior, he ran second to Coronado's Quest in the Wood Memorial, and was a two-length winner of the May 2 GII Withers S. at a mile.

Silver Patriarch (Ire) returned to the scene of his nose defeat by Benny The Dip in last year's Vodafone Derby and this time the victory was his, taking his lifetime record to five wins from 12 starts and his earnings over the \$1 million mark. Second by a neck in his only previous start this year, the G2 Sagitta Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 1, the giant grey once again looked to have too much to do down the long Epsom stretch as he was well behind the leaders LUSO (GB) (Salse) and POSIDONAS (GB) (Slip Anchor {GB}), who shared the lead from the gate until the quarter-mile pole, where Swain (Ire), twice a previous winner of this event, swooped to take command, with 1997 Irish Oaks winner Ebadiyla (Ire) coming to challenge. Silver Patriarch quickened brilliantly at this stage and made his customary powerful charge down the center of the track, while Swain led entering the final eighth of a mile. Swain drifted away from the fence and bumped Ebadiyla, who became the 'meat in the sandwich' between the Godolphin horse and Silver Patriarch powering his way home on the outside. Inside the final uphill 100 yards, Silver Patriarch asserted his superiority and ran out a comfortable winner. The stewards held a long inquiry after the race, but allowed the placings to remain unaltered. Silver Patriarch's winning owner-breeder Peter Winfield, who had bought the grey's dam Early Rising from Paul Mellon, was overjoyed, "My feeling is one of unabounding joy, especially after the horse's narrow defeat in last year's Derby. And, with there only being a slow pace in the race, he won against the odds today. Once he was in the straight, he really flew and motored home. He has a long stride and that disguises his great turn of foot. He's a genuine mile-and-a-half horse, as he showed in the Derby and in the Great Voltigeur last year and here again today."
